The Holy Cross men's basketball team will be back at home on Sunday, Jan. 14, for a Turnpike Trophy match-up with Boston University at 1:05 p.m. The contest between the Crusaders and the Terriers will be shown by Stadium and the Patriot League Network, and can be heard live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross owns an overall record of 4-12 on the season with a 1-4 mark in the Patriot League. The Crusaders have dropped six of their last seven games, and are coming off a 61-56 overtime loss at Navy on Thursday.

Junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has led the team by averaging 10.8 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.1 blocks per game, while leading the league with a .675 field goal percentage. Junior forward **Karl Charles** is also off to a strong start this year, with averages of 10.5 points, 2.7 assists, 2.3 rebounds and 1.5 steals per contest. Freshman guard **Caleb Green** has added 8.9 points, 2.8 assists and 2.4 boards per game, while freshman guard **Austin Butler** is chipping in with 8.1 points and 2.5 rebounds per contest.

Boston University currently stands 8-8 overall and is tied for first place in the Patriot League with a 4-1 mark in conference play. The Terriers have won four of their last five games, including a 72-58 victory over Colgate on Thursday night.

Senior guard Cedric Hankerson has led the team by averaging 14.7 points, 3.4 rebounds and 1.4 steals per game, while hitting 32.0 percent of his three-point attempts. Sophomore forward Max Mahoney has added 12.7 points and 5.1 boards per contest, while sophomore forward Tyler Scanlon is chipping in with 9.6 points, 5.4 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game.

After the contest with Boston University, the Crusaders will remain at home for a 7:05 p.m. game with Army West Point on Wednesday, Jan. 17.

THE SERIES WITH BOSTON UNIVERSITY: This will be the 72nd meeting between the Crusaders and the Terriers on the hardwood, with Holy Cross leading the all-time series 53-18. Boston University has won six of the last eight meetings between the schools, including a sweep of the season series last year. For games played in Worcester, Holy Cross holds a 32-9 advantage, but the Crusaders are only 7-6 against the Terriers at the Hart Center. The schools first met on January 10, 1903, with Holy Cross posting a 33-4 victory in Worcester.

BUTLER BECOMING A FORCE ON THE WING: Freshman guard **Austin Butler** is developing into one of the Crusaders' top players on the perimeter. In 15 games played this year, Butler has averaged 8.1 points and 2.5 rebounds, while hitting 35.4 percent of his three-point attempts. He has been even more impressive in Patriot League play, averaging 12.8 points and 3.8 boards against conference foes. During the victory over Loyola, Butler led the team with 12 points and two steals. Previously at Lehigh, he totaled a career-high 22 points, five rebounds and two assists. Butler also played well against Colgate, posting 14 points, six rebounds and four assists. Some of his other top performances this season have been against New Hampshire (16 points, two assists, two steals), against Iona (12 points, two rebounds, two assists) and against Harvard (10 points, two rebounds, two assists). Butler came to Holy Cross from Greater Latrobe Senior High School in Latrobe, Pa., where he averaged 29.2 points, 6.6 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game as a senior.

THE TURNPIKE TROPHY: Throughout the 2017-2018 academic year, Holy Cross and Boston University will be competing for the third annual Turnpike Trophy. This athletic series between the in-state Patriot League rivals awards points for all head-to-head victories in both the regular season and postseason, with the Turnpike Trophy going to the school which accumulates the most points at the end of the year. Entering this week, the Terriers hold a 5-2 lead in the competition. In addition to the men's basketball game, the schools will also meet in women's basketball on Jan. 13.

CHARLES ENJOYING ANOTHER STELLAR SEASON: Junior forward **Karl Charles** is once again a key player for the Crusaders this year. In 15 games played, Charles has averaged 10.5 points, 2.7 assists, 2.3 rebounds and 1.5 steals, while making 76.8 percent of his free throw attempts. In the Navy game, he led the team with 10 points, four rebounds and two assists. Previously against Loyola, Charles recorded 11 points, three rebounds and two assists. He also played well at Lehigh, tallying 11 points, four steals, three assists and two rebounds. A few of Charles' other top performances this season have come at Sacred Heart (23 points, four rebounds, three assists), at Fairleigh Dickinson (17 points, four assists, three rebounds, three steals), against Albany (16 points, two assists), at Lafayette (13 points, four rebounds), against Colgate (11 points, two rebounds) and against New Hampshire (10 points, five assists, four rebounds, two steals). Last year, Charles averaged 9.4 points, 3.7 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.6 steals, while hitting 80.5 percent of his free throws and 37.5 percent of his three-pointers. As a freshman, he was named to the Patriot League All-Rookie team after averaging 10.6 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 1.1 steals and 0.5 blocks per game, while hitting 79.2 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his collegiate career, Charles has totaled 830 points, 286 rebounds, 244 assists and 111 steals with a .793 free throw percentage (268 of 338).

