The Holy Cross men's basketball team will play its second straight home game when it faces Lafayette at 3:05 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 12. This will be Jersey Day at the Hart Center, with all children 12 and under who show up in a jersey receiving free admission. The contest between the Crusaders and the Leopards will be televised live by Charter TV3 and the Patriot League Network, and can be heard live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross stands 10-6 overall this year with a 1-2 mark in the Patriot League. The Crusaders have lost their last two games, including a 99-94 overtime setback against Lehigh on Wednesday night. Holy Cross leads the Patriot League in assists (17.6 assists per game), turnover margin (+3.0 turnovers per game) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.6-to-1).

Sophomore guard **Jacob Grandison** has led the team by averaging 15.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.7 assists per game, while sophomore guard **Austin Butler** has added 12.6 points and 4.0 boards per contest. Four other Crusaders are averaging at least six points, led by sophomore guard **Caleb Green** (12.1 points per game) and senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** (10.1 pointer per game).

Lafayette stands 4-10 overall this year with a 1-2 mark in Patriot League play. The Leopards are coming off an 85-70 victory over Loyola (Md.) on Wednesday, which snapped a three-game losing streak.

Sophomore guard Alex Petrie has led the team by averaging 13.6 points and 2.6 rebounds per game, while making 80.0 percent of his four shots. Sophomore guard Justin Jaworski is also off to a strong start this season, with averages of 13.1 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.4 assists per contest. Lafayette is led by head coach Fran O'Hanlon, who stands 318-383 in 24 seasons with the Leopards.

After the contest with Lafayette, the Crusaders will travel to Bucknell on Monday, Jan. 14, for a 7:00 p.m. game on the CBS Sports Network.

**THE SERIES WITH LAFAYETTE:** This will be the 67th meeting between the Crusaders and the Leopards on the hardwood, with Holy Cross leading the all-time series 38-28. The schools have split the regular season series in each of the last five seasons, with the home team winning eight straight games. Holy Cross holds a 23-9 advantage for games played in Worcester, including four straight wins. The schools first met on Feb. 4, 1947, with Holy Cross posting a 50-40 victory at the Boston Garden.

**GREEN LEADS FROM THE POINT:** Sophomore guard Caleb Green continues to be a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 16 games played, he has averaged 12.1 points, 4.1 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.4 steals per contest, while hitting 83.0 percent of his free throws. During the Lehigh game, Green led the team with a career-high 25 points, five rebounds and three assists. Previously at Loyola (Md.), he recorded 16 points, five assists and three steals. Green also played well at Iona, posting 16 points, five assists and three rebounds. A few of his other top performances this season have come at Massachusetts (17 points, six assists, four rebounds), against Rhode Island (16 points, eight assists, three steals), at Providence (13 points, four rebounds, three assists), against Sacred Heart (13 points, five assists), at Albany (12 points, seven rebounds, four assists), against Siena (12 points, five assists), at Harvard (12 points, three assists), against Stony Brook (10 points, six rebounds) and against Fairleigh Dickinson (10 points, six assists). In 31 games played last season, Green averaged 8.9 points, 2.9 assists and 2.4 rebounds, and hit 73.3 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 469 points, 155 assists, 127 rebounds and 48 steals.

