The Holy Cross football team hits the road this weekend, heading to Yale for a 1:00 p.m. contest on Saturday, Oct. 14. The game between the Crusaders and the Bulldogs will be shown on the Ivy League Network, and can be heard live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross stands 2-4 overall this year with a 1-1 mark in the Patriot League. The Crusaders own victories over No. 9 New Hampshire (51-26) and Bucknell (20-0), while falling to Connecticut (27-20), Dartmouth (27-26 in overtime), Monmouth (48-36) and Lafayette (10-7). Holy Cross currently ranks 12th in the nation in passing offense (304.2 yards per game), 14th in kickoff coverage (17.0 yards per return) and 17th in third down conversion defense (31.0 percent).

Senior quarterback **Peter Pujals** has led the Crusader offense by completing 157 of 285 passes for 1,825 yards and 12 touchdowns. Senior wide out **Blaise Bell** has posted 34 receptions for 437 yards and five scores, while junior wide receiver **Martin Dorsey** has caught 22 passes for 353 yards and two touchdowns. Senior tailback **Gabe Guild** leads the Holy Cross ground game with 244 yards on 49 carries.

On the defensive side of the ball, junior linebacker **Ryan Brady** leads the team with 67 tackles, three sacks and eight tackles for loss. Senior linebacker **Nick McBeath** has added 60 tackles, three sacks, nine tackles for loss, two interceptions and a fumble recovery, while senior defensive tackle **Jack Kutschke** has recorded 31 tackles, three sacks, 10 tackles for loss and two pass breakups.

Yale currently stands 3-1 overall this season with a 1-1 mark in the Ivy League. The Bulldogs have defeated Lehigh (56-28), Cornell (49-24) and Fordham (41-10), while falling to Dartmouth (28-27).

Freshman tailback Zane Dudek has led Yale by rushing 45 times for 403 yards and five touchdowns, while senior tailback Deshawn Salter has added 376 yards and seven scores on 49 carries. Sophomore quarterback Kurt Rawlings has connected on 72 of 102 passes for 903 yards and nine touchdowns with four interceptions, and senior wide out Christopher Williams-Lopez has totaled 25 receptions for 348 yards and two scores. Defensively, senior free safety Hayden Carlson has a team-best 28 tackles with an interception and two pass breakups. Senior cornerback Spencer Rymiszewski is also enjoying a strong season with 21 tackles and four pass breakups.

“This is definitely one of the best Yale teams I have ever seen,” said Holy Cross head coach Tom Gilmore. “They have great talent and depth, and have been playing very well this year. We expect this week’s game to be a huge challenge for us.”

After the contest with Yale, Holy Cross returns home to face Colgate on Saturday, Oct. 21, at 12:05 p.m.

THE SERIES WITH YALE: This will be the 32nd meeting between the Crusaders and the Bulldogs on the gridiron, with Yale leading the all-time series 27-4. The Bulldogs have won 12 of the last 13 games played in the series, with the Crusaders' lone victory during that stretch being a 22-19 win in New Haven in 2005. Prior to 2005, Yale had won six straight meetings at the Yale Bowl. For all games played in New Haven, the Bulldogs hold a 20-4 advantage. The two schools first met on Oct. 14, 1903, when Yale won 36-10 in New Haven.

MCBEATH LEADS AT LINEBACKER: Senior linebacker **Nick McBeath** is once again a leader for the Holy Cross defense this year. In the Lafayette game, he totaled eight tackles with an interception. Previously at Dartmouth, McBeath made 11 tackles with a sack and a forced fumble. He also played well against New Hampshire, posting a team-high 14 tackles with a sack and a pass breakup. A few of McBeath's other top games this year came against Bucknell (nine tackles, two tackles for loss, a sack and an interception) and Connecticut (11 tackles with one tackle for loss and a fumble recovery). On the season, he has now totaled 60 tackles with three sacks, nine tackles for loss and two interceptions. Last year, McBeath was named first team All-Patriot League after leading the conference with 106 total tackles. Over the course of his career with the Crusaders, he has totaled 268 tackles, 22 tackles for loss, three interceptions, four forced fumbles and six pass breakups.

PUJALS RETURNS AT QUARTERBACK: Fifth-year senior quarterback **Peter Pujals** has returned for one final season to lead the Crusaders this fall. In six games played this year, Pujals has connected on 157 of 285 attempts for 1,825 yards and 12 touchdowns. During the Monmouth game, he completed 36 of 63 passes for a school single-game record 509 yards and four touchdowns. Previously against New Hampshire, Pujals hit on 21 of 39 passes for 367 yards and five scores. He also played well at Connecticut, completing 33 of 56 attempts for 358 yards and a touchdown. Last season, he started the first four games before suffering a season-ending injury at Dartmouth and receiving a medical redshirt. Pujals previously earned first team All-Patriot League honors in 2015, after being a second team selection in 2014 and taking home Patriot League Rookie of the Year honors in 2013. Over the course of his collegiate career, Pujals has hit on 990 of 1,651 passes for 10,744 yards and 79 touchdowns, while rushing 466 times for 1,656 yards and 17 scores. He currently ranks second all-time at Holy Cross in career completions, pass attempts, passing yards and touchdown passes.

