The Holy Cross football team plays its second straight road game this week, when it heads to Harvard for a 7:00 p.m. contest on Friday, Oct. 12. The game between the Crusaders and the Crimson will be shown live on ESPN+, and can be heard live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross stands 1-5 this year with an 0-2 mark in Patriot League play. The Crusaders' one win was an impressive 31-28 overtime victory over defending Ivy League champion Yale, in which they rallied from 14 points down in the final five minutes of the fourth quarter.

Senior quarterback **Geoff Wade** has led the Holy Cross offense by completing 79 of 134 passes for 860 yards and five touchdowns this season, in addition to carrying the ball 52 times for 116 yards and a score. Junior running back **Domenic Cozier** has added a team-high 272 rushing yards and two touchdowns on 59 carries, while senior wide out **Martin Dorsey** has caught 22 passes for 260 yards and a score.

On the defensive side of the ball, senior linebacker **Ryan Brady** leads the team with 70 tackles, two quarterback sacks and 11 tackles for loss. Brady currently ranks sixth in the nation in tackles and 26th in tackles for loss. Sophomore defensive back **Joe Lang** has added 45 tackles, two quarterback sacks and two pass breakups, while junior defensive back **Alex Johnson** has 36 tackles, one interception and two pass breakups.

Harvard stands 2-2 on the year with a 1-1 mark in the Ivy League. After opening the season with victories over San Diego (36-14) and Brown (31-17), the Crimson have dropped their last two games to Rhode Island (23-16) and Cornell (28-24).

Sophomore quarterback Jake Smith has led the Harvard offense by hitting on 60 of 99 passes for 650 yards and two touchdowns with four interceptions. Sophomore tailback Aaron Shampklin has rushed 71 times for 527 yards and five scores, while senior wide out Justice Shelton-Mosley has a team-best 24 receptions for 299 yards. Defensively, junior linebacker Jordan Hill has totaled 25 tackles with one tackle for loss, and senior defensive back Cole Thompson has posted 25 tackles and an interception. Head coach Tim Murphy is in his 25th season at the helm of the Harvard program, where he has a record of 170-73. Murphy's career record stands at 202-118-1, including five seasons as the head coach at Cincinnati and two years as head coach at Maine.

Saturday's game will be the 70th all-time meeting between the teams, with Harvard leading the series 42-25-2. The Crimson own a 34-17-2 advantage for games played in Cambridge, winning seven straight.

After the contest at Harvard, Holy Cross will have a week off before playing host to Lehigh at 1:05 p.m. as part of Family Weekend on Saturday, Oct. 27.

2018 HOLY CROSS FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

HEAD COACH BOB CHESNEY: Bob Chesney is in his first year as the Crusaders' head coach in 2018. The 28th head coach in the history of the program, he has posted a winning record in each of his eight seasons as a collegiate head coach. A two-time Northeast-10 Conference Coach of the Year, Chesney's career record stands at 68-30, including five seasons at Assumption (44-16, 2013-2017) and three years at Salve Regina (23-9, 2010-2012). He took over an Assumption program that had posted two winning seasons in the 17 years prior to his arrival and led the Greyhounds to five-straight winning records and three NCAA Tournament appearances. Chesney previously rebuilt a Salve Regina program which had a streak of eight-consecutive losing seasons before his tenure, posting three winning campaigns in a row. Chesney is a 2000 graduate of Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pa., where he was a two-time All-Centennial Conference selection as a defensive back.

CAPSIS LEADS THE CHARGE UP FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Teddy Capsis** continues to be one of Holy Cross' top players in the trenches this season. In the Bucknell game, he totaled six tackles with two quarterback sacks, three tackles for loss and a pass breakup. Previously against Yale, Capsis recorded six tackles with a sack and two tackles for loss. On the season, he has now posted 22 tackles with a team-best three sacks and six tackles for loss. Last season, Capsis earned second team All-Patriot League honors after totaling 33 tackles, six quarterback sacks and nine tackles for loss. Over the course of his career with the Crusaders, he has recorded 98 tackles, 13 sacks and 19 tackles for loss.

Geoff Wade hit on 23 of 35 passes for 244 yards and two touchdowns, as Holy Cross knocked off No. 20 Harvard 27-17 at Fitton Field. The Crusader defense held the Crimson to just 245 yards of total offense on the afternoon, while sacking the quarterback six times. Kyle Young led the way with eight total tackles, including two quarterback sacks and two forced fumbles. Ryan Smith finished the game with four tackles, two sacks and a forced fumble, while Brett Laurie added three tackles, two tackles for loss, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. On the offensive side of the ball, Domenic Cozier rushed 16 times for a career-high 112 yards, while Brendan Flaherty finished with eight receptions for 96 yards and a touchdown. Harvard opened the scoring at the 8:15-mark of the first quarter on a 14-yard touchdown run by Noah Reimers. The Crusaders responded on their next possession with a 32-yard scoring strike from Wade to Flaherty on a fourth-down play. Holy Cross pulled in front on a three-yard touchdown pass from Wade to Jake Wieczorek, then increased its lead to 21-7 when Young forced a fumble on a sack, and Laurie recovered in the end zone. The Crimson responded in the second quarter with a 12-yard touchdown pass from Tom Stewart to Brian Dunlap and a 37-yard Jake McIntyre field goal, and the Crusaders led 21-17 at halftime. The Holy Cross defense then pitched a shutout in the second half, while holding Harvard to just 27 total yards and three first downs after the intermission. Zane Wasp hit a 44-yard field goal in the third quarter and a 41-yard field goal in the fourth quarter to conclude the scoring.

