The Holy Cross men's basketball team plays its second straight road game this week, heading to Army West Point for a 7:00 p.m. contest on Wednesday, Feb. 14. The game between the Crusaders and the Black Knights can be seen online through the Patriot League Network, and will also air live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross owns an overall record of 9-16 on the season with a 6-8 mark in the Patriot League. The Crusaders stand just 4-8 on the road this season, but have won their last three games away from home (including a 73-62 triumph at Boston University on Saturday). Holy Cross currently ranks second in the Patriot League in scoring defense (68.6 points per game) and turnover margin (+1.0 turnovers per game).

Junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has led the team by averaging 12.0 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game, while ranking fifth in the nation with a .677 field goal percentage. Freshman guard **Austin Butler** has also been playing well, with averages of 8.8 points and 3.1 rebounds per contest. Freshman guard **Caleb Green** has added 8.7 points, 2.9 assists and 2.5 boards per game, while freshman forward **Jacob Grandison** is chipping in with 8.0 points and 3.9 rebounds per contest.

Army currently stands 13-12 overall and owns a 6-8 mark in conference play. The Black Knights have lost five of their last six games, including a 68-59 setback against Navy on Saturday.

Junior guard Jordan Fox has led the team by averaging 14.2 points, 4.2 assists and 4.0 rebounds per game, while hitting 41.5 percent of his three-point attempts. Sophomore center Matt Wilson has added 12.5 points and 5.9 rebounds per game, while sophomore guard Tommy Funk has posted 10.1 points, 5.8 assists and 3.1 boards per contest.

After the contest with Army, Holy Cross will return home to face Bucknell at 12:05 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 17.

THE SERIES WITH ARMY: This will be the 87th meeting between the Crusaders and the Black Knights on the hardwood, with Holy Cross leading the all-time series 64-22. The Crusaders have won 27 out of the last 35 meetings in the series, but hold just an 8-6 edge over the last 14 contests. For games played at West Point, the Crusaders own a 26-15 advantage, with 13 victories in their last 16 visits. The schools first met on Feb. 22, 1926, with Army posting a 41-27 victory at West Point.

HOLY CROSS STAYS STRONG ON DEFENSE: The Crusaders are once again among the top defensive teams in the Patriot League this year. Through 25 games played, they have held their opponents to 68.6 points per contest on 44.2 percent shooting from the field, while forcing 13.2 turnovers per game. Over its last 19 games, Holy Cross has allowed just 66.3 points per contest on 42.3 percent shooting. Last year, the Crusaders limited their opponents to just 62.1 points per game overall and 61.3 points per contest in Patriot League regular season play.

CRUSADERS KEEP FORCING TURNOVERS: In 25 games played so far this year, Holy Cross has forced its opponents to commit 331 turnovers for an average of 13.2 turnovers per contest. During the victory over Harvard, the Crusaders forced 23 turnovers. Previously at Sacred Heart, Holy Cross caused the Pioneers to give the ball away 20 times. That marked the first time the Crusaders forced at least 20 turnovers in back-to-back games since they accomplished the feat against Harvard (24 turnovers) and Brown (23 turnovers) in the first two games of the 2014-2015 season. Last year, Holy Cross led the Patriot League and ranked 20th in the nation by forcing 15.9 turnovers per game.

FLOYD MAKES PRESENCE FELT DOWN LOW: Junior forward Jehyve Floyd has been the top player for the Crusaders in the post this season. In 25 games played, he has averaged 12.0 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.0 blocks while hitting 67.7 percent of his shots from the floor. In the victory at Boston University, Floyd led the team with 18 points, five rebounds, four blocks and three assists. Previously at Loyola, he posted 14 points, six rebounds, five blocks and two assists. Floyd also played well against Lehigh, scoring 15 points on seven of seven shooting, to go along with nine rebounds, six blocks, four assists and two steals. A few of his other top games this year have come at American (career-high 22 points, six blocked shots, five rebounds), against Army (18 points, nine rebounds, four blocks), against Lafayette (17 points, six rebounds), at Lehigh (16 points, eight rebounds, four blocks), against La Salle (15 points, six rebounds), against Colgate (15 point, three rebounds), at Rhode Island (14 points, eight rebounds), at Fairleigh Dickinson (13 points, seven rebounds), at UMass (12 points, five rebounds), against Harvard (11 points, three rebounds), at Siena (10 points, seven rebounds), at Lafayette (10 points, five rebounds), against Albany (10 points, four rebounds, three blocks), against Iona (nine points, career-high 10 rebounds) and against New Hampshire (nine points, nine rebounds). Last season, Floyd averaged 2.3 points, 1.6 rebounds and 0.8 blocked shots in 31 games played. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has totaled 453 points, 236 rebounds, 96 blocks, 71 assists and 51 steals, while hitting 64.7 percent of his field goal attempts (200 of 309).

