BYLAW OF THE MONTH!

13.01.1 Eligibility Effects of Recruiting Violation. The recruitment of a student-athlete by a member institution or any representative of its athletics interest in violation of the Association's legislation, as acknowledged by the institution or established through the Association's infractions process, shall result in the student-athlete becoming ineligible to represent that institution in intercollegiate athletics.

Social Media Reminders

- A coach may publicly post or "tweet" generic information about locations visited (e.g., "Visit to French Lick High today" or "Attending the East vs. South game tonight").
- Coaches are permitted to initiate or accept a "friend" or "follow" request to a PSA (or his/her parents) through social media sites at any time.
- A coach may post general content not created for recruiting purposes (game scores, team updates, facility updates, etc.) provided they do not mention a specific PSA.
- An institution may comment publicly only to the extent of its recruiting of a PSA.

Important Things to Remember about Official Visits

1. Confirm that all pre-visit NCAA and Charlotte requirements have been satisfied PRIOR to the start of official visit activities.
2. Ensure that the appropriate Charlotte staff members or employees are communicating with the prospect .
3. Clarify who will be accompanying the prospect during the official visit.
4. Review all the student-athlete host policies with any and all student-athletes that serve as host prior to the start of an official visit.
5. Keep the 48 hour official limit in mind when setting up activities that will trigger the start of the 48-hour window
6. When it comes to transportation confirm with compliance what is permissible or what costs are reimbursable before giving information to prospect and their family.
7. Remember that prospects should be provided with lodging and take meals as regular students normally do.
8. Ensure that ONLY permissible entertainment is provided to the prospect and any individuals accompanying the prospect.
9. Consider the parameters that allow for a prospect to engage in workouts/recreational activities during visit.
10. Stay away from creating an experience that is designed to bring attention to individual prospects while they are on an official visit. Teams MAY NOT tweet/post pictures with prospects.

Texting...

As of August 1st, new rules for texting have been implemented. Here are a few sport specific regulations for when it is permissible to text prospects.

Football and Track & Field. After the PSA has signed a NLI or offer of financial aid, and approval has been sent by the compliance office.

Men's Basketball. After June 15th of PSA's sophomore year.

Baseball, Women's Basketball, Golf, Soccer, Tennis, & Volleyball. After September 1st of the PSA's Junior Year.

**Note: Non-coaching staff members should check with compliance before texting.*
