CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson swept Wake Forest on the road by a combined score of 20-12 last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.9 runs per game and hitting .246 with a .364 on-base percentage and 28 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.44 ERA, .239 opponents' batting average and 2.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .976.

KENNESAW STATE OVERVIEW

- Kennesaw State is led by 27th-year head coach Mike Sansing.
- The Owls won two of three home games against Lipscomb last weekend. They are hitting .289 and have a 5.06 ERA and .970 fielding percentage.
- Tyler Simon is hitting .353, LaDonis Bryant is batting .345 with nine steals and Jake Franklin has seven homers and 34 RBIs.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE OVERVIEW

- Presbyterian College is led by 14th-year head coach Elton Pollock.
- The Blue Hose were swept at Gardner-Webb in three one-run games. They are hitting .269 and have a 6.10 ERA and .970 fielding percentage.
- A.J. Prialux is hitting .392 with six homers, 13 doubles and 36 RBIs, while Jonathan White is batting .358 with four homers and 34 RBIs.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is 22-3 when it scores first and 7-8 when it does not score first.
- Clemson has hit multiple home runs in 18 games (15-3 record).
- Kennesaw State assistant head coach Kevin Erminio served as the volunteer assistant coach at Clemson from 1996-98.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,161 fans per home date (21), the sixth-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of April 22).
- The Clemson record for average home attendance is 4,810 fans per date in 2007.
- Entering 2018, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 24 straight seasons and a top-15 figure 16 years in a row.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 8 by Perfect Game in the polls this week.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top 25 by at least one poll for 37 straight weeks dating to 2016.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson (14-7) is in second place behind NC State (15-6) in the ACC Atlantic Division standings.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in third place behind North Carolina (15-6) and NC State (15-6).

SENIOR LEADERS

- Clemson has relied in large part on four seniors in the heart of the lineup to achieve its 29-11 record this season.
- Patrick Cromwell, Robert Jolly, Drew Wharton and Chris Williams have been in the middle of the lineup for most of the season.
- They have combined to total 26 doubles, a triple, 22 homers and 106 RBIs.

BULLPEN STRONG

- Tiger relievers have combined for a 14-4 record, 14 saves, a 2.83 ERA and .229 opponents' batting average in 171.2 innings pitched in 2018.
- The bullpen also has 176 strikeouts against 75 walks, good for a 2.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Ryley Gilliam leads with a 2-1 record, seven saves, an 0.90 ERA, .147 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts in 20.0 innings pitched.

PRO INFLUENCE

- Clemson has several current and former players on its roster who have MLB ties.
- Both Tiger student assistant coaches, Mark Davidson and Ben Paulsen, were former Tigers who went on to play in the majors.
- Davidson, father of Tiger shortstop Logan Davidson, played at Clemson in 1982 and played six MLB years (1986-91) with the Twins and Astros.
- Paulsen, Clemson's first-base coach, played at Clemson from 2007-09 and played three years (2014-16) with the Rockies.
- Grayson Byrd is the son of righthander Paul Byrd, who played 14 years with the Mets, Braves, Phillies, Royals, Angels, Indians and Red Sox.
- Carson Spiers is the nephew of former Tiger infielder Bill Spiers, who played 13 MLB seasons and is currently a Tiger football staff member.
- Bo Majkowski is the son of Don Majkowski, who played 10 years as a quarterback in the NFL with the Packers, Colts and Lions.

BEER HAS 44 CAREER HOME RUNS

- Junior Seth Beer had 18 homers in 2016, 16 home runs in 2017 and has a team-high 10 homers in 2018, meaning he has 44 career homers.
- His 44 career home runs are ninth most in Clemson history.
- He was one of 40 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .291 with 10 homers, seven doubles, 28 RBIs, 33 runs, a .437 on-base percentage and a steal in 40 games in 2018.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 37 of the 40 games in 2018.
- He hit one homer in each game of the Georgia Tech series on March 9,10 and did the same in the Boston College series from March 29-31.
- In late March, he hit a home run in four straight games, the first Tiger to do that since Kris Harvey in the 2005 season.