**GRANDISON PLAYS KEY MINUTES ON THE PERIMETER:**

Sophomore guard Jacob Grandison is once again a key part of the Holy Cross rotation this season. In 16 games played, he has averaged a team-best 15.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.7 assists, while hitting 82.1 percent of his foul shots. During the Lehigh game, Grandison recorded 11 points, five rebounds and three assists. Previously at Navy, he posted 11 points and nine rebounds. Grandison also played well at Iona, leading the team with a career-high 25 points, nine rebounds and eight assists. A few of his other top performances this year have come against Siena (24 points, four assists, three rebounds), against Stony Brook (21 points, a career-high 10 assists, eight rebounds), at Harvard (21 points, four rebounds, three assists), at UMass (20 points, four rebounds, three assists), at Providence (17 points, seven rebounds, three steals), at Albany (17 points, three rebounds, three assists), against Canisius (15 points, seven rebounds, six assists), against Siena (14 points, seven rebounds, three assists), against Fairleigh Dickinson (13 points, seven rebounds), at Loyola (13 points, four assists) and at No. 19 Michigan (12 points, five boards, three assists). In 31 games played last year, Grandison averaged 9.0 points and 4.5 rebounds, while hitting 74.1 percent of his free throws. During his career with the Crusaders, he has now totaled 518 points, 226 rebounds, 120 assists and 38 steals.

**CRUSADERS HEAT UP ON OFFENSE:**

Holy Cross has turned in some outstanding shooting performances so far this season. The Crusaders have hit at least 50 percent of their field goal attempts seven times this year, with a high of 55.7 percent against Lehigh on Jan. 9. On the year, Holy Cross has a 6-1 record when shooting at least 50 percent from the floor. The Crusaders have hit 46.8 percent of their field goal attempts overall this season, a mark which ranks fourth in the Patriot League.

**LEHIGH RECAP**

Caleb Green scored a career-high 25 points, but the Crusaders were defeated by Lehigh 99-94 in overtime at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Jan. 9, 2019. The game was tied at 13-13 early on, when Holy Cross scored 10 straight points to take a 23-13 lead. The Crusaders were later up 32-22 with eight minutes left in the first half, when they used a 14-6 spurt to increase their advantage to 18 points. Lehigh was able to trim the margin down to 12 points heading into the locker room at halftime. Holy Cross was still up by 12 (65-53) with 17:17 left in regulation, when the Mountain Hawks went on a 23-1 run to pull in front 76-66 with 9:40 remaining. Lehigh later led 81-74 with 5:22 to go, when a three-pointer by Jacob Grandison and a pair of free throws from Matt Faw made it a two-point game. A layup by Grandison with 1:26 remaining put the Crusaders back in front (84-83), before the game went to overtime tied at 86-86. In the extra session, the Mountain Hawks hit three-point field goals on three of their first four possessions to build a 95-88 lead. Holy Cross scored the next six points to trim the margin to one point (95-94), and had the ball back with less than a minute to play. But the Crusaders were unable to score, before Lehigh's Lance Tejada hit a three-pointer with 8.8 seconds left to put the game away. Holy Cross made 55.7 percent of its field goal attempts and 57.1 percent of its three-pointers on the night, but connected on just 60.9 percent of its free throws. The Mountain Hawks hit 47.7 percent of their shots from the floor, 45.5 percent of their attempts from beyond the arc and 73.3 percent of their foul shots. Jehyve Floyd finished the night with 22 points, nine rebounds and seven assists. Tejada led Lehigh with 36 points, while hitting 10 of 14 three-point attempts.

**FLOYD DOMINATES DOWN LOW:** Senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** is once again among the top players in the Patriot League this year. In 16 games played, he has averaged 10.1 points, 6.3 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 2.4 blocked shots, while hitting 67.3 percent of his field goal attempts. During the Lehigh game, Floyd totaled a season-high 22 points, nine rebounds and seven assists. Previously at Navy, he posted 10 points and three rebounds. Floyd also had a huge game at Loyola (Md.), leading the team with 20 points and a career-best 15 rebounds, while hitting eight of nine field goal attempts. A few of his other top games this year have come against Canisius (15 points, seven rebounds, five blocks, three assists), against Siena (14 points, eight rebounds, five assists), at UMass (14 points, seven rebounds, four assists), against Fairleigh Dickinson (12 points, career-high 13 rebounds, six blocks, four assists), at Albany (12 points, six assists, six blocks, five rebounds) and against Stony Brook (10 points, eight rebounds, seven blocks, five assists). In 2017-2018, Floyd was named the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, in addition to being selected to the All-Patriot League third team, the Patriot League All-Defensive team and the All-Patriot League Tournament team. Last season, he averaged 12.2 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.2 blocks while hitting 66.8 percent of his shots from the floor. Over the course of his collegiate career, Floyd has totaled 692 points, 370 rebounds, 152 blocks, 145 assists and 66 steals, while hitting 65.2 percent of his field goal attempts (303 of 465).