NAVY RECAP

George Kiernan scored five of his game-high 13 points in overtime, to lead Navy to a 61-56 victory over the Crusaders at Alumni Hall on Jan. 11, 2018. Navy hit just 39.1 percent of its field goal attempts on the night, but held a 34-29 rebounding advantage and a 25-12 edge in free throw attempts. Holy Cross also struggled shooting the ball, making only 38.0 percent of its shots from the floor. Karl Charles led the Crusaders with 10 points, four rebounds and two assists. Jacob Grandison added nine points, a career-best nine rebounds and five assists, while Kyle Copeland scored a career-high nine points. The game was close for the majority of the first half, and Holy Cross held a 20-19 lead with 3:17 left before the break. The Midshipmen then went on a 10-0 run to pull in front, and eventually held a 29-23 advantage at halftime. The Crusaders came out playing outstanding defense to start the second half, using an 8-0 spurt over the first six minutes to claim a 31-29 lead. The score stayed close for the next several minutes, and Holy Cross was up 43-42 with 3:28 left in regulation. Navy scored the next five points to pull ahead, and held a 48-45 lead with less than a minute to play. Patrick Benzan then converted a three-point play with 50.8 seconds left to tie the score at 48-48 and force overtime. The Crusaders went cold from the field in the extra session, missing their first three shots as the Midshipmen built a 55-48 lead. Holy Cross would get no closer than three points the rest of the way, as Navy hit six of eight free throws in the final minute to pull out the win.

FLOYD MAKES PRESENCE FELT DOWN LOW: Junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has been the top player for the Crusaders in the post this season. In 16 games played, he has averaged 10.8 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.1 blocks while hitting 67.5 percent of his shots from the floor. In the Lehigh game, Floyd posted a career-high 16 points, eight rebounds and four blocks, while hitting eight of 10 field goal attempts. Previously at Lehigh, he totaled 10 points and five rebounds. Floyd also played well against Colgate, leading the team with 15 points, three rebounds and two steals. A few of his other top games this year have come against La Salle (15 points, six rebounds), at Rhode Island (14 points, eight rebounds), at Fairleigh Dickinson (13 points, seven rebounds, two assists, two blocks), at UMass (12 points, five rebounds), against Harvard (11 points, three rebounds, two steals), at Siena (10 points, seven rebounds, two assists), against Albany (10 points, four rebounds, three blocks), against Iona (nine points, career-high 10 rebounds) and against New Hampshire (nine points, nine rebounds). Last season, Floyd averaged 2.3 points, 1.6 rebounds and 0.8 blocked shots in 31 games played. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has totaled 326 points, 184 rebounds, 64 blocks, 53 assists and 41 steals, while hitting 63.6 percent of his field goal attempts (145 of 228).

BENZAN PLAYS KEY MINUTES IN BACKCOURT: Junior guard **Patrick Benzan** is one of the leaders in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 16 games played, he has averaged 7.5 points, 3.6 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.1 steals per contest. During the Siena game, Benzan led the team with 12 points and five rebounds. Previously against La Salle, he totaled 13 points, five rebounds and two assists. Benzan also played well against Albany, recording 13 points and two rebounds. A few of his other top games this season have come against Harvard (career-high 18 points, seven rebounds, three assists, three steals) and Sacred Heart (14 points, three rebounds, two assists). In 2016-2017, Benzan averaged 7.6 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.4 steals per game, while hitting 51.4 percent of his field goal attempts. During last year's game at Army, Benzan totaled 16 points, eight assists, five rebounds and three steals. He also played well at Bucknell last season, recording 15 points, three rebounds and two steals. Over the course of his collegiate career, Benzan has now totaled 385 points, 161 rebounds, 123 assists and 68 steals.