- He was named national player-of-the-Week by Perfect Game and ACC Player-of-the-Week on April 2, as he had four homers and 12 RBIs.
- He was named national player-of-the-month (March) by NCBWA after hitting .294 with eight homers, a double, 20 RBIs and 19 runs in 20 games.
- In his career, he is hitting .322 with 37 doubles, a triple, 44 homers, 151 RBIs, 141 runs and a .490 on-base percentage in 165 games.
- He has 158 career walks, fourth most in Clemson history, and his one walk every 3.56 at-bats is first in Tiger history.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 158 of his last 163 games with a plate appearance.
- He has reached via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 102 of his 104 career games with a plate appearance against ACC (84) and SEC (18) teams.

BYRD TIES TIGER HOME RUN RECORD

- Junior infielder Grayson Byrd had one career home run, which came in 2017, entering the game against Charleston Southern on March 13.
- He hit three homers in his first three plate appearances and totaled a career-high five RBIs in Clemson's 5-0 win over the Buccaneers.
- He tied the school record for homers in a game and became the 14th Tiger with three and first since 2010 (John Hinson vs. USC Upstate).
- He hit a solo homer to left in the second inning, a three-run homer to right field in the fourth and a solo homer to center in the seventh.
- The son of former major league pitcher Paul Byrd is hitting .281 with six homers, 16 RBIs and three steals in 28 games (24 starts) in 2018.
- In his two seasons as a Tiger, he is hitting .283 with seven homers, 36 RBIs, 39 runs and six steals in 85 games (78 starts).

CRAWFORD FINDING HOME ON WEEKEND

- Junior righty Brooks Crawford was a long reliever most of his first two seasons at Clemson, but he has become the Saturday starter in 2018.
- He is 4-2 with a 3.54 ERA, .250 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts against 12 walks in 48.1 innings pitched over 10 starts.
- Clemson has an 8-2 record in his 10 starts in 2018.
- He is holding opponents to a .188 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- In his career, he is 11-2 with one save, a 3.15 ERA and 77 strikeouts in 117.0 innings pitched over 53 appearances (12 starts).

CROMWELL GETTING ON BASE

- Senior Patrick Cromwell has emerged as one of Clemson's top offensive threats in 2018.
- He is hitting .248 with four homers, five doubles, 17 RBIs, 28 runs, a .371 on-base percentage and a steal in 40 games (37 starts).
- He has a .959 fielding percentage, committing only five errors in 122 chances, and has made many highlight-reel plays at third base.
- He hit the game-tying, solo homer in the ninth inning against Winthrop on Feb. 27, a game the Tigers went on to win.
- He went 3-for-5 with two two-run homers against Miami (Fla.) on April 13.
- In his career, he is hitting .233 with five doubles, six homers, 22 RBIs and a .352 on-base percentage in 73 games (58 starts).

GILLIAM CLOSING THE DEAL

- Junior righty Ryley Gilliam has been the closer each of the last two years and has a team-high seven saves.

NOTES

- He was named an NSCA Strength & Conditioning All-American in 2018.
- He is 2-1 with an 0.90 ERA, a .147 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts against 12 walks in 20.0 innings pitched over 16 outings.
- In his seven ACC regular-season outings, he has five saves and has allowed three hits with 17 strikeouts in 10.2 scoreless innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 8-4 with 11 saves, a 3.45 ERA and 98 strikeouts in 86.0 innings pitched over 58 appearances (six starts).

GREENE PROVIDING SPARK

- Junior infielder Jordan Greene has come on to become the starter at second base and has provided a spark in the lineup.
- He is hitting .250 with a double, four homers, 12 RBIs, 18 runs, a .381 on-base percentage and five steals in 27 games (20 starts) in 2018.
- In ACC regular-season games, he is hitting .283 with a .443 on-base percentage and five steals in 16 games (14 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .254 with 14 doubles, five homers, 37 RBIs, 61 runs and 13 steals in 124 games (98 starts).

