



Tiger Trust Selection Criteria:

The Tiger Trust Selection Committee will review the following criteria when considering an application:

- Must have no more than 45 credits remaining to graduate
- Re-admission to the university and completion of the FASFA
- Letter of recommendation from coach or administrator and personal essay
- Favorable results on the background check

You've been accepted into the Tiger Trust Program, now what?

- Once admitted contact the Tiger Trust Program Coordinator (Barbara Kennedy-Dixon) to obtain information on the FAFSA application, background check, and other program requirements, including employment with the Athletic Department.
- Meet with your campus advisor to discuss your graduation plan.
- Meet with an assigned Vickery Hall advisor, as instructed by the Tiger Trust Program Coordinator, to review your proposed schedule.
- Register for classes.
- Complete any additional university requirements for enrollment. This may include proof of insurance (the Tiger Trust Program does not provide insurance for former student-athletes), immunization records, etc.
- Students must pass all classes each semester. If a student does not meet this requirement their scholarship will be cancelled for future terms.

Athletic Commitment:

- Provide full scholarship (tuition & fees, room & board, and books) for full-time students.
- Provide partial scholarship (tuition, fees, and books) for part-time students.
- Accepted students must work in the Athletic Department upon completion of a background check.

What is the Tiger Trust Program?

A reconnection program for former student-athletes to return to Clemson to complete their degree.

How do I enroll in the Tiger Trust Program?

- Complete the Interest Inventory (see back page for further instructions),
- Complete the required one page essay and submit with your Interest Inventory.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a current or former Clemson coach or athletics administrator. Send recommendations to Barbara Kennedy-Dixon at kbarbar@clemson.edu.
- Complete the Undergraduate Application for Re-Admission (<https://www.applyweb.com/clemson/index.html>). The Undergraduate Application for Re-Admission fee is \$25.00 and online instructions for payment are provided in the application. Former student-athlete is responsible for this fee. Acceptance letters will be emailed to returning students to the email address entered on the application.
- Once admitted contact the Tiger Trust Program Coordinator to complete the Tiger Trust Program application and criteria