Robert Champion scored a game-high 27 points, but it was not enough as Holy Cross was defeated by Boston University 71-68 in overtime at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Feb. 25, 2017. The game was close early on, and the Terriers held an 18-17 lead with 7:24 left in the first half. The Crusaders then went on an 11-3 spurt to claim the lead, including five points from Champion. Holy Cross eventually led by 10 points late in the half, before taking a 33-24 advantage into the locker room. Boston University started the second half on fire, hitting four straight three-pointers while going on a 22-6 run to pull in front. The Terriers would lead by as many as nine points (51-42), before the Crusaders used a quick 9-2 spurt to get back into the game. Two free throws by Champion with 2:40 remaining tied the game at 59-59, and neither

team scored again in regulation as the game went to overtime. Boston University started the extra session with an 8-3 spurt to pull in front, and was still up 69-64 with less than 30 seconds to play. A pair of foul shots by Champion and a layup by Patrick Benzan made the score 69-68, before Justin Alston hit two free throws to put the Terriers up 71-68. Holy Cross was unable to get a clean shot off on its final possession, as Boston University held on for the victory. The Crusaders made just 38.6 percent of their field goal attempts on the day, while the Terriers were able to connect on 47.8 percent of their shots from the floor and 46.7 percent from three-point range. Malachi Alexander finished the game with 12 points, five assists and four rebounds. Boston University was led by Tyler Scanlon with 19 points.

CARMODY LEADS THE CRUSADERS: Bill Carmody is in his third season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2016-2017, with an overall record of 34-49. He owns a career record of 318-294, and earned his 300th career victory with a 63-52 win at Harvard on Nov. 22, 2016. In 2015-2016, Carmody led the Crusaders to their first Patriot League Tournament title since 2007 and their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1953. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, he has 35 years of Division I coaching experience, including 20 seasons as a head coach (with 13 years at Northwestern and four seasons at Princeton). Carmody has led his teams to nine postseason tournament appearances — three trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament.

HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 376-159 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including a 3-3 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 36 out of 42 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 162-67 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 105-38 record against Patriot League foes.

CRUSADERS HEAT UP ON OFFENSE: Holy Cross has shot the ball well so far this season, making 45.1 percent of its field goal attempts overall (381 of 845). The Crusaders have connected on 50 percent of their shots from the floor in a game four times so far this year. Holy Cross hit 28 of 56 field goal attempts in the victory over Harvard, while making 24 of 48 shots in the Albany game, 32 of 64 attempts at Lehigh and 21 of 42 shots against Loyola (Md.). The last time the Crusaders made over 45 percent of their field goal attempts for an entire season came during the 2002-2003 campaign (46.2 percent, 759 of 1643).

GREEN STARTS CAREER STRONG: Freshman guard **Caleb Green** has become a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 16 games played, Green has averaged 8.9 points, 2.8 assists and 2.4 rebounds. In the Lafayette game, he posted 11 points and three rebounds. Previously against New Hampshire, Green totaled 12 points and two assists. He also played well at Fairleigh Dickinson, leading the team with a career-high 22 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals. A few of Green's other top games this season have come at Rhode Island (14 points, career-high 11 assists, five rebounds), at Sacred Heart (12 points, three rebounds, two assists), against Harvard (12 points, two rebounds), against Manhattan (11 points, three rebounds, two steals) and at UMass (10 points, three rebounds, two assists). His 12 points against Sacred Heart in the season opener were the most by a Crusader in his collegiate debut since Cullen Hamilton scored 15 points at Old Dominion on Nov. 9, 2012. Green came to Holy Cross from Proctor Academy in Andover, N.H., where he was two-time second team Class AA All-New England selection and scored over 1,000 career points.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 98th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,394-981, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 10 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

CRUSADERS KEEP FORCING TURNOVERS: In 16 games played so far this year, Holy Cross has forced its opponents to commit an average of 13.9 turnovers per contest. During the victory over Harvard, the Crusaders forced 23 turnovers. Previously at Sacred Heart, Holy Cross caused the Pioneers to give the ball away 20 times. That marked the first time the Crusaders forced at least 20 turnovers in back-to-back games since they accomplished the feat against Harvard (24 turnovers) and Brown (23 turnovers) in the first two games of the 2014-2015 season. Last year, Holy Cross led the Patriot League and ranked 20th in the nation by forcing 15.9 turnovers per game.

HOLY CROSS KNOCKS DOWN SHOTS FROM LONG RANGE: The Crusaders have been a strong three-point shooting team this season, hitting 33.6 percent of their attempts from beyond the arc (118 of 351). Holy Cross has picked things up over its last eight games, hitting 33.8 percent of its shots from deep during that span (66 of 195) while hitting 11 or more three-pointers four times. The Crusaders made a season-high 12 three-pointers against both Lehigh and Iona, while draining 11 shots from three-point range against Colgate and New Hampshire. The production from long range has been balanced, as seven different Holy Cross players have already made at least 10 three-pointers so far this season.

FRESHMEN STEP INTO KEY ROLES: Holy Cross has six freshmen on its roster this season, who have combined to make a huge impact on the court. The freshman class has played 49.1 percent of the team's minutes so far this year, while scoring 50.2 percent of the Crusaders' points. In addition, five different freshmen have at least one game in which they have scored in double figures this season.

