ABOUT THE 2012 LOBOS

The 2011 season did not unfold as last year's Lobo squad had hoped. New Mexico was plagued by injury and inconsistency, resulting in a rollercoaster of a season in which UNM finished 14-15 overall and 6-8 in Mountain West play. The Lobos hosted the MW Tournament, but were ousted, 1-3, by Wyoming in their opening match. It was the Lobos' worst record under head coach Jeff Nelson and program's first losing season since 2006.

The 2012 team returns six letterwinners who are hungry and ready to right the wrongs of last season. New Mexico welcomes three freshmen to aid in the pursuit.

The Lobos said goodbye to three seniors who posted outstanding careers -- Allison Buck, Ashley Rhoades and Kelly Williamson. All three were named to the 2011 All-MW team while Buck and Rhoades were named to the AVCA All-West Region Team and received AVCA Honorable Mention All-America honors. Williamson was named the Capitol One Academic All-America First Team.

WELL ATTENDED

University of New Mexico volleyball hopes to remain in the top 20 nationwide in attendance for the third season in a row as Lobo fans will have 17 opportunities in 2012 to watch the Lobo volleyball team compete at home.

UNM has led the Mountain West conference in volleyball attendance for the past two seasons and finished No. 16 and No. 12 in the nation for attendance in 2010 and 2011, respectively. Last season, the Lobos drew an average of 2,184 fans per match for a grand total of 26,211. An impressive 33,181 fans entered Johnson Gym in 2010 to watch Lobo volleyball, a match average of 2,212.

HOPES OF REACHING THE MOUNTAIN TOP

The Lobos have yet to claim a Mountain West regular season or tournament championship. New Mexico finished as high as second in the regular season in 2010, posting a 12-4 MW mark. Colorado State has consistently been at or near the top of the league, having finished first in the MW regular season nine years out of 13, and of the 10 MW Volleyball Tournaments, the Rams have claimed the

title four times.

New Mexico has won a conference title twice in program history--the Lobos claimed the 1988 High Country Conference title and the 1991 Western Athletic Conference crown.

SCHEDULE

The Lobos' 2012-13 schedule opens with four tournaments and features a total of 34 matches, half of which will be played at home.

New Mexico's regimen includes match-ups with two teams that made trips to the 2011 NCAA Tournament - Maryland-Eastern Shore and Colorado State--and 11 squads that posted winning records last season.

New Mexico alternates the first four weekends of the season at home and on the road.

UNM opens its season at home with the three-team Sheraton/LA Boxing Lobo Classic, hosting Southern and Duquesne Aug. 24-25.

The weekend of Aug. 31-Sept. 1 the Lobos travel to Savannah, Ga., for the Tiger Invitational hosted by Savannah State University. UNM will face 2011 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Champs Maryland-Eastern Shore while in Savannah. The Hawks posted a program-best 24-7 record last season, making the NCAA Championship tournament for the first time in program history.

Georgia Southern, Portland and UC Santa Barbara come to Albuquerque Sept. 7-8 for the Sheraton/LA Boxing/Comcast Lobo Invitational. The Gauchos finished 19-12 and second in the Big West in 2011.

New Mexico's final regular-season tournament is at the University of Oklahoma. While in Norman, the Lobos play Arkansas-Little Rock, Southern Methodist and Oklahoma. The Sooners finished fifth in the Big XII last year, posting an overall record of 21-12, and an even 8-8 mark in league matches.

New Mexico begins Mountain West play at home against 2011 MW regular-season and tournament champions Colorado State. The Rams' season ended at the NCAA quarterfinals with a 3-1 loss to Hawai'i, leaving CSU with a record of 24-6 overall and 12-2 in conference play, dropping just two league matches (at TCU and

Wyoming).

The Lobos host MW foe Wyoming for its second conference contest in 2012. The Cowgirls finished 21-11 overall last year and posted a program-best 9-5 finish in conference play. Wyoming also beat New Mexico three times in 2011--twice in the regular season (3-0 and 3-2)--and in UNM's opening match of the MW Championship (3-1).

The Lobos continue conference play the rest of September and on in to October with home and away matches against Fresno State, UNLV, Boise State, Air Force Academy, San Diego State and Nevada.

TCU becomes a member of the Big East Conference on July 1, but the addition of former Western Athletic Conference members Fresno State and Nevada make for nine MW volleyball schools. The Bulldogs finished 14-15 last year and 7-7 in the WAC, while the Wolf Pack posted a 5-21 overall record and 2-12 in league play.

The Lobos have an 8-7 series record against Fresno State and the two matches against Nevada will be the first time the Lobos and the Wolf Pack meet on the volleyball court.

New Mexico has a few non-conference contests interspersed throughout the second half of the schedule, including a home and away matchup with CSU Bakersfield--the Lobos go to Bakersfield on Sept. 26 and welcome the Roadrunners on Nov. 11.

Rio Grande Rival New Mexico State comes to Albuquerque on Oct. 23. The Lobos lost to the Aggies in 2011 in Las Cruces, 3-1. New Mexico also travels to Lubbock, Texas, to face another Big XII opponent in Texas Tech on Nov. 9.

The Lobos close the regular season with matches at Wyoming and Colorado State on Nov. 21 and 23, respectively.