COACHES VS. BOSTON UNIVERSITY RECAP

Jehyve Floyd totaled 18 points, five rebounds, four blocked shots and three assists, to lead the Crusaders to a 73-62 victory over Boston University at Case Gymnasium on Feb. 10, 2018. Holy Cross made 48.3 percent of its field goal attempts and a season-best 94.1 percent of its free throws on the day. The Crusaders also held Boston University to 35.2 percent shooting from the floor, including just 20.0 percent from three-point range. Patrick Benzan finished the game with 15 points, four rebounds and two steals. Jacob Grandison added 14 points, five boards and two assists, while Austin Butler chipped in with 11 points, five rebounds and three assists. The Terriers were led by Tyler Scanlon with 19 points and eight rebounds. Holy Cross opened the game by jumping out to an early 8-3 lead after the first four minutes of play. Boston University responded with an 8-2 run to pull in front, and went on to take a 25-16 advantage with 6:47 left in the first half. But the Crusaders came back with a 16-4 spurt to close out the half, taking a 32-29 edge into the locker room. The game remained close early in the second half, and the score was tied at 39-39 with 16 minutes remaining. Holy Cross then scored 10 straight points to take the lead for good, with Floyd and Connor Niego both netting four points during that run. The Crusaders would eventually lead by as many as 15 points, and the Terriers would get no closer than seven points in the final five minutes before Holy Cross eventually posted an 11-point victory.

CRUSADERS HEAT UP ON OFFENSE: Holy Cross has shot the ball well so far this season, making 45.4 percent of its field goal attempts overall (588 of 1,295). The Crusaders have been even more effective over their last five games, making 49.5 percent (146 of 295) of their shots from the floor during that stretch. In the victory at American, Holy Cross made a season-best 59.5 percent of its field goal attempts (22 of 37). The Crusaders also hit 55.9 percent of their shots from the floor in the win over Lafayette (33 of 59) and 54.2 percent of their field goal attempts in the victory at Loyola (26 of 48). The last time Holy Cross made over 45 percent of its field goal attempts for an entire season came during the 2002-2003 campaign (46.2 percent, 759 of 1643).

GRANDISON PLAYS KEY MINUTES ON THE PERIMETER: Freshman forward **Jacob Grandison** has become a key part of the Holy Cross rotation this season. In 25 games played, Grandison has averaged 8.0 points and 3.9 rebounds per contest. During the victory at Boston University, he totaled 14 points, five rebounds and two assists. Previously at Loyola, Grandison led the team with a career-high 21 points, five rebounds and two assists, while hitting seven of 10 field goals, three of our three-pointers and four of five free throws. He also played well against Lehigh, posting 13 points and six rebounds. A few of Grandison's other top games this season have come against Iona (14 points, two rebounds), at Bucknell (13 points, nine rebounds, two assists), against Loyola (11 points, seven rebounds), against Colgate (10 points, three rebounds) and against Army (nine points). Grandison came to Holy Cross from Phillips Exeter Academy in Exeter, N.H., where he earned third team Class A All-New England honors last season.

CARMODY LEADS THE CRUSADERS: Bill Carmody is in his third season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2017-2018, with an overall record of 39-53. He owns a career record of 323-298, and earned his 300th career victory with a 63-52 win at Harvard on Nov. 22, 2016. In 2015-2016, Carmody led the Crusaders to their first Patriot League Tournament title since 2007 and their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1953. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, he has 35 years of Division I coaching experience, including 20 seasons as a head coach (with 13 years at Northwestern and four seasons at Princeton). Carmody has led his teams to nine postseason tournament appearances — three trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament.

THE LAST MEETING

Jacob Grandison hit a pair of three-point field goals on back-to-back possessions in the final two minutes, as the Crusaders defeated Army West Point 70-66 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Jan. 17, 2018. Army held a 64-62 lead with less than two minutes to play, before Grandison's three-pointers put Holy Cross up 68-64 with 38.2 seconds remaining. After the Black Knights trimmed the margin to 68-66, Patrick Benzan knocked down both ends of a one-and-one with 18.9 seconds on the clock to secure the win. The game was close early on, with the Crusaders holding a 9-8 lead at the 15:17-mark of the first half. Holy Cross then went on a 25-5 run to take a 21-point lead (34-13) with 6:25 left before the break. Army would later close out the half with a 10-2 spurt, and the Crusaders led by 11 (41-30) heading into the locker room. Holy Cross was still up by 11 (52-41) with 11:53 remaining, when the Black Knights scored 10 straight points to make it a 52-51 game. Neither team would lead by more than four points the rest of the way, before the Crusaders eventually pulled out the victory. Jehyve Floyd led Holy Cross with 18 points, nine rebounds and four blocked shots on the night, while hitting seven of nine field goal attempts. Caleb Green finished with 15 points, four rebounds and two assists, while Karl Charles added 11 points, five assists and two rebounds. The Black Knights were led by Matt Wilson with 17 points and seven rebounds. As a team, Holy Cross made 50.0 percent of its field goal attempts, 40.7 percent of its three-pointers and 75.0 percent of its free throws on the night. Army was able to connect on 42.1 percent of its shots from the floor and 39.3 percent of its attempts from beyond the arc. The Crusaders also posted a season-low six turnovers.

