



2014 PARKING, TAILGATING & HOMECOMING POLICY

The Department of Athletics welcomes you to Delaware State University. The parking and tailgating policy below is designed to ensure your safety and comfort during your visit to campus for athletic events. Please respect the needs of others by keeping sidewalks and roadways clear of obstructions for those using wheelchairs or walking with assistive devices, respect the beauty of the grounds, and follow the directives of our parking attendants, public safety, and special events staff.

Game day parking lots open four (4) hours (9:30 am) before kickoff. The University's main gate will close four and a half hours (9:00 am) before kickoff. All traffic will be directed to College Road: Gate 1 (Southeast Entrance - Presidential VIP, Lots 1, 14, 18 and 24) and Gate 2 (Education & Humanities Entrance – Lots 16, 19, 19A, and 25).

PARKING INFORMATION

Rules and Regulations

- Parking is permitted only in designated spaces.
- Parking on sidewalks, islands, and medians is not permitted.
- Parking on grass is NOT permitted except in designated areas and as directed by or parking attendants and special events staff.
- Parking spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis and cannot be saved.
- Parking areas must be cleared two (2) hours after the conclusion of an event.
- Golf carts or ATVs are not permitted.
- NO OVERNIGHT PARKING. Violators will be towed.

This fee is due upon entrance to campus. Parking will open at 9:30am on Homecoming day.

Reserved Parking:

Patrons who wish to purchase a reserved parking space can contact the DSU Ticket Office at 302-857-7497. The cost for the pass is \$60.00. ADVANCE PURCHASE ONLY. This pass entitles each holder to one (1) parking space in Lot 1.

Handicap/ADA Parking:

Handicap/ADA parking is located in Lot 14 (adjacent to the Price Building). Shuttle Service will be provided for two (2) hours before and after the game. Patrons needing assistance can use the designated ADA drop off location by Lot 1. This service is only to allow patrons out of the vehicle for shorter traveling distance to Alumni Stadium. Vehicles will still need to be parked in the appropriate lot unless a season parking pass has been purchased. Spaces are limited.

Handicap parking will require the following admission to the appropriate lot:

- 1) Valid state-issued handicap parking placard or license plate.
- 2) Valid state-issued handicap parking registration card.

TAILGATING INFORMATION

Delaware State University acknowledges tailgating as a time-honored tradition. We encourage you to have a good time and ask that you do so responsibly. The following restrictions apply:

- Only one parking space per vehicle.
- Tailgating is permitted only in areas where the flow of traffic is not obstructed and must comply with all University regulations. (Lot 1-B parking lot area)/ Grass area by the outdoor basketball courts.
- Only small weighted tents may be erected in tailgating /parking lot areas.
- Grill cooking with charcoal or L.P. gas is allowed; however, all grills must be supervised while in use and be fully extinguished before being left unattended.
- Waste food items and trash, including charcoal, must be disposed of in appropriate containers.
- The sale of food in this area is not permitted, persons who conduct food sales will be asked to leave the tailgating area.

Failure to comply with tailgating regulations may result in immediate termination of tailgating privileges and criminal prosecution or disciplinary action through the DSU Public Safety Office or local law enforcement agencies.
