The Holy Cross football team will play its first home game of the season when it takes on New Hampshire at Fitton Field on Saturday, Sept. 16. The game between the Crusaders and the Wildcats will be televised live by Charter TV3 and the Patriot League Network, and can be heard live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

At halftime of the Holy Cross-New Hampshire game, Dr. Eddie Anderson, Dennis Golden and David Murphy will become the 23rd, 24th and 25th individuals to be inducted into the Crusader Football Legends Ring of Honor.

Holy Cross stands 1-1 overall this year with a 1-0 mark in the Patriot League. After being edged by Connecticut 27-20 in their season opener, the Crusaders posted a 20-0 shutout victory at Bucknell last week.

Senior quarterback **Peter Pujals** has led the Crusader offense by completing 49 of 89 passes for 536 yards and a touchdown. Senior wide out **Blaise Bell** has posted 14 receptions for 174 yards and a score, while junior wide receiver **Richie DeNicola** has caught 13 passes for 142 yards. Senior tailback **Diquan Walker** leads the Holy Cross ground game with 88 yards and three touchdowns on 15 carries.

On the defensive side of the ball, junior linebacker **Ryan Brady** leads the team with 24 tackles and two tackles for loss. Senior linebacker **Nick McBeath** has added 20 tackles, three tackles for loss, a sack, an interception and a fumble recovery, while senior cornerback **Alim Muhammad** has recorded 14 tackles, one tackle for loss and three pass breakups.

New Hampshire currently stands 2-0 overall this year with a 1-0 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association, and is ranked No. 9 in the nation by Stats. The Wildcats defeated Maine 24-23 in their season opener, before knocking off FBS foe Georgia Southern 22-12 last week.

Junior quarterback Trevor Knight has completed 32 of 52 passes for 287 yards with four touchdowns, in addition to rushing the ball 30 times for 134 yards. Junior wide receiver Neil O'Connor has caught 15 passes for 160 yards and two scores, while sophomore tailback Evan Gray has carried 31 times for 151 yards and a touchdown. On the defensive side of the ball, sophomore linebacker Quinlen Dean has a team-best 16 tackles with a sack and an interception. Sophomore strong safety Rick Ellison has posted 13 tackles, an interception and a pass breakup, with senior defensive tackle Rick Holt adding 12 tackles and two sacks.

"New Hampshire is coming off two big wins against their rival Maine and FBS Georgia Southern," said Holy Cross head coach Tom Gilmore. "They are a talented and well-coached team that always presents multiple challenges in all phases of the game."

After the contest with New Hampshire, Holy Cross will hit the road for a 7:00 p.m. game at Dartmouth on Saturday, Sept. 23.

THE SERIES WITH NEW HAMPSHIRE: This will be the 15th meeting between the Crusaders and the Wildcats on the gridiron, with New Hampshire leading the all-time series 8-6. The Wildcats have defeated Holy Cross three times since 2011, but prior to that the two schools had not met since 1984. Holy Cross holds a 4-3 advantage for games played in Worcester, although the Wildcats have won their last two visits to Fitton Field. The schools first met on Oct. 2, 1909, with Holy Cross winning 13-0 in Worcester.

DEFENSE SHUTS OUT BUCKNELL: The Holy Cross defense turned in one of its top performances in recent history last Saturday in the 20-0 shutout victory over Bucknell. The shutout was the seventh by the Crusaders during Tom Gilmore's tenure as head coach, and their first since defeating Lafayette 42-0 on Oct. 24, 2015. In the contest, Holy Cross held Bucknell to just 214 yards of total offense and 13 first downs on the day. The 214 total yards were the fewest by a Crusader opponent since Georgetown had only 213 yards on Nov. 21, 2005, while the 10 first downs were the least since Albany only picked up 10 first downs on Oct. 3, 2015. With last week's victory, Holy Cross became the first Patriot League team to record a shutout this season. Through the first two contests of the 2017 campaign, the Crusaders are now holding their opponents to 13.5 points, 15.5 first downs and 326.0 yards per game.

