The Holy Cross football team will play its first home game of the season when it takes on Yale at Fitton Field on Saturday, Sept. 15. The game between the Crusaders and the Bulldogs will be televised live by Charter TV3 and the Patriot League Network, and can be heard live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

At halftime of the Holy Cross-Yale game, Bill McGovern and Rob McGovern will become the 26th and 27th individuals to be inducted into the Crusader Football Legends Ring of Honor. Saturday is also Faculty & Staff Appreciation Day, with tickets available to all Holy Cross faculty and staff for just \$8.00 each. In addition, the first 500 fans to enter Fitton Field will receive free Holy Cross phone wallets.

Holy Cross stands 0-2 so far this year, with an 0-1 mark in Patriot League play. After being edged by Colgate 24-17 in their season opener, the Crusaders dropped a 62-14 decision at Boston College last week.

Junior running back **Domenic Cozier** has led the Holy Cross offense with 151 yards from scrimmage and a pair of touchdowns. Cozier has carried the ball 24 times for 97 yards and a score, while catching five passes for 54 yards and a touchdown. Junior running back **Miles Alexander** has a team-high 106 rushing yards on 26 carries, while junior quarterback **Emmett Clifford** has hit on 20 of 34 passes for 152 yards and a score.

On the defensive side of the ball, senior linebacker **Ryan Brady** leads the team with 29 tackles with two quarterback sacks and eight tackles for loss. Sophomore defensive back **Joe Lang** has added 13 tackles and one tackle for loss, while senior defensive back **Corey Stefanik** has seven tackles, a quarterback sack, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

Yale went 9-1 overall last season and won the Ivy League title with a 6-1 mark in conference play. Junior quarterback Kurt Rawlings is expected to lead the Bulldog offense after completing 189 of 281 passes for 2,320 yards and 19 touchdowns last season, in addition to rushing 64 times for 226 yards and two scores. Sophomore tailback Zane Dudek is also back, after carrying the ball 159 times for 1,133 yards and 15 touchdowns in 2017. Senior defensive end J. Hunter Roman is the top returning tackler for Yale, after totaling 21 tackles, three quarterback sacks and six tackles for loss a year ago. The Bulldogs are led by head coach Tony Reno, who is entering his seventh season at Yale. Reon's career record stands at 33-27, including a 21-21 mark in Ivy League play.

Saturday's game will be the 33rd all-time meeting between the teams, with Yale leading the series 28-4. The Bulldogs have won 14 of the last 15 meetings, and own a perfect 7-0 record at Fitton Field

After the contest with Yale, Holy Cross will remain at home to face Dartmouth on Saturday, Sept. 22, at 1:05 p.m.

**THE SERIES WITH YALE:** This will be the 33rd meeting between the Crusaders and the Bulldogs on the gridiron, with Yale leading the all-time series 28-4. The Bulldogs have won 14 of the last 15 games played in the series, with the Crusaders' lone victory during that stretch being a 22-19 win in New Haven in 2005. For games played in Worcester, Yale owns a 7-0 all-time lead against Holy Cross. In the last meeting at Fitton Field, the Bulldogs posted a 38-17 win in 2007. The two schools first met on Oct. 14, 1903, when Yale won 36-10 in New Haven.

**HOLY CROSS AGAINST THE IVY LEAGUE:** The Crusaders stand 17-21 against Ivy League foes since the start of the 2004 season, including an 0-2 record last season. The 17-21 mark over the last 14 years includes an 8-5 record against Dartmouth, a 4-5 mark against Brown, a 4-8 record against Harvard and a 1-3 mark against Yale. Holy Cross' all time record against the Ivy League stands at 110-150-9 (31-25-3 against Brown, 6-2 vs. Columbia, 0-5 against Cornell, 37-39-4 vs. Dartmouth, 25-42-2 against Harvard, 3-2 vs. Pennsylvania, 3-7 against Princeton and 4-28 vs. Yale).

**GILLIAM CONTRIBUTES SPECIAL PLAYS:** Freshman wide receiver **Spencer Gilliam** received a pair of honors this week for his outstanding play on special teams. He was named the STATS FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week and the Patriot League Special Teams Player of the Week. During the Boston College game, Gilliam blocked a punt which was returned by freshman defensive back **Cristos Argys** for Holy Cross' first points of the day. Later, after junior defensive back **Macklin Kortebien** blocked a punt, he recovered the ball and carried it into the end zone for the Crusaders' second touchdown. Gilliam also returned three kickoffs for 49 yards and made two special teams tackles against the Eagles, one on kickoff coverage and one on punt coverage.