HOLY CROSS AGAINST THE IVY LEAGUE: The Crusaders stand 17-20 against Ivy League foes during Tom Gilmore's tenure as head coach, including an 0-1 record so far season. The 17-20 mark over the last 14 years includes an 8-5 record against Dartmouth, a 4-5 mark against Brown, a 4-8 record against Harvard and a 1-2 mark against Yale. Holy Cross' all time record against the Ivy League stands at 110-149-9 (31-25-3 against Brown, 6-2 vs. Columbia, 0-5 against Cornell, 37-39-4 vs. Dartmouth, 25-42-2 against Harvard, 3-2 vs. Pennsylvania, 3-7 against Princeton and 4-27 vs. Yale).

PUJALS PUT UP BIG NUMBERS AGAINST MONMOUTH: During last Saturday's game against Monmouth, senior quarterback Peter Pujals hit on 36 of 63 passes for 509 yards and four touchdowns. He broke the school single-game record for passing yards, which he had previously set himself with 508 yards at Fordham in 2015. Pujals also placed fifth on the all-time Patriot League single-game list for most passing yards. He now owns the only two 500-yard passing games in Holy Cross history, while his 509 passing yards are the fourth-most by any FCS player in a single game this season.

BRADY MAKING BIG PLAYS: Junior linebacker **Ryan Brady** has been one of the leaders of the Holy Cross defense this year. In six games played, he has totaled 67 tackles with three sacks and eight tackles for loss. Last week against Monmouth, Brady led the team with 12 tackles, a sack and two tackles for loss. Previously against Lafayette, he made a team-best 10 tackles with two tackles for loss. A few of Brady's other top games this season have been against New Hampshire (eight tackles, two sacks) and Connecticut (14 tackles). Over the course of his collegiate career, Brady has now totaled 94 tackles, four sacks and 12 tackles for loss.

MCBEATH, MURRAY & PUJALS SERVE AS CAPTAINS: Holy Cross has three captains for the 2017 football season. Senior linebacker **Nick McBeath**, senior offensive lineman **James Murray** and senior quarterback **Peter Pujals** were named the team's captains by head coach Tom Gilmore following the conclusion of spring practice. Pujals previously served as a captain during the 2014, 2015 and 2016 campaigns, and is the first player in school history to spend four seasons as a captain. The only other three-year captain in school history was Dominic Randolph in 2007, 2008 and 2009.

HEAD COACH TOM GILMORE: A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year (in 2006 and 2009), Tom Gilmore is now in his 14th season as the head football coach at Holy Cross in 2017. He has guided the Crusaders to an overall record of 72-78 during his time at Holy Cross. In 2009, Gilmore led the Crusaders to an overall record of 9-3, the Patriot League championship and a trip to the NCAA playoffs. A finalist for the 2009 Eddie Robinson Award, Gilmore's teams have posted winning records in eight of the last 11 seasons. Prior to his time at Holy Cross, Gilmore served as an assistant coach at Lehigh (2000-2003), Dartmouth (1992-1999), Pennsylvania (1986, 1990-1991) and Columbia (1987-1989). An Academic All-American and the Ivy League Player of the Year at Pennsylvania, Gilmore graduated in 1986 with a bachelor's degree in computer mathematics.

Dominic Randolph completed 41 of 63 passes for 376 yards and three touchdowns, but it was not enough as Holy Cross was defeated by Yale 31-28 in double overtime at the Yale Bowl. In the first overtime, Holy Cross needed just three plays to score a touchdown on a 10-yard pass from Randolph to Nick Cole. Yale came right back on the next play to tie up the score with a 25-yard pass from Ryan Fodor to Jordan Forney. The Bulldogs had the ball first in the second overtime, with Tom Mante kicking a 34-yard field goal. The Crusaders then missed a 37-yard field goal attempt on the final play of the second overtime. To open the game, Yale took a 7-0 lead late in the first quarter on an 18-yard touchdown pass from Fodor to John Sheffield. The Bulldogs then increased their lead to 14-0 in the second quarter on a 32-yard interception return by Bobby Abare. The Crusaders came right back on their next possession, with Randolph throwing a 28-yard touchdown pass to Ryan McGuire. But before halftime, Yale drove back down the field and scored on a one-yard run by Mike McLeod, making the score 21-7 at the break. After neither team scored in the third quarter, Randolph went into the end zone on a one-yard run to make the score 21-14 with 3:47 left to play. The Crusaders then got the ball back with 56 seconds remaining and no time outs at their own 10-yard line, and drove all the way down the field to tie the score on a three-yard pass from Randolph to McGuire with six seconds left. McGuire finished with five catches for 55 yards and two scores, while Luke Chmielinski had 75 receiving yards on six catches. McLeod led Yale by rushing for 131 yards on 39 carries. Sean Lamkin led the Holy Cross defense with 12 total tackles.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: The 2017 campaign marks the 122nd season of Holy Cross football. The Crusaders currently own an overall record of 626-519-54, good for a .545 winning percentage. Prior to the start of the 2017 season, Holy Cross' 624 all-time victories ranked as the 15th most among all FCS schools. Holy Cross has had 31 first team All-America selections, sent 69 players on to professional football, won five Lambert Cups, claimed six Patriot League championships, and was named the Division I-AA Team of the Year in 1987. The Crusaders also played in the 1946 Orange Bowl, losing to host Miami on the game's final play.

