QUOTES FROM MISSISSIPPI STATE HEAD COACH PAUL DAVIS:

"LSU ran their sweep real well on us and hurt us outside early in the game, especially with that option play.

"As a matter of fact, they may have run outside a little bit more than we expected them to."

When asked why he chose to kick off after winning the opening toss of the coin, Davis said: "It was a wet field and we felt that if we gave them the football first, any early mistakes because of the field would be in our favor. I thought we could hold them in the first series. If it would have been a dry field, I wouldn't have wanted us to kick off."

"Yes, Lewis didn't play at all today, and this hurt us. He's got a knee injury that he received in the Auburn game and that kept him out. It really hurt us."

"Grezaffi is a real fine runner; he's a threat every time he gets the ball. Bevan is a fine football player and a good linebacker.

"We were hurt at linebacker today; our first two linebackers were out.

"Our passing was kinda' spasmodic--at times we moved passing and at others we didn't.

"We didn't do a whole lot, but I think we passed more than we usually do.

"LSU has got a real fine football team. They got some breaks, and I don't think they made one mistake the whole first half, and that really makes a difference, especially with a young ball club.

"We did better defensively in the second half after we went over some mistakes we were making the first half."

QUOTES FROM LSU COACH CHARLES MCCLENDON

"Our offense should sleep real well tonight. They certainly worked overtime today. It was a well deserved victory. Our kidshad to fight real hard this week and I am proud of the way that they came through.

"I also want to Congratulate Coach Paul Davis. His defense was as tough as we thought it would be. We got the jump on them and scored early, and even though we moved the ball well in the second half, we couldn't put it in the end zone.

"We had planned to use the option this week, so naturally we hated to see the rain. But it was too late to change our game plan and I think it was amazing that we were able to hold on to the football as well as we did.

"I thought both quarterbacks (Fred Haynes and Trey Prather) played well. Haynes called an excellent game under the conditions and moved the team well. It's unfortunate that he fumbled, but he was trying to score and I can't fault him for that.

"Defensively I felt that George Bevan played a tremendous game. He had as many big plays as any defensive player that I have seen. He is a tremendous football player."

Concerning LSU's unusual third down punt, McClendon said, "We had long yardage (3rd and 20), and the wet ball was dangerous. We also were looking for a 10-man rush."