BENZAN PLAYS KEY MINUTES IN BACKCOURT: Junior guard **Patrick Benzan** is one of the leaders in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 22 games played, he has averaged 6.5 points, 3.2 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.0 steals per contest. During the victory at Boston University, Benzan recorded 15 points, four rebounds and two steals, while hitting nine of 10 free throw attempts. Previously at Siena, he led the team with 12 points and five rebounds. Benzan also played well against La Salle, totaling 13 points, five rebounds and two assists. A few of his other top games this season have come against Harvard (career-high 18 points, seven rebounds, three assists, three steals), Sacred Heart (14 points, three rebounds, two assists) and against Albany (13 points, two rebounds). In 2016-2017, Benzan averaged 7.6 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.4 steals per game, while hitting 51.4 percent of his field goal attempts. During last year's game at Army, Benzan totaled 16 points, eight assists, five rebounds and three steals. He also played well at Bucknell last season, recording 15 points, three rebounds and two steals. Over the course of his collegiate career, Benzan has now totaled 408 points, 174 rebounds, 132 assists and 72 steals.

PROTECTING THE BALL: Holy Cross has done an excellent job of protecting the ball so far this year. The Crusaders have turned the ball over just 306 times in 25 games played, for an average of 12.2 turnovers per contest. Holy Cross has posted single-digit turnovers seven times this year, with a season-low of six against Army West Point. This should come as no surprise, as the Crusaders have had the fewest turnovers per game in the Patriot League in each of the last three seasons (11.0 in 2016-2017; 11.0 in 2015-2016; 10.9 in 2014-2015). In 2014-2015, Holy Cross set a school single-season record for the fewest turnovers per game.

BUTLER BECOMING A FORCE ON THE WING: Freshman guard **Austin Butler** is developing into one of the Crusaders' top players on the perimeter. In 24 games played this year, Butler has averaged 8.8 points and 3.1 rebounds, while hitting 32.7 percent of his three-point attempts. He has been even more impressive in Patriot League play, averaging 10.9 points and 4.1 boards against conference foes. During the victory at Boston University, Butler posted 11 points, five rebounds and three assists. Previously at Loyola, he totaled 10 points, seven rebounds and three steals. Butler also played well against Lafayette, leading the team with a career-high 28 points and four rebounds, while hitting 11 of 15 field goal attempts. Some of his other top performances this season have come at Lehigh (22 points, five rebounds), against New Hampshire (16 points), against Colgate (14 points, six rebounds, four assists), at Bucknell (13 points, six rebounds), against Lehigh (12 points, four assists), against Iona (12 points), against Loyola (12 points), against Boston University (11 points, six rebounds) and against Harvard (10 points). Butler came to Holy Cross from Greater Latrobe Senior High School in Latrobe, Pa., where he averaged 29.2 points, 6.6 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game as a senior.

HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 378-162 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including a 5-6 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 36 out of 42 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 164-70 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 107-41 record against Patriot League foes.

GREEN STARTS CAREER STRONG: Freshman guard **Caleb Green** has become a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 25 games played, Green has averaged 8.7 points, 2.9 assists and 2.5 rebounds. In the victory at Loyola, he posted 12 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals. Previously at American, Green totaled 15 points, four assists and two rebounds. He also had a huge day at Fairleigh Dickinson, leading the team with a career-high 22 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals. A few of Green's other top games this season have come against Army (15 points, four rebounds), at Rhode Island (14 points, career-high 11 assists, five rebounds), at Sacred Heart (12 points, three rebounds, two assists), against New Hampshire (12 points, two assists), against Harvard (12 points, two rebounds), against Manhattan (11 points, three rebounds, two steals), at Lafayette (11 points, three rebounds) and at UMass (10 points, three rebounds, two assists). His 12 points against Sacred Heart in the season opener were the most by a Crusader in his collegiate debut since Cullen Hamilton scored 15 points at Old Dominion on Nov. 9, 2012. Green came to Holy Cross from Proctor Academy in Andover, N.H., where he was two-time second team Class AA All-New England selection and scored over 1,000 career points.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 98th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,399-984, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 10 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

FLOYD SHOOTS THE LIGHTS OUT: Junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has been hot from the field, making 42 of 54 field goal attempts over the last six games (77.8 percent). That included a school-record stretch of 20 consecutive made field goal attempts from Jan. 22-Feb. 3. Floyd's top shooting performance came against Lafayette on Jan. 27, when he hit all eight of his shots from the floor to tie the Holy Cross single-game record for the best field goal percentage. The only other players in school history to hit 100.0 percent of their attempts from the floor with at least eight shots made are Ernie Floyd (10 of 10 against Notre Dame on Jan. 6, 1984) and Aaron Jordan (eight of eight vs. Lafayette on Feb. 6, 1991). Floyd's mark also tied the all-time Hart Center record for the best single-game field goal percentage in the building's history.