RING OF HONOR INDUCTIONS SET FOR SEPT. 16: The athletic department at the College of the Holy Cross will honor three individuals this season as the seventh class of the Crusader Football Legends Ring of Honor. **Dr. Eddie Anderson, Dennis Golden** (Class of 1963) and **David Murphy** (Class of 1990) will be honored in a ceremony at the game against New Hampshire on Sept. 16. Only former Crusader football players and coaches who have been elected to the Holy Cross Varsity Club Hall of Fame are eligible for this honor, which is an annual event each fall. PUJALS RETURNS AT QUARTERBACK: Fifth-year senior quarterback **Peter Pujals** has returned for one final season to lead the Holy Cross offense this fall. During the opener at Connecticut, Pujals led the team by completing 33 of 56 passes for 358 yards and a touchdown. Last season, he started the first four games for the Crusaders before suffering a season-ending injury at Dartmouth and receiving a medical redshirt. Pujals previously earned first team All-Patriot League honors in 2015, after being a second team selection in 2014 and taking home Patriot League Rookie of the Year honors in 2013. Over the course of his collegiate career, Pujals has hit on 882 of 1,455 passes for 9,455 yards and 68 touchdowns, while rushing 439 times for 1,607 yards and 16 scores. He currently ranks second all-time at Holy Cross in career completions and pass attempts, while standing third in passing yards and fourth in touchdown passes.

CRUSADERS SET FOR HOME OPENER: Holy Cross is now in its 122nd season of intercollegiate football. The Crusaders have been impressive in their opening home game of the season, posting an all-time mark of 79-34-7. Holy Cross stands 5-8 in home openers under head coach Tom Gilmore, including a 35-10 loss to Dartmouth last season. Following this year's 27-20 loss at Connecticut, the Crusaders now stand at 71-42-9 in their season debuts overall, including a 6-8 record in Gilmore's tenure.

HOLY CROSS PICKED FOURTH IN PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL: The 2017 Crusaders were picked to finish in fourth place in the preseason poll of the Patriot League's head coaches and sports information directors. Holy Cross received a total of 39 points in the poll. The rankings:

MCBEATH LEADS AT LINEBACKER: Senior linebacker **Nick McBeath** is once again a leader for the Holy Cross defense this year. Last week at Bucknell, he recorded nine tackles, two tackles for loss, a sack and an interception. Previously at Connecticut, McBeath totaled 11 tackles with one tackle for loss and a fumble recovery. He was selected preseason All-Patriot League prior to the start of the year, after being named first team All-Patriot League in 2016. Last year, McBeath led the team in tackles eight times and reached double digits in tackles on six occasions. Overall in 2016, McBeath led the Patriot League with 106 total tackles. Over the course of his career with the Crusaders, he has totaled 228 tackles, 16 tackles for loss, two interceptions, three forced fumbles and four pass breakups.

Peter Pujals completed 42 of 64 passes for 427 yards and three touchdowns, but Holy Cross was defeated by 24th-ranked New Hampshire 39-28 at Wildcat Stadium. Pujals broke the school single-game record with his 42 completions, while his 427 passing yards were the sixth-highest single-game total in school history. Richie DeNicola caught a career-best 13 passes for 151 yards and the first two touchdowns of his career, while Jake Wieczorek added a career-high 13 receptions for 113 yards. Ryan Smith led the Holy Cross defense with six tackles and three quarterback sacks. The Crusaders opened the game with an early 14-0 lead on a 21-yard scoring run by Pujals and a 32-yard touchdown pass from Pujals to Blaise Bell. The Wildcats scored their first points on a three-yard touchdown run by Dalton Crossan, before a 23-yard scoring strike from Pujals to DeNicola put Holy Cross up 21-6 early in the second quarter. Crossan added a 56-yard touchdown run on New Hampshire's next drive, and the Crusaders went on to take a 21-13 advantage into the locker room at halftime. The Wildcats opened the third quarter with an eight-yard scoring strike from Trevor Knight to Neil O'Connor, before Pujals and DeNicola hooked up for a 29-yard touchdown to put Holy Cross in front 28-19. But New Hampshire went on to score the final 20 points of the night (on a one-yard Trevon Bryant rush, a 62-yard pass from Knight to Rory Donovan and a 28-yard interception return by Casey DeAndrade) to pull away for the victory.

DEFENDING THE HOME TURF: Holy Cross has enjoyed great success at Fitton Field over the years, but went just 1-3 at home last season. The Crusaders, who played their first game at Fitton Field in 1903, have posted an all-time home mark of 376-187-27 (.660). From Oct. 11, 2008-Oct. 9, 2010, Holy Cross had a streak of 13 straight victories at home. The Crusaders had a perfect 6-0 mark at Fitton Field in 2009, and finished the 2011 campaign with a winning record at home for the sixth straight season. Fitton Field is the second-oldest stadium still used for Division I college football, behind only Franklin Field at the University of Pennsylvania (opened in 1895).