HENNESSY LEADING ROTATION

- Sophomore lefthander Jacob Hennessy was a reliever as a freshman in 2017, but has become the Friday starter in 2018.
- He was one of 78 pitchers named to the College Baseball Foundation National Pitcher-of-the-Year Watch List in April.
- He is 3-2 with a 3.25 ERA, .236 opponents' batting average and 43 strikeouts against 14 walks in 55.1 innings pitched over 10 starts.
- He is holding opponents to a .145 batting average with two outs.
- He earned the win against Boston College by allowing just one hit and no earned runs in 6.0 innings pitched on March 29.
- In his career, he is 5-3 with a 3.45 ERA and 80 strikeouts against 25 walks in 86.0 innings pitched over 36 appearances (10 starts).

HIGGINBOTHAM BACK ON THE MOUND

- Sophomore lefthander Jake Higginbotham was a mid-week starter as a freshman in 2016, but suffered an arm injury and missed all of 2017.
- He is 6-1 with a 3.44 ERA, .231 opponents' batting average and 40 strikeouts against 15 walks in 52.1 innings pitched over 10 starts.
- Clemson has an 8-2 record in his 10 starts in the 2018 season.
- He returned to action against William & Mary on Feb. 18 and earned the win in 5.1 innings pitched, allowing just one run on two hits.
- He earned the win against No. 10 Dallas Baptist by allowing just five hits and no earned runs with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 9-1 with a 3.89 ERA and 68 strikeouts against 36 walks in 85.2 innings pitched over 18 appearances (17 starts).

JOLLY HAPPY AS A SENIOR

- Robert Jolly is enjoying one of his best seasons as a senior in 2018. After being a catcher from 2015-17, he has moved to the outfield.
- He is hitting .243 with six doubles, a homer, 16 RBIs, 16 runs, 20 walks and a .358 on-base percentage in 35 games (34 starts).
- He is hitting .317 with runners on base and .350 with runners in scoring position.

- In his career, he is hitting .264 with 21 doubles, two homers, 51 RBIs, a .366 on-base percentage and three steals in 151 games (92 starts).

MARR HAVING SOLID FRESHMAN YEAR

- Redshirt freshman righthander Travis Marr has been one of the team's top long relievers in his second season in the program in 2018.
- He is 3-1 with a 4.76 ERA, .295 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts in 34.0 innings pitched over 15 appearances (two starts).
- He is holding opponents to 0-for-9 with four strikeouts against no walks with the bases loaded.
- In his career, he is 3-1 with a 4.63 ERA and 27 strikeouts against 12 walks in 35.0 innings pitched over 16 appearances (two starts).

MEREDITH ADDING SPEED TO LINEUP

- Freshman outfielder Kier Meredith made his Clemson debut at Notre Dame on April 7 after missing the first half of the season due to injury.
- He made an instant impact in the Notre Dame series, going 4-for-10 with a homer, triple, .571 on-base percentage and three steals.
- He is hitting .267 with a homer, triple, double, three RBIs, four runs, a .463 on-base percentage and four steals in nine games in 2018.

MILLER FILLING KEY RELIEF ROLE

- Senior righthander Ryan Miller has been one of Clemson's top relievers in 2018 and has filled an important role.
- He is 3-1 with three saves, a 2.92 ERA, .232 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts in 37.0 innings pitched over 14 relief outings.
- He is holding opponents to a .159 batting average with two outs.
- He has 46 groundball outs compared to 27 flyball outs.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief to record the save in Clemson's win over No. 23 South Carolina at Greenville, S.C., on March 3.
- In his career, he is 4-1 with four saves, a 2.96 ERA and 43 strikeouts against nine walks in 48.2 innings pitched over 25 relief outings.

