This Week in UNM Women's Soccer ... The Lobos finished the regular season 10-6-2 overall and 4-2-1 in conference play. The Lobos have earned a bye into the semifinals of the Mountain West Tournament, entering as the No. 2 seed. New Mexico will take on the No. 6 seed Nevada, who got a late goal on Wednesday night to nip No. 3 Boise State 1-0. The Lobos defeated Nevada earlier in the season 1-0, that game in Reno, on a goal barely three minutes into the contest by Natalie Jenks.

Stephanie Rowe and Rachel Montoya each have five goals to tie for the team lead. Montoya also has four assists, and her 14 points lead the team. Kelli Cornell has seven shutouts and a 0.86 goals against average. UNM has 21 goals scored to 16 against.

Montoya was UNM's only selection to the All-Mountain West First Team, and defender Sinead Fleming was named Second Team All-Mountain West.

ABOUT THE 2012 LOBOS

New Mexico is 10-6-2 on the season. The Lobos lost on the road to a nationally-ranked team by a goal for the second time this season, as UNM lost 1-0 in an evenly matched battle in San Diego to the No. 6 Aztecs. UNM earlier this season lost to now No. 11 Florida 3-2 in Gainesville.

GOOD ON AND OFF THE PITCH

The Lobos not only excel on the pitch, but in the classroom too. Liz Nare was named Capital One/CoSIDA First Team All-Academic District VI. Goalkeeper Kelli Cornell, defender Brooke Ellison, and midfielder Brianna Webster were all named Capital One/CoSIDA Second Team All-Academic District VI. Nare will now advance to the national ballot for Academic All-America considerations.

UNDEFEATED AGAIN

For the second time in three seasons, the University of New Mexico has gone undefeated at home, registering a 4-0-1 mark at the UNM Soccer Complex. The team went a perfect 6-0-0 in 2010.

The Lobos are will carry a 13-match unbeaten streak at home into the 2013 season, having gone 11-0-2 since an overtime loss to Cal State Fullerton in 2011. That loss is all that stands between UNM having a 24-match streak, as UNM is 20-1-3 in it's last 24 home matches.

From 2009-11, the New Mexico Lobos ripped off a 10-match undefeated streak at home, going 9-0-1 at the UNM Soccer Complex before losing that overtime decision last season to Cal State Fullerton 3-2.

ROWE, ROWE, ROWE YOUR BOAT

The Lobos have been solid on offense, scoring 21 goals this season on the way to 10 wins. However, Stephanie Rowe has turned herself into captain clutch for UNM. Rowe's header with 1:08 left in the game on Sunday to win Senior Day was the Littleton native's third game-winner of the year. That number leads the team, and it currently ranks 75th nationally. Ohio State's Tiffany Cameron and Middle Tennessee's Paige Goeglein lead the nation with eight each.

DOUBLE DIGITS BABY...DOUBLE DIGITS

The University of New Mexico women's soccer team is having the greatest four-year run in school history, with a record of 47-18-13 over the past four years. With the win over Wyoming, the Lobos earned their 10th win of the season, which marks the fourth consecutive year that the Lobos have won in double-figures.

It marks the first time in school history that UNM has won at least 10 games in four straight seasons. UNM's best previous streak was three, from 1995-97. UNM's 47 wins easily tops the 42 wins from 1994-97 as the most wins over any four-year period in school history.

The Lobos have also clinched a winning record for the eighth-straight year, and for the ninth time in Kit Vela's 12 years at UNM. Prior to Vela's arrival, the school had four winning seasons in eight seasons.

LOBOS SET A RECORD FOR SHUTOUT STREAK

The Lobos went on an epic scoreless run, setting and tying records in the process. New Mexico registered five consecutive shutouts, which tied the school record for the most consecutive shutouts, as the team had five shutouts in its first five games as a program in 1993. Overall, when Fresno State scored at the 53:13 mark of the game, it ended a streak of 545:19 minutes without , which is easily the number one streak in school history:

The other record broken was by Kelli Cornell, as she broke the individual record of scoreless minutes of 473:29, which she herself set during her freshman year. Cornell also is the first goalkeeper to record five straight shutouts. Melissa Liston and April Duncan shared a shutout back in 1993 during that five match streak.

ANOTHER SHOCKING COMEBACK

When New Mexico came back and beat Wyoming after being down 1-0 at the half, it marked the second time this season that the Lobos came back to win a game after being down at the half. The other game was a 2-1 overtime win over Texas.

To get one comeback win is pretty good, but getting two out of three means someone should buy a lottery ticket. Entering this season, UNM since 2001 was 1-49-5 when trailing at half, yet it's a new team, and UNM is 2-1 this year in that situation.

OF COURSE, HARD TO TRAIL AT THE HALF...