HOLY CROSS STAYS STRONG ON DEFENSE: The Crusaders are once again among the top defensive teams in the Patriot League this year. Through 16 games played, they have held their opponents to 70.6 points per contest on 45.2 percent shooting from the field, while forcing 13.9 turnovers per game. Over its last 10 games, Holy Cross has allowed just 67.3 points per contest on 42.1 percent shooting. Last year, the Crusaders limited their opponents to just 62.1 points per game overall and 61.3 points per contest in Patriot League regular season play.

PROTECTING THE BALL: Holy Cross has done an excellent job of protecting the ball so far this year. The Crusaders have turned the ball over just 195 times in 16 games played, for an average of 12.2 turnovers per contest. Holy Cross has posted single-digit turnovers five times this year, with a season-low of seven against New Hampshire. This should come as no surprise, as the Crusaders have had the fewest turnovers per game in the Patriot League in each of the last three seasons (11.0 in 2016-2017; 11.0 in 2015-2016; 10.9 in 2014-2015). In 2014-2015, Holy Cross set a school single-season record for the fewest turnovers per game.

CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SIXTH PATRIOT LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON TITLE: During the 2017-2018 campaign, Holy Cross will attempt to win the Patriot League regular season title for the sixth time in school history. The last championship for the Crusaders came in 2006-2007, when they tied for first place in the conference with Bucknell, as both teams posted 13-1 records in league play. Prior to that, Holy Cross won outright Patriot League regular season titles in 2001, 2003 and 2005, while sharing the regular season championship in 1994. The Crusaders' five total championships are tied for the second-most in conference history with Navy (one outright, four shared), behind only Bucknell (eight outright, three shared).

IN THE RECORD BOOKS: Junior forward **Karl Charles** is presently ranked among Holy Cross' all-time leaders in two statistical categories. Charles currently stands ninth in career average minutes played (29.5) and 11th in career free throw percentage (.793, 268 of 338).

CRUSADERS PICKED EIGHTH IN PRESEASON POLL: In the 2017-2018 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in eighth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. The Crusaders received 48 total points in the conference preseason poll. Bucknell placed first in the poll, with 162 total points and 18 first-place votes, followed by Boston University in second with 141 points and two first-place votes, and Navy in third with 120 points. Lehigh placed fourth with 108 points, while Colgate was fifth (104 points), Loyola (Md.) was sixth (78 points) and Army West Point was seventh (66 points). The preseason rankings were rounded out by American (ninth, 39 points) and Lafayette (10th, 27 points).

CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SEVENTH PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT CROWN:

This year, Holy Cross will be looking to win the Patriot League Tournament for the seventh time in school history. Last year, the Crusaders captured their sixth Patriot League Tournament crown with a 59-56 victory at Lehigh on March 9, 2016. Holy Cross' previous tournament titles came in 2007 (74-66 over Bucknell), 2003 (72-64 over American), 2002 (58-54 at American), 2001 (68-64 over Navy in overtime) and 1993 (98-73 at Bucknell). Holy Cross' six conference tournament championships are the most in Patriot League history, with Bucknell (four in 2005, 2006, 2011 and 2013) ranking second. The Crusaders have also appeared in the championship game eight times in the last 16 years. Overall, Holy Cross has made a conference-record 11 appearances in the Patriot League championship game.

DRIBBLES: Freshman guard Kyle Copeland scored a career-high nine points at Navy, hitting three of four attempts from three-point range. On the season, he is averaging 2.3 points in six games played ... Freshman forward **Jacob Grandison** led the team with a career-high 14 points against Iona, then had 11 points and seven rebounds in the victory over Loyola (Md.). He is averaging 6.5 points and 3.3 boards per game this year ... Freshman forward **Matt Faw** scored a career-high 12 points during the victory over Harvard, then tallied 11 points at Lehigh. He is averaging 5.0 points and 1.6 rebounds on the season, while hitting 48.0 percent of his three-point attempts ... Junior guard **Matt Zignorski** scored 10 points on three-of-four shooting from three-point range during the Rhode Island game. On the season, he is currently averaging 3.3 points per game ... Freshman forward **Connor Niego** tallied nine points and two rebounds at Rhode Island in the first appearance of his collegiate career, then scored a career-high 11 points at Siena. On the year, he has averaged 3.8 points and 2.2 boards ... With the 69-64 victory at Sacred Heart, Holy Cross improved to 69-30 all-time in season openers ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2007 through 2010, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 97 percent, tied for the 14th-best mark among all Division I schools ... Holy Cross has received an NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award in each of the last 12 seasons, for having a multi-year APR in the top 10 percent of all Division I men's basketball teams in the nation.