SPIERS MAKING THE JUMP

- Sophomore righthander Carson Spiers saw limited action as a freshman, but he has made a big jump as one of the team's top relievers in 2018.
- He has made a team-high 18 appearances, all out of the bullpen, and has three saves.
- He is 1-2 with a 3.24 ERA, .191 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts against 10 walks in 25.0 innings pitched.
- He is holding opponents to a .119 batting average with runners on base.
- He has allowed only two of his 20 inherited baserunners to score in 2018.
- In his career, he is 1-2 with a 3.21 ERA and 28 strikeouts against 10 walks in 28.0 innings pitched over 21 relief appearances.
- His cousin, Will Spiers, is the starting punter on the Tiger football team.
- His father, Michael Spiers, hit .301 with 16 homers, 110 RBIs and 32 steals in 184 games as a Tiger from 1988-91.
- His uncle, Bill Spiers, hit .325 with 17 homers, 119 RBIs and 60 steals in 173 games as a Tiger from 1985-87, then played 13 MLB seasons.
- His grandfather, Bud Spiers, hit .254 with seven homers and 44 RBIs as a Tiger from 1956-58.

HEAD COACH MONTE LEE

WHARTON EMERGING IN FINAL SEASON

- Senior Drew Wharton entered the season with no homers and 20 RBIs in 74 games (22 starts) over three years.
- With the departure of two outfielders from last year's team, he has made the most of his chance to contribute in 2018.
- He is hitting .231 with nine doubles, a triple, six homers, 30 RBIs and a .310 on-base percentage in 40 games (39 starts) in 2018.
- He hit three long balls, the first three of his career, in the series against No. 10 Dallas Baptist in February.
- He hit a walkoff triple in Clemson's 8-7 win over No. 23 South Carolina on March 4.
- In his career, he is hitting .227 with 12 doubles, a triple, six homers, 50 RBIs, 25 runs and six steals in 114 games (61 starts).

WILKIE ON A SECOND-HALF SURGE

- Sophomore catcher is on a second-half surge, just like he was at the end of his freshman season in 2017.
- In the last six games, he is 10-for-24 (.417) with a homer and six RBIs.
- He is hitting .252 with two homers, six doubles, 21 RBIs and a .361 on-base percentage in 39 games (37 starts).
- He is hitting .345 with runners on base, .405 with runners in scoring position and .333 with two outs.
- In ACC regular-season games, he is hitting .313 with two homers, five doubles, 16 RBIs and a .418 on-base percentage in 20 games.
- As Clemson's catcher, he has allowed only 14 stolen bases in 23 attempts.
- In his career, he is hitting .247 with seven doubles, a triple, two homers, 26 RBIs, 19 runs and a .364 on-base percentage in 63 games.

WILLIAMS POWERING TIGERS

- Chris Williams was drafted in the 31st round in 2017, but chose to return for his senior season.
- He is one of the team's best power hitters and has seen most of his action at first base in 2018, but has also played at catcher.
- He was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List in March.
- He is hitting .252 with six doubles, 11 homers, 43 RBIs, 33 runs, a .346 on-base percentage and a steal in 40 games in 2018.
- He is hitting .308 with runners on base and .341 with runners in scoring position.
- He is 6-for-9 with two grand slams, 15 RBIs and a 1.333 slugging percentage with the bases loaded in 2018.
- He hit two grand slams, the first two of his career, in the Miami (Fla.) series on April 13,14.
- In his three-year career, he is hitting .252 with 25 doubles, 33 homers, 132 RBIs, 96 runs and five steals in 146 games (134 starts).

FOUR TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2018

- Former Tigers Daniel Gossett, Dominic Leone, Brad Miller and Tony Sipp have all played at least one MLB game in 2018.
- Gossett is in his second season, Leone is in his fifth season, Miller is in his sixth season and Sipp is in his 10th season.
- Gossett, who had a 23-9 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Oakland Athletics in 2017.
- Leone, who had a 16-8 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Seattle Mariners in 2014.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- Sipp batted .280 and had a 2-2 pitching record for the Tigers in 2004.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2014 has had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