...when the other team never scores in the first half. The Lobos have allowed three first half goals all season. The team has a 0.33 goals against average in the opening half of games this year. Only Texas, Wyoming, and Nebraska have scored goals against the Lobos in the first half. UNM is outscoring its opponents in the first half 8-3.

VELA HITS THE CENTURY MARK

Kit Vela picked up a milestone victory on Friday when UNM defeated Boise State 1-0, as the win was the 100th in her career. While Vela is happier with the number 1-0, as in UNM's conference record to this point, the win is a milestone not just for UNM, but for the Mountain West in general, as it isn't everyday that a coach gets win No. 100.

In fact, it's only happened three other times, as Vela became the fourth coach in MW history to record their 100th career victory. Jennifer Rockwood has 221 for BYU, Marty Buckley had 113 for Air Force, and Rick Manning had 110 for Utah.

KING OF THE MINUTE MOUNTAIN

Kelli Cornell has played in 7,522 minutes, the most in school history. She continues to put distance between her and second place Jayme Dieringer, who was tops on the minutes list with 7,139.

Since starting the 2009 season opener, she has played 7,522 minutes out of a possible 7,567, or 99.4% of all the minutes over the last three-plus years. The only 45 minutes she missed was on Oct. 1, 2010 when she suffered a head injury late in the first half of a 4-0 win at UNLV, and sat the second half. That ended a streak of 2,962 straight minutes played. Since that game, she has played 4,470 straight minutes exactly, passing her own personal mark with a complete game in the season opener.

ONE MORE CORNELL RECORD WATCH

Kelli Cornell has now started 80 matches, and she passed former teammate Jennifer Williams for the most career starts at UNM, as she had 79. Her 80 games played is tied for second in games played, and she will tie the record on Friday in the MW Tournament. Eryn Paetz played in 81 games from 2002-06.

FANS AROUND HERE LOVE THEIR LOBOS

In 2011, for the second year in a row, the New Mexico Lobos have finished fourth nationally in attendance. UNM in 2011 averaged a record 2,032 fans over its 11 home games, bringing in 22,350 fans.

The average topped the 1,953 that the squad averaged in 2010 when UNM won the regular-season title. In 2011, the Lobos made it back-to-back with both the regular-season and tournament titles. The Lobos have not lost a conference match since the 2009 season.

The University of Portland led the nation in attendance, averaging 3,110 fans per game. BYU

finished second with 2,882 fans and Texas A&M was third with 2,630 fans. The next closest team in the Mountain West was TCU, which finished seventh.

The Lobos have now finished in the top 20 in attendance in eight straight years, and in the top 10 in six of those eight, with four straight.

New Mexico completed this season with an average of 1,781 fans per contest. While that number is below 2010 and 2011, it is still the third-best attendance of all-time at UNM. Of course, in 2012, the Lobos never did play a 7 p.m. match, instead playing twice at 6, once at 5, once at 4, and once at 11 a.m.

Of course, over the weekend, UNM drew 4,391 fans for its two matches, and that weekend total would top three other MW teams for its total season attendance.

LOBOS PICKED FIRST IN MOUNTAIN WEST PRESEASON POLL

New Mexico was picked to win the title again in a poll of the eight league coaches, as the MW released the official preseason poll today, with the Lobos on top. The Lobos collected five first-place votes and 46 total points, edging San Diego State which had 44 points and two first-place votes.

Mountain West newcomer Fresno State received the other first-place vote and was picked third, totaling 35 points. Rounding out the poll was UNLV (4th, 31 points), Wyoming (5th, 28), Boise State (6th, 18), Air Force (7th, 12) and the other new team to the conference, Nevada (8th, 10).

New Mexico returns 14 letter-winners and seven starters from a 2011 squad that swept the MW regular-season and tournament crowns en route to a second-straight NCAA appearance. Heading up the list of 2012 returnees for 12th-year head coach Kit Vela is senior goalkeeper Kelli Cornell, the 2010 and 2011 MW Defensive Player of the Year. The Lobos finished the 2011 campaign with a 12-5-4 overall record (4-0-2 in MW play) and earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

The Lobos had a school record 11-match undefeated streak snapped in the NCAA College Cup in a tight 1-0 loss to UCLA in the opening round. The Lobos have gone undefeated in Mountain West play in each of the last two years, going 4-0-2 last year after a 5-0-2 season in 2010. Dating back to 2009, UNM is undefeated in its last 14 MW games, going 10-0-4, outscoring its opponents 30-6.

Among the other returning starters for New Mexico, along with Cornell and Jenks are back-line anchors Lauren Irwin and Liz Nare, who both started all 21 games and played nearly every minute (Irwin played 1,983 of 1,996 minutes, while Nare played 1,933 minutes). While Jenks is the leading returning scorer with 11 points on four goals and three assists, senior Rachel Montoya also brings plenty of fire power with three goals and four assists from a year ago.