**SHARING THE ROCK:** Holy Cross has been an excellent passing team so far this season. The Crusaders currently lead the Patriot League with an average of 17.6 assists per game and a 1.6-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio. Overall this year, Holy Cross has recorded an assist on 68.0 percent of its made field goals (281 of 413), a mark that ranks second in all of Division I through games of Jan. 9. Sophomore guard **Caleb Green** currently leads the team with 65 assists, followed by sophomore guard **Jacob Grandison** (59 assists), senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** (57 assists) and senior guard **Patrick Benzan** (48 assists).

**CRUSADERS KEEP FORCING TURNOVERS:** In 16 games played this year, Holy Cross has forced its opponents to commit 228 turnovers for an average of 14.3 turnovers per contest. During the victory over Sacred Heart, the Crusaders forced a season-high 20 turnovers. Holy Cross also caused 19 turnovers against Fairleigh Dickinson, Harvard and Navy. The Crusaders caused 12.9 turnovers per game last season, after leading the Patriot League with an average of 15.9 caused turnovers in 2016-2017.

Austin Butler scored a career-high 28 points to lead the Crusaders to an 85-74 victory over Lafayette at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Jan. 27, 2018. Holy Cross hit 55.9 percent of its field goal attempts and 90.9 percent of its free throws on the day, while turning the ball over just seven times. The Crusaders also held Lafayette to 44.9 percent shooting from the floor, while forcing 13 turnovers. Jehyve Floyd finished with 17 points, six rebounds, two blocked shots and two assists, while Karl Charles totaled 12 points, eight assists, six rebounds and three steals. The Leopards were led by Alex Petrie with 29 points and five rebounds. The Crusaders started the game hot, using runs of 13-4 and 10-2 to claim a 31-15 lead with 9:38 left in the first half. Holy Cross was still up by 15 (35-20) with 6:26 to go before

the break, before Lafayette scored 14 straight points to make it a one-point game (35-34). But the Crusaders responded with a 14-3 spurt of their own to close out the half, and led 49-37 heading into the locker room. Holy Cross was still up by 10 points (55-45) with 14:18 remaining, when the Leopards went on a 15-7 run to close the gap to two points (62-60) at the 10:12 mark. The Crusaders then stepped up on defense, holding Lafayette scoreless for almost five minutes while scoring nine straight points to go back up by 11 (71-60). The Leopards would get no closer than seven points the rest of the way, and Holy Cross hit five of six free throws in the final two minutes to pull out the victory.

**HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS:** Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 383-164 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including a 4-1 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 36 out of 43 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 170-72 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 108-43 record against Patriot League foes.

**BUTLER COMING OFF ALL-ROOKIE SEASON:** Sophomore guard **Austin Butler** is once again among the Crusaders' top players on the perimeter this season, after being selected to the Patriot League All-Rookie team in 2017-2018. On the year, he is averaging 12.6 points, 4.0 rebounds and 1.3 steals per game, while making 39.7 percent of his shots from three-point range. During the Lehigh game, Butler posted 16 points, four rebounds and three assists. Previously at Loyola (Md.), he totaled 15 points and two steals. Butler also played well at Iona, recording 17 points and five rebounds. A few of his other top games this year have come against Sacred Heart (26 points), against Stony Brook (21 points, three assists), against Siena (18 points, five rebounds), against Fairleigh Dickinson (14 points, seven rebounds, three steals), against Rhode Island (14 points) and against Siena (12 points, career-high 11 rebounds, five assists). In 29 games played last year, Butler averaged 9.8 points and 3.7 rebounds. Over the course of his collegiate career, Butler has now totaled 496 points, 174 rebounds, 61 assists and 43 steals.