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: The 2017 campaign marks the 122nd season of Holy Cross football. The Crusaders currently own an overall record of 625-517-54, good for a .545 winning percentage. Prior to the start of the 2017 season, Holy Cross' 624 all-time victories ranked as the 15th most among all FCS schools. Holy Cross has had 31 first team All-America selections, sent 69 players on to professional football, won five Lambert Cups, claimed six Patriot League championships, and was named the Division I-AA Team of the Year in 1987. The Crusaders also played in the 1946 Orange Bowl, losing to host Miami on the game's final play.

MCBEATH, MURRAY & PUJALS SERVE AS CAPTAINS: Holy Cross has three captains for the 2017 football season. Senior linebacker **Nick McBeath**, senior offensive lineman **James Murray** and senior quarterback **Peter Pujals** were named the team's captains by head coach Tom Gilmore following the conclusion of spring practice. Pujals previously served as a captain during the 2014, 2015 and 2016 campaigns, and is the first player in school history to spend four seasons as a captain. The only other three-year captain in school history was Dominic Randolph in 2007, 2008 and 2009.

HEAD COACH TOM GILMORE: A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year (in 2006 and 2009), Tom Gilmore is now in his 14th season as the head football coach at Holy Cross in 2017. He has guided the Crusaders to an overall record of 71-77 during his time at Holy Cross. In 2009, Gilmore led the Crusaders to an overall record of 9-3, the Patriot League championship and a trip to the NCAA playoffs. A finalist for the 2009 Eddie Robinson Award, Gilmore's teams have posted winning records in eight of the last 11 seasons. Prior to his time at Holy Cross, Gilmore served as an assistant coach at Lehigh (2000-2003), Dartmouth (1992-1999), Pennsylvania (1986, 1990-1991) and Columbia (1987-1989). An Academic All-American and the Ivy League Player of the Year at Pennsylvania, Gilmore graduated in 1986 with a bachelor's degree in computer mathematics.

UConn's Nate Hopkins carried the ball 20 times for 130 yards and three touchdowns, to lead the Huskies to a 27-20 victory over Holy Cross at Pratt and Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. UConn scored 20 unanswered points in the second half to rally for the win. Hopkins began the comeback with a three-yard touchdown run late in the third quarter, before an 11-yard pass from Bryant Shirreffs to Hergy Mayala gave the Huskies a 21-20 lead. Hopkins then concluded the scoring with a one-yard scoring run in the fourth quarter. Holy Cross had opened the game by jumping out to a 20-7 halftime lead. The Crusaders scored two touchdowns in the second quarter, on a 19-yard pass from Peter Pujals to Blaise Bell and a six-yard run by Diquan Walker. Pujals completed 33 of 56 passes on the evening for 358 yards and a touchdown. Bell finished the night with a career-high 10 receptions for a team-best 129 yards and a score, while Richie DeNicola added 10 catches for 87 yards. Ryan Brady led the Crusader defense with a career-best 14 total tackles, and Alim Muhammad finished with a career-high 12 tackles and two pass breakups. A.J. Wells scored the first eight points of his collegiate career, hitting field goals of 20 and 25 yards along with two extra points. The crowd of 24,435 was the largest to witness a Holy Cross football game since 2002, when 28,063 fans attended the game at Army.

HOLY CROSS 20, BUCKNELL 0

September 9, 2017 • Lewisburg, Pa.

The Holy Cross defense posted its first shutout since 2015 and allowed only 214 total yards, as the Crusaders recorded a 20-0 victory over Bucknell at Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium. Holy Cross forced three first half turnovers, setting the offense up in Bucknell territory each time. The Crusaders took advantage with a two-yard touchdown run by Diquan Walker and a pair of field goals by A.J. Wells to build a 13-0 halftime lead. Walker added another two-yard touchdown run in the third quarter to conclude the scoring. The shutout was the first by Holy Cross since defeating Lafayette 42-0 on Oct. 24, 2015. The 214 total yards allowed were the fewest the Crusaders have given up since holding Georgetown to 213 yards on Nov. 21, 2015. Ryan Brady led the team with 10 tackles, including one tackle for loss. Nick McBeath totaled nine tackles, a quarterback sack, two tackles for loss and an interception. Akeem Walcott added six tackles, a tackle for loss, a fumble recovery and two pass breakups, while Jack Kutschke finished with six tackles, one tackle for loss, a forced fumble and two pass breakups. Walker finished the day with a team-high 72 yards and two scores on just 10 carries. Peter Pujals hit on 16 of 33 passes for 178 yards. Blaise Bell posted four receptions for 45 yards, while Darius Lacy caught four passes for 41 yards.