**BRADY MAKES BIG PLAYS:** Senior linebacker **Ryan Brady** has been the leader for the Holy Cross defense so far this season. Last week at Boston College, he made a career-high 15 tackles with a fumble recovery and four tackles for loss. Previously at Colgate, Brady recorded 14 tackles, two sacks and four tackles for loss. Overall this year, he has now totaled a team-best 29 tackles with two sacks, eight tackles for loss and a fumble recovery. In 11 games played last season, Brady finished with 110 tackles, four sacks and 10 tackles for loss. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 166 tackles, eight sacks and 22 tackles for loss.

**CRUSADERS BRING IN PRESEASON HONORS:** Four Holy Cross players received preseason honors heading into the 2018 campaign. Senior linebacker **Ryan Brady** was selected as a preseason third team All-American by HERO Sports. In addition, Brady was joined on the preseason All-Patriot League team by senior wide receiver **Blaise Bell**, senior defensive lineman **Teddy Capsis** and senior defensive lineman **Neil Vorster**.

## 2018 HOLY CROSS FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

**RING OF HONOR INDUCTIONS SET THIS WEEK:** Holy Cross will honor two individuals this season as the eighth class of the Crusader Football Legends Ring of Honor. **Bill McGovern** (Class of 1985) and **Rob McGovern** (Class of 1989) will be honored in a ceremony at the game against Yale on Sept. 15. Only former Crusader football players and coaches who have been elected to the Holy Cross Varsity Club Hall of Fame are eligible for this honor, which is an annual event each fall.

**CRUSADERS SET FOR HOME OPENER:** Holy Cross is now in its 123rd season of intercollegiate football. The Crusaders have been impressive in their opening home game of the season, posting an all-time mark of 80-34-7. Last season, Holy Cross defeated No. 9 New Hampshire 51-26 in its home opener. Following this year's 24-17 loss at Colgate, the Crusaders now stand at 71-43-9 in their season debuts overall, including a 6-9 record over the last 15 seasons.

**HEAD COACH BOB CHESNEY:** Bob Chesney is in his first year as the Crusaders' head coach in 2018. The 28th head coach in the history of the program, he has posted a winning record in each of his eight seasons as a collegiate head coach. A two-time Northeast-10 Conference Coach of the Year, Chesney's career record stands at 67-27, including five seasons at Assumption (44-16, 2013-2017) and three years at Salve Regina (23-9, 2010-2012). He took over an Assumption program that had posted two winning seasons in the 17 years prior to his arrival and led the Greyhounds to five-straight winning records and NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his last three years. Chesney previously rebuilt a Salve Regina program which had a streak of eight-consecutive losing seasons before his tenure, posting three winning campaigns in a row. Chesney is a 2000 graduate of Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pa., where he was a two-time All-Centennial Conference selection as a defensive back.

**BELL & BRADY SERVE AS CAPTAINS:** Holy Cross has two captains for the 2018 football season. Senior wide receiver **Blaise Bell** and senior linebacker **Ryan Brady** were named the team's captains by head coach Bob Chesney at the conclusion of preseason camp. These two players have taken over the leadership role from Nick McBeath, James Murray and Peter Pujals, who served as the Crusaders' captains during the 2017 season.

**TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE:** The 2017 campaign marks the 123rd season of Holy Cross football. The Crusaders currently own an overall record of 628-522-54, good for a .544 winning percentage. Prior to the start of the 2018 season, Holy Cross' 628 all-time victories ranked as the 14th most among all FCS schools. Holy Cross has had 31 first team All-America selections, sent 69 players on to professional football, won five Lambert Cups, claimed six Patriot League championships, and was named the Division I-AA Team of the Year in 1987. The Crusaders also played in the 1946 Orange Bowl, losing to host Miami on the game's final play.

