## SEAHAWKS TO FACE DUKES FRIDAY IN CAA QUARTERFINALS

The No. 9 seed UNCW women's basketball team returns to action in the 2014 CAA Women's Basketball Championship Friday as it faces top-seeded James Madison in a Noon quarterfinal contest at Show Place Arena.

The Seahawks opened the championship with a 67-65 victory over No. 8 seed William & Mary in first-round action Thursday. Junior Kelva Atkins led five UNCW players in double figures with 21 points and added 10 rebounds for her second double-double of the season. Freshman Johanna McMillan joined Atkins in double figures with a career-high 12 points while fellow newcomers Ryan Flowers, Brie Mobley and Naqaiyyah Teague chipped in 10 points each. Flowers also pulled down a game-high 15 rebounds to post her fourth double-double of the season and help the Seahawks to a 46-35 advantage on the glass.

The winner of Friday's contest will advance to the semifinals, where they will face the winner of the game between No. 4 Drexel and No. 5 Hofstra Saturday at Noon.

## Series Notes

### Series History

Friday's contest marks the 63rd meeting between UNCW and James Madison in a series that dates back to the 1984-85 season and early days of the Colonial Athletic Association. The Dukes hold a 53-9 advantage in the all-time series and have won seven straight against the Seahawks, including a sweep of the regular season series with a 77-41 victory at Trask Coliseum on Jan. 26 and a 92-43 triumph at the JMU Convocation Center on Feb. 14

### A Familiar Foe

UNCW's 62 previous contests against James Madison represent the third highest number of contests against an opponent in program history. In fact, the Dukes are just one of four programs (George Mason (64) William & Mary (63), and East Carolina (54)) that the Seahawks have played on more than 50 occasions during their 41-year history.

### UNCW Versus James Madison In The CAA Championship

UNCW holds a 1-6 record against James Madison in the CAA Women's Basketball Championship. The Dukes have won two straight against the Seahawks in postseason play, including a 67-41 triumph in their most recent matchup in the CAA Championship on March 11, 2010. UNCW's lone postseason victory against JMU came in a 65-62 victory in the semifinals of the 2000 championship in Richmond, Va.

### The Last Meeting

James Madison raced out to a 39-14 halftime cushion and cruised to a 92-43 victory over visiting UNCW in women's basketball action Friday night at the JMU Convocation Center.

Junior forward Toia Giggets and sophomore guard Precious Hall paced six Dukes in double figures with 16 points apiece. Senior guard Kirby Burkholder added 15, while sophomore guard Jazmon Gwathmey, sophomore guard Angela Mickens and junior center Lauren Okafor chipped in 10 each.

Junior playmaker Kelva Atkins of UNCW tied for game scoring honors with 16 points. Freshman guard Brie Mobley also had 13 points for the Seahawks, who finish off a two-game swing to Virginia on Sunday with a 2 p.m. matchup against William & Mary at Kaplan Arena.

JMU, which defeated the visitors, 77-41, just 19 days ago at Trask Coliseum, put its depth and experience on display before a festive Valentine's Day crowd at the JMU Convocation Center and broke away from the pesky Seahawks midway through the first half.

Giggets and Hall helped the Dukes bolt out to a 39-14 lead at halftime as JMU held the Seahawks to 28 percent shooting and a season-low output of 14 points over the opening 20 minutes.

UNCW, behind Atkins and Mobley, traded buckets with the Dukes over the first eight minutes of the second half before JMU's depth took its toll. Atkins scored on a reverse layup with 13:20 on the clock to cut the margin to 47-23, but JMU poured it on down the stretch and all 10 players in the lineup scored after intermission.
