



Topics of the Month – Complimentary Admissions

Student-athletes:

- May be provided a max of four (4) complimentary admissions for home and away games in their sport. [Bylaw 16.2.1.1]
 - Issued on game by game basis
 - NO hard tickets [Bylaw 16.2.1.2]
 - All guest need proof of ID [Bylaw 16.2.1.2.1]
 - They can trade amongst themselves (none from staff)
 - They get six (6) for post season [Bylaw 16.2.1.1.1]
 - **NEW RULE:** they can purchase additional post season tickets at face value from the university (subject to institutional policy) [Bylaw 16.2.1.4]
 - Student-athlete (or their designated guest) may NOT sell their comp tickets. [Bylaw 16.2.2.1 & 16.2.2.2]

Prospects:

Unofficial Visit:

- May be provided a max of three (3) complimentary admissions for home competition [Bylaw 13.7.2.1]
 - General seating area ONLY
 - May **not** be provided during a dead period (unless they're a signee)
 - **Nontraditional family (ex: divorced parents)** – may be provided two (2) additional complimentary admissions
 - **NO** hard tickets/All guest need ID/No selling
 - **NO** reserving additional tickets [Bylaw 13.7.2.1.5]
- **HOME SITE OTHER THAN REGULAR FACILITY:** If designated as home team a prospect may be provided complimentary admissions. [Bylaw 13.7.2.2]
- **NO** parking [Bylaw 13.7.2.1.6]

Official Visit:

- May be provided a max of six (6) complimentary admissions to home competition [Bylaw 13.6.7.2]
 - General seating ONLY
 - NO hard tickets/All guest need ID/No selling
- May reserve additional for purchase by immediate family only [Bylaw 13.6.7.2.3]
- Parking may be arranged [Bylaw 13.6.7.3]
- No tickets for NCAA/postseason or ACC tournament events (applies to unofficial visit)

HS/JUCO Coaches:

- May be granted a maximum of TWO (2) complimentary admissions (issued only through a pass list) to home intercollegiate athletic events. [Bylaw 13.8.1]
 - No Postseason events
 - No reserving tickets for purchase [Bylaw 13.8.1.4]

Head Coach Responsibility-Compliance Discussion Topics

1. **Gifts at coaches' clinic:** Know that you're prohibited from providing door prizes to coaches, even if the cost is included in registration [Bylaw 13.8.2.1]
2. **Period of Award:** Be familiar with what defines a "period of award" and what exceptions might apply [Bylaw 15.3.3]
3. **Missed Term Exception:** Know the qualifications for applying a missed term exception as it relates to Progress-Toward-Degree limitations. [Bylaw 14.4.3.6]
4. **Student Assistant Coach:** Know the definition and limitations as it relates to prospect interaction. [Bylaw 11.01.5]

2015-21	RECRUITING: Official Visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Allows up to six (6) complimentary tickets for prospects on official visits. (subject to institutional limitations) ▪ Further defines family members ▪ Lodging may be provided for up to four (4) family members ▪ Entertainment may be provided for up to four (4) family members ▪ Meals may be provided for up to four (4) family members
2015-39	RECRUITING: Phone Calls/Recruiting Material <i>[Diving & Track]</i>	TRK: Beginning 9/1 of junior year – unlimited phone & text to prospects (and parents/legal guardians) DIV: Beginning 7/1 prior to junior year - unlimited phone & text to prospects (and parents/legal guardians)
2015-40	RECRUITING: Phone Calls/Recruiting Material to a coach who is also the parent of a prospect	Phone calls may be placed and electronic correspondence sent to a prospect's coach who is also the parent of a prospect at an institution's discretion.
2015-42	RECRUITING: Contacts & Evaluations: Restrictions at Prospect's school – <i>[Basketball]</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A coaching staff member may contact a prospect at a two-year college that conducts classes throughout the day after 4 p.m. local time ▪ Prospect shall not miss class for such contact
2015-48	ATHLETICS PERSONNEL AND RECRUITING: Social media content approval	Staff member may "like," "favorite," republish, etc. content on social media platforms that was generated by users of the platforms other than institutional staff members or representatives of an institution's athletics interests.
2015-49	RECRUITING MATERIAL: Electronic Correspondence <i>[TRK/DIV]</i>	Eliminates Text restrictions.
2015-51-FBS	RECRUITING MATERIAL: Electronic Correspondence <i>[FOOTBALL]</i>	Eliminates Text restrictions.
2015-53	RECRUITING: OFFICIAL VISIT – <i>Men's Basketball</i> – 24 visits over two years.	Specifies that an institution may provide official visits to up to 24 prospects in a rolling two-year period
2015-75	PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASONS: Outside the playing season – Eliminate limit of four student-athletes in skill instruction	In sports other football, eliminates the restriction that not more than four student-athletes from the same team may be involved in skill related instruction prior to September 15 and after April 15;