**CARMODY LEADS THE CRUSADERS:** Bill Carmody is in his fourth season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2018-2019, with an overall record of 52-62. He owns a career record of 336-297, and earned his 300th career victory with a 63-52 win at Harvard on Nov. 22, 2016. In 2015-2016, Carmody led the Crusaders to their first Patriot League Tournament title since 2007 and their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1953. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, he has 36 years of Division I coaching experience, including 21 seasons as a head coach (with 13 years at Northwestern and four seasons at Princeton). Carmody has led his teams to nine postseason tournament appearances — three trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament.

**HOLY CROSS STAYS STRONG ON DEFENSE:** The Crusaders are once again among the top defensive teams in the Patriot League this season. In 16 games played, Holy Cross has allowed just 67.4 points per contest while holding the opposition to 31.3 percent shooting from three-point range and blocking 4.0 shots per contest. Last season, the Crusaders held their opponents to 67.7 points per game on 43.1 percent shooting from the field, while forcing 12.9 turnovers and blocking 3.4 shots per game. Holy Cross was even more effective on the defensive end during Patriot League play in 2017-2018, allowing just 65.7 points per contest on 42.3 percent shooting against conference foes.

**HOLY CROSS IN THE NCAA STATISTICS:** The Crusaders are currently ranked among the NCAA Division I leaders in 10 statistical categories, through games of Jan. 9. In addition, four Holy Cross players stand among the best in the nation in individual categories. The rankings:

**TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE:** This year marks the 100th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,412-994, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 11 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

## 2018-2019 HOLY CROSS MEN'S BASKETBALL

**CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SIXTH PATRIOT LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON TITLE:** During the 2018-2019 campaign, Holy Cross will attempt to win the Patriot League regular season title for the sixth time in school history. The last championship for the Crusaders came in 2006-2007, when they tied for first place in the conference with Bucknell, as both teams posted 13-1 records in league play. Prior to that, Holy Cross won outright Patriot League regular season titles in 2001, 2003 and 2005, while sharing the regular season championship in 1994. The Crusaders' five total championships are tied for the second-most in conference history with Navy (one outright, four shared), behind only Bucknell (nine outright, three shared).

**BENZAN PLAYS KEY MINUTES IN BACKCOURT:** Senior guard **Patrick Benzan** is one of the leaders in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 16 games played, he has averaged 6.1 points, 3.0 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 1.1 steals per contest. During the victory at Albany, he totaled 10 points, three rebounds, three assists and two steals. Previously against Sacred Heart, Benzan recorded a career-high 19 points and five assists, while hitting nine of 10 field goal attempts. In 28 games played last season, he averaged 6.3 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.1 steals per contest, while hitting 79.5 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his collegiate career, Benzan has now totaled 540 points, 236 rebounds, 196 assists and 97 steals.

**PROTECTING THE BALL:** Holy Cross has done an excellent job of protecting the ball so far this year. The Crusaders have averaged a Patriot League-low 11.3 turnovers per game this season while posting single-digit turnovers five times. Holy Cross gave the ball away just five times in the first meeting with Siena, while posting six turnovers against Stony Brook and eight in the second Siena game. This should come as no surprise, as the Crusaders have had the fewest turnovers in the Patriot League during three of the last four seasons. In 2014-2015, Holy Cross set a school single-season record for the fewest turnovers per game (10.9).

**CRUSADERS FIND SUCCESS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY:** Holy Cross started this season strong against non-conference opponents, posting a 9-4 record prior to the start of Patriot League play. This marked the first time the Crusaders recorded nine victories prior to the start of conference action since the 2007-2008 campaign, when they were also 9-4 (that team also added a 10th non-league victory in February). Holy Cross also totaled nine wins in the months of November and December this year, its most prior to New Year's Day since the 2000-2001 team went 9-3.

