LSU head coach Charles McClendon: "It'll be a while before we can pass out proper kudos to everyone, but there's no doubt that this football team put out one of the greatest efforts I've ever seen.

The defense made ~~xxxx~~ Ole Miss punt and the offense too: it in. The ball team showed an immense amount of character, there was good organization by my coaches and the sideline procedure was a contributing factor. That last play required great protection, an excellent throw, a superb catch and don't forget Jackson's extra point under all that pressure.

In all my years in the game I don't believe I've ever seen a game won after ~~xxxx~~ time expired.

That Jones is a winner, you can put your money on that. He doesn't know what it is to quit. In fact the whole ball club stayed right in there and battled the Ole Miss team and the clock. Don't forget our kids had a chance to quit on that next to last drive, but the defense held the Rebels to three downs and made them punt and we got the ball with only three minutes to play and 80 yards away.