**QUICK HITS:** Senior defensive end **Teddy Capsis** totaled six tackles with one tackle for loss during last week's game at Boston College. During his career with the Crusaders, he has now recorded 83 tackles, 10 sacks and 15 tackles for loss ... Senior wide receiver **Blaise Bell** led the squad currently leads the team with nine receptions for 56 yards so far this season. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, he has caught 72 passes for 844 yards and 10 touchdowns ... Senior wide receiver **Richie DeNicola** currently stands third on the team in receiving with four catches for 31 yards this year. During his career at Holy Cross, he now has 87 receptions for 885 yards and four touchdowns ... Junior quarterback **Emmett Clifford** has started the first two games of the season for the Crusaders, completing 20 of 34 passes for 152 yards and a touchdown ... Former Crusader offensive lineman **James Murray** is currently on the practice squad of the Kansas City Chiefs in the National Football League ... The Crusaders were picked to finish in fourth place in the 2018 preseason poll of the Patriot League's head coaches and sports information directors.

Yale quarterback Kurt Rawlings hit on 27 of 39 passes for 316 yards and two touchdowns, as the Bulldogs posted a 32-0 victory over Holy Cross at the Yale Bowl. Yale began the scoring with a 39-yard field goal by Alex Galland on its opening drive of the game. The Bulldogs then used a five-yard scoring strike from Rawlings to Michael Siragusa and a 21-yard Zane Dudek touchdown run to make the score 17-0 midway through the second quarter. In the final two minutes before halftime, Yale added a safety and a 33-yard touchdown pass from Rawlings to Siragusa to go in front 25-0 at the break. The Bulldogs then concluded the scoring with a 22-yard scoring run by Dudek in the third quarter. Yale finished with 452 yards of total offense on the day, while Holy Cross managed just 143 total yards. The Bulldogs also owned a 23-8 advantage in first downs, and held the ball for 37:37. The Crusaders were shut out for the first time since falling to Harvard 35-0 on Sept. 18, 2004, snapping a streak of 149 consecutive games in which they scored. Ryan Brady led the Holy Cross defense with a game-high nine tackles, while Corey Stefanik added seven tackles. Will McGrail punted 10 times for 377 yards on the afternoon, good for the fourth-most punting yards ever by a Holy Cross player in a single game.

## 2018 HOLY CROSS FOOTBALL GAME-BY-GAME RECAPS

### COLGATE 24, HOLY CROSS 17

*September 1, 2018 • Hamilton, N.Y.*

The Holy Cross defense allowed just 75 yards of total offense and no points in the second half, but the Crusaders were edged by Colgate 24-17 in their season opener at Andy Kerr Stadium. After trailing 24-0 at halftime, Corey Stefanik recovered a fumble on a punt return at the Colgate 22-yard line midway through the third quarter to give the Crusaders their best field position of the day. Derek Ng then booted a 28-yard field goal to put Holy Cross on the board. Early in the fourth quarter, Emmett Clifford hit Domenic Cozier for a 41-yard touchdown on a fourth-down play to make the score 24-10. After another big stop by the defense on the Raiders' next possession, the Crusaders drove 69 yards in 14 plays with Cozier scoring from one-yard out on fourth-and-goal to trim the margin to 24-17 with 6:59 left to play. But after gaining just one first down on its first four second-half possessions combined, Colgate picked up three first downs on its next drive to run out the clock and clinch the victory. Holy Cross finished the day with 169 rushing yards and 282 yards of total offense, in addition to picking up 17 first downs. The Raiders recorded 285 yards of total offense and 15 first downs, while scoring 17 of their points off three Crusader turnovers. Cozier totaled 108 yards from scrimmage in the game, with 54 rushing yards on 12 carries and five receptions for 54 yards. Ryan Brady recorded a game-high 14 tackles with three tackles for loss, while Stefanik added five tackles, a quarterback sack and a fumble recovery.

Spencer Gilliam blocked one punt and returned another blocked punt for a touchdown, as Holy Cross fell to Boston College 62-14 at Alumni Stadium. A.J. Dillon led the Eagles by rushing for 149 yards and three touchdowns on the afternoon and received the Capt. Edward J. O'Melia Trophy as the game's most valuable player. Ryan Brady led the Crusaders with 15 total tackles, three tackles for loss and a fumble recovery, while Domenic Cozier carried 12 times for a team-best 43 yards. Boston College opened the game by jumping out to a 21-0 lead on three first quarter scoring runs by Dillon. The Eagles added 13 more points in the second quarter to make the score 34-0 at the break, with a touchdown pass from E.J. Perry to Ben Glines and an interception return by Hamp Cheevers.