DEFENSE CONTINUES SOLID PLAY: The Holy Cross defense has turned in several outstanding performances so far this season. On Sept. 9, the Crusaders posted the seventh shutout during Tom Gilmore's tenure as head coach with a 20-0 victory at Bucknell. In that contest, Holy Cross held the Bison to just 214 yards of total offense and 13 first downs on the day. The 214 total yards were the fewest by a Crusader opponent since Georgetown had only 213 yards on Nov. 21, 2005, while the 10 first downs were the least since Albany only picked up 10 first downs on Oct. 3, 2015. Then against Lafayette on Sept. 30, Holy Cross limited the Leopards to just 220 total yards, including -6 rushing yards. Through the first six contests of the 2017 campaign, the Crusaders are now holding their opponents to 23.0 points, 17.3 first downs and 373.0 yards per game.

QUICK HITS: In the polls released on Sept. 18, Holy Cross was ranked 25th in the nation in the Stats FCS Poll and the FCS Coaches Poll ... On Sept. 16, **Dr. Eddie Anderson**, **Dennis Golden** (Class of 1963) and **David Murphy** (Class of 1990) were honored as the seventh class in the Crusader Football Legends Ring of Honor. With the addition of Anderson, Golden and Murphy, a total of 25 former Crusaders are now included in the Ring of Honor ... Freshman wide out **Tenio Ayeni** scored the first two touchdowns of his collegiate career against Monmouth, while totaling 89 yards on four receptions ... Holy Cross' 51 points scored against New Hampshire on Sept. 16 were its most in a home game since defeating Sacred Heart 52-21 at Fitton Field on Sept. 12, 2009 ... Junior wide receiver **Martin Dorsey** posted career highs with five receptions for 165 yards and two touchdowns during the victory over New Hampshire. His 86-yard touchdown reception against the Wildcats was Holy Cross' longest play from scrimmage since Erreick Stewart threw an 86-yard touchdown pass to Steve Green against Colgate on Nov. 20, 1999 ... Senior wide receiver **Blaise Bell** posted career highs with 10 catches and 129 receiving yards in the season opener at UConn. During his career as a Crusader, he has now caught 51 passes for 624 yards and seven touchdowns ... Senior cornerback **Alim Muhammad** recorded a career-high 12 tackles and two pass breakups during the season opener at Connecticut. On the season, he has now totaled 25 tackles, an interception and three pass breakups.

GAME #1

CONNECTICUT 27, HOLY CROSS 20

August 31, 2017 • East Hartford, Conn.

UConn's Nate Hopkins carried the ball 20 times for 130 yards and three touchdowns, to lead the Huskies to a 27-20 victory over Holy Cross at Pratt and Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. UConn scored 20 unanswered points in the second half to rally for the win. Hopkins began the comeback with a three-yard touchdown run late in the third quarter, before an 11-yard pass from Bryant Shirreffs to Hergy Mayala gave the Huskies a 21-20 lead. Hopkins then concluded the scoring with a one-yard scoring run in the fourth quarter. Holy Cross had opened the game by jumping out to a 20-7 halftime lead. The Crusaders scored two touchdowns in the second quarter, on a 19-yard pass from Peter Pujals to Blaise Bell and a six-yard run by Diquan Walker. Pujals completed 33 of 56 passes on the evening for 358 yards and a touchdown. Bell finished the night with a career-high 10 receptions for a team-best 129 yards and a score, while Richie DeNicola added 10 catches for 87 yards. Ryan Brady led the Crusader defense with a career-best 14 total tackles, and Alim Muhammad finished with a career-high 12 tackles and two pass breakups. A.J. Wells scored the first eight points of his collegiate career, hitting field goals of 20 and 25 yards along with two extra points. The crowd of 24,435 was the largest to witness a Holy Cross football game since 2002, when 28,063 fans attended the game at Army.

The Holy Cross defense posted its first shutout since 2015 and allowed only 214 total yards, as the Crusaders recorded a 20-0 victory over Bucknell at Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium. Holy Cross forced three first half turnovers, setting the offense up in Bucknell territory each time. The Crusaders took advantage with a two-yard touchdown run by Diquan Walker and a pair of field goals by A.J. Wells to build a 13-0 halftime lead.