**FLOYD NAMED PRESEASON ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE:** Senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** was selected to the preseason All-Patriot League team, in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. Floyd was joined on the preseason all-conference team by American junior guard Sa'eed Nelson, Colgate junior forward Will Rayman, Bucknell senior forward Nate Sestina and Lehigh senior guard Lance Tejada. In addition, Nelson was selected as the preseason Patriot League Player of the Year.

**CRUSADERS PICKED FIFTH IN PRESEASON POLL:** In the 2018-2019 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in fifth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. The Crusaders received 109 total points in the conference preseason poll. Lehigh placed first in the poll with 145 total points and seven first-place votes, followed by Bucknell in second with 140 points and eight first-place votes. Colgate placed third with 130 points and three first-place votes, while Boston University was fourth with 121 points and two first-place votes. The preseason rankings were rounded out by Army West Point (sixth, 71 points), American (seventh, 64 points), Navy (eighth, 52 points), Lafayette (ninth, 46 points) and Loyola (10th, 22 points).

**FAW STEPS UP IN THE POST:** Sophomore forward **Matt Faw** has been a key player along the Holy Cross front line this season. In 16 games played, he has averaged 7.4 points, 3.4 rebounds and 0.9 blocked shots per contest. During the Lehigh game, Faw totaled 10 points, four rebounds and two blocks. Previously against Canisius, he recorded 11 points and six rebounds. Faw also played well at UMass, finishing with 10 points, five rebounds, four assists and three blocks. A few of his other top performances this season have come against Stony Brook (career-high 13 points) and Sacred Heart (12 points). Over the course of his collegiate career, Faw has now totaled 252 points, 107 rebounds, 27 blocks and 25 assists, while making 42 of 104 three-point attempts (40.0 percent).

**BURRELL RETURNS TO WORCESTER:** Former Crusader **Justin Burrell** (Class of 2015) will be back on campus this week, as he is in his third season as an assistant coach at Lafayette. The 2011-2012 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, Burrell totaled 1,143 points, 414 assists, 227 rebounds and 97 steals during his Holy Cross career, while making 34.5 percent (140 of 406) of his three-pointers and 83.2 percent (243 of 292) of his free throws. He owns the third-best career free throw percentage in school history.

**DRIBBLES:** With the 80-73 victory at Loyola (Md.) on Jan. 3, the Crusaders won their Patriot League opener for just the second time in the last seven years, while winning their opening conference road game for the first time in eight years ... In the NCAA's new NET rankings (through games of Jan. 9), Holy Cross' non-conference schedule ranked as the 178th hardest in the nation, and the second-toughest in the Patriot League ... Junior guard **Clayton Le Sann** tied his career high with 13 points against Rhode Island on Dec. 8, while hitting five of seven field goals and three of five shots from three-point range. On the year, he is now averaging 1.8 points per game ... Sophomore forward **Connor Niego** led the team with a career-high 13 points at No. 19 Michigan on Nov. 10, then scored 11 points against Rhode Island on Dec. 8. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, he has now totaled 119 points and 56 rebounds ... Senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has 152 career blocked shots, to rank third all-time at Holy Cross ... Holy Cross won the Springfield Bracket of this year's Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament for the 15th regular season tournament championship in program history ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2008 through 2011, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 98 percent, tied for the eighth-best mark among all Division I schools ... Holy Cross' 93 points against Sacred Heart were its most in a season opener since defeating Colgate 114-91 on Nov. 27, 1989 ... Holy Cross has received an NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award in each of the last 13 seasons, for having a multi-year APR in the top 10 percent of all Division I men's basketball teams in the nation. Only two other Division I schools in the country have matched that feat (Belmont and Davidson).