DORSEY SHINES IN THE PASS GAME: Senior wide receiver **Martin Dorsey** continues to be one of the top options in the Holy Cross pass game this season. During the Bucknell game, Dorsey caught 10 passes for 167 yards, to set new career highs in both categories. In addition, his 167 receiving yards were also the ninth-most ever by a Holy Cross player in a single game. On the season, Dorsey now leads the team with 22 receptions for 260 yards and a touchdown. His top game last season came against New Hampshire, when he caught five passes for 165 yards and two scores. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Dorsey has totaled 66 catches for 856 yards and four touchdowns.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: The 2017 campaign marks the 123rd season of Holy Cross football. The Crusaders currently own an overall record of 629-525-54, good for a .543 winning percentage. Prior to the start of the 2018 season, Holy Cross' 628 all-time victories ranked as the 14th most among all FCS schools. Holy Cross has had 31 first team All-America selections, sent 69 players on to professional football, won five Lambert Cups, claimed six Patriot League championships, and was named the Division I-AA Team of the Year in 1987. The Crusaders also played in the 1946 Orange Bowl, losing to host Miami on the game's final play.

QUICK HITS: On Sept. 15, **Bill McGovern** (Class of 1985) and **Rob McGovern** (Class of 1989) were honored as the ninth class in the Crusader Football Legends Ring of Honor. With the addition of the McGovern brothers, a total of 27 former Crusaders are now included in the Ring of Honor ... Senior wide receiver **Blaise Bell** currently ranks second on the team with 21 receptions for 171 yards so far this season. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, he has caught 84 passes for 959 yards and 10 touchdowns ... The Crusaders were picked to finish in fourth place in the 2018 preseason poll of the Patriot League's head coaches and sports information directors ... Former Crusader offensive lineman **James Murray** is currently on the practice squad of the Kansas City Chiefs in the National Football League.

HOLY CROSS 31, YALE 28 (OT)

September 15, 2018 • Worcester, Mass.

Derek Ng booted a 45-yard field goal in overtime to break a 28-28 tie and lift Holy Cross to a 31-28 victory over Yale at Fitton Field. Yale had the ball first in overtime and reached the Holy Cross five-yard line, where it faced fourth-and-goal. The Bulldogs went for it, but Zane Dudek was tackled for a loss by Ryan Brady and Corey Stefanik. The Crusaders then took over on the 25-yard line, and after running the ball three times Ng kicked the game-winning field goal. Yale had opened the game by jumping out to an early 21-0 lead in the first quarter, before Holy Cross put its first points on the board with a 30-yard scoring run by Miles Alexander. After recovering the ensuing onside kick, the Crusaders marched 48 yards in six plays to make the score 21-14 on a one-yard touchdown run by Geoff Wade. The Bulldogs responded with a 20-yard touchdown pass from Kurt Rawlings to Reed Klubnik early in the second quarter, and led 28-14 at halftime. The score remaining the same until the fourth quarter, when Wade hit Martin Dorsey with a 29-yard scoring strike to trim the deficit to 28-21 with 4:32 left. After the defense forced Yale to punt on its next possession, Wade found Spencer Gilliam for a 30-yard touchdown with 52 seconds left to play, forcing overtime. Wade hit on 17 of 28 passes for 242 yards and two scores on the afternoon, while rushing the ball 11 times for 70 yards and a touchdown. Joe Lang finished the day with 11 tackles, a sack and a pass breakup, while Brady added 11 tackles and one tackle for loss. The Bulldogs were led by Dudek with 217 rushing yards on 22 carries.

Ryan Brady made a career-high 17 total tackles, but the Crusaders were defeated by Dartmouth 34-14 at Fitton Field. Alex Johnson finished the game with a career-best 13 tackles, while back Joe Lang added eight tackles with one tackle for loss. On the offensive side of the ball, Geoff Wade hit on 20 of 31 passes for 196 yards and two scores. Dartmouth's Derek Kyler completed 25 of 35 attempts for 258 yards and three scores on the day, and Isiah Swan posted three tackles and three interceptions for the Big Green defense. Dartmouth moved the ball deep into Holy Cross territory on each of its first four possessions, but led just 6-0 midway through the second quarter as Connor Davis only made two of four field goal attempts. The Big Green then added a 25-yard scoring run by Caylin Parker, before Kyler hit Drew Estrada for a 17-yard touchdown with just three seconds left in the quarter to make the score 20-0 at halftime. In the second half, Dartmouth increased its lead to 34-0 as Kyler threw a pair of touchdown passes to Connor Rempel. The Crusaders put their first points on the board when Wade hit Derek Mountain for a 70-yard touchdown early in the fourth quarter. Tate Beachley then scored the final points of the day on a nine-yard scoring strike from Wade. The Big Green finished the game with 448 yards of total offense, in addition to holding the ball for 39:34. Holy Cross managed just 209 total yards and committed four turnovers.