HOLY CROSS IN THE NCAA STATISTICS: The Crusaders are currently ranked among the NCAA Division I leaders in four statistical categories, through games of Feb. 11. In addition, junior forward **Karl Charles** and junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** stand among the best in the nation in individual categories. The rankings:

CRUSADERS PICKED EIGHTH IN PRESEASON POLL: In the 2017-2018 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in eighth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. The Crusaders received 48 total points in the conference preseason poll. Bucknell placed first in the poll, with 162 total points and 18 first-place votes, followed by Boston University in second with 141 points and two first-place votes, and Navy in third with 120 points. Lehigh placed fourth with 108 points, while Colgate was fifth (104 points), Loyola (Md.) was sixth (78 points) and Army West Point was seventh (66 points). The preseason rankings were rounded out by American (ninth, 39 points) and Lafayette (10th, 27 points).

MILLER MAKES HIS WAY TO THE NBA: Former Crusader **Malcolm Miller** (Class of 2015) made his National Basketball Association debut for the Toronto Raptors against the Charlotte Hornets on Dec. 22. Miller then scored his first career points when he hit a pair of three-pointers against the Cleveland Cavaliers on Jan. 11. In three games played this season, he has now totaled six points and two rebounds. Miller is the first Crusader to appear in an NBA regular season game since Garry Witts played for the Washington Bullets in the 1981-1982 season. During his career with the Crusaders from 2011-2015, Miller posted 1,013 points, 532 rebounds, 164 assists, 143 blocked shots and 93 steals.

FRESHMEN STEP INTO KEY ROLES: Holy Cross has six freshmen on its roster this season, who have combined to make a huge impact on the court. The freshman class has played 51.0 percent of the team's minutes so far this year, while scoring 51.1 percent of the Crusaders' points. In addition, five different freshman have at least one game in which they have scored in double figures this season.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS: Junior forward **Karl Charles** and junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** are presently ranked among Holy Cross' all-time leaders in various statistical categories. Charles currently stands eighth in career average minutes played (29.7), while Floyd ranks ninth in career blocked shots (96).

HOLY CROSS KNOCKS DOWN SHOTS FROM LONG RANGE: The Crusaders have been a solid three-point shooting team this season, hitting 169 shots from beyond the arc for an average of 6.8 treys per game. Holy Cross has picked things up over its last 17 games, making 11 or more three-pointers in a game five times. The Crusaders hit a season-high 12 three-pointers against both Lehigh and Iona, while draining 11 shots from three-point range against Army, Colgate and New Hampshire. The production from long range has been balanced, as seven different Holy Cross players have already made at least 10 three-pointers so far this season.

DRIBBLES: During the Feb. 10 game at Boston University, the Crusaders coaching staff wore blue puzzle piece pins as part of Coaches Powering Forward for Autism benefiting Autism Speaks ... At the Jan. 27 game against Lafayette, members of the Holy Cross coaching staff took part in Coaches vs. Cancer Suits & Sneakers Week ... Freshman guard **Kyle Copeland** scored a career-high nine points at Navy, hitting three of four attempts from three-point range. On the season, he is averaging 1.9 points in 14 games played ... Freshman forward **Matt Faw** scored a career-high 12 points during the victory over Harvard, then tallied 11 points at Lehigh. He is averaging 3.9 points and 1.6 rebounds on the season, while hitting 43.8 percent of his three-point attempts ... Junior guard **Matt Zignorski** scored 10 points on three-of-four shooting from three-point range during the Rhode Island game. On the season, he is currently averaging 3.5 points per game ... Freshman forward **Connor Niego** tallied nine points and two rebounds at Rhode Island in the first appearance of his collegiate career, then scored a career-high 11 points at Siena. On the year, he has averaged 3.1 points and 2.1 boards ... Sophomore guard **Clayton Le Sann** scored a season-high seven points against Navy on Feb. 7. Overall this year, he is averaging 1.6 points per game ... With the 69-64 victory at Sacred Heart, Holy Cross improved to 69-30 all-time in season openers ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2007 through 2010, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 97 percent, tied for the 14th-best mark among all Division I schools ... Holy Cross has received an NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award in each of the last 12 seasons, for having a multi-year APR in the top 10 percent of all Division I men's basketball teams in the nation.
