**For the second consecutive season, Penn plays host to city-rival Villanova in its season opener at Franklin Field. And for the second straight year, the Wildcats are nationally ranked. However, Villanova enters this Schuylkill Showdown ranked No. 2 in the nation—becoming the highest ranked team the Quakers have faced since the FCS (I-AA) rankings began in 1978.**

## The Series

If history is any indicator, tonight should be a close one. The last four meetings on this field between these two schools have come down to the final possession. In all, Villanova leads Penn in the series 8-5, including 6-5 at Franklin Field. The Quakers claimed the first five matchups (1905-11) between the schools, but the Wildcats have dominated as of late, winning the last eight meetings since 1980. This is the sixth-straight year the two teams have met.

## Last Time Out

One year ago, it took more than four quarters to decide this matchup. After allowing an opening drive touchdown, the Penn defense was phenomenal. Of the four interceptions thrown by the Wildcats, three of them were picked off in the end zone. Penn held a brief 14-7 lead in the second quarter, but Villanova tied it on the next possession. The score remained 14-14 into the overtime session, where the Wildcats scored on the opening possession. But the extra point was blocked, giving the Quakers a shot to win the game with a touchdown and an extra point. However, a fumble on Penn's first play from scrimmage ended the game. See page 12 for a complete box score from last season's matchup.

## Under the Lights

Tonight's 7 p.m. kickoff marks the first night game at Franklin Field since the 2007 season opener against Lafayette. The Quakers lost that matchup when the Leopards split the uprights in the waning seconds for an 8-7 win. In all, the stadium lights have not been kind to the Quakers since head coach Al Bagnoli took over in 1992. Penn has gone 4-9 (.308) in night games since then, losing the last six. In comparison, Bagnoli is 110-45 (.710) in day games. Penn's last night time win was against Duquesne on Sept. 20, 2003. The 51-10 home victory propelled the team to an Ivy title that season.

## Up Next

Penn will play another night game. This time on the road as they travel to Eaton, Pa., to take on Lafayette. The two teams kick off at 6 p.m. next Saturday. It is the same place and time as the 2008 matchup won by the Leopards, 24-17. Penn—at Dartmouth on Oct. 3—doesn't return home until Oct. 10 (vs. Bucknell, 1 p.m.).

## A Penn Win Would...

- ... be the first over Villanova in nearly 98 years (Oct. 14, 1911).
- ... be the first ever against an FCS (I-AA) Top 10 opponent.
- ... mark the first in a season opener since 2006.

## A Penn Loss Would...

- ... mark a nine-game losing streak to Villanova, dating back to 1911.
- ... be the fourth straight loss in a home opener.
- ... be less good than a win.

## **Top Five Foe**

Since the inception of FCS (I-AA) rankings in 1978, the Quakers have never played a team ranked as high as the Wildcats' No. 3 position in The Sports Network's Top 25. Below is a list of Penn's results with ranked opponents since 2000.

Overall, Penn is 3-8 vs. teams ranked in the top-25 since 2000. and 1-5 at home. The last Top 25 upset for the Quakers was a 22-13 victory over No. 17 Harvard at Franklin Field on Nov. 11, 2006. *A special thanks to Dave Coulson at The Sports Network for his research in this matter.*

## **Wildcat Advantage**

Though this will be the first game action the Quakers have seen since November, their Philadelphia rivals already have two games under their belt—including one against an FBS (I-A) opponent. The Wildcats and their scholarship players matched up against Temple on Sept. 3 and defeated Philadelphia's FBS football team 27-24 at Lincoln Financial Field. They then defeated Lehigh in their home opener last Saturday.

## **Home Field Advantage?**

Though Al Bagnoli has an incredible record of 62-24 at Franklin Field in his 17 seasons at the helm of the Quakers, the cross-city Wildcats are the only team he has not beaten at the historic facility (of teams he's hosted more than once). This is despite the fact that all four Penn-Villanova games played at Franklin Field during his tenure have been decided by seven points or less.

## **Let the Games Begin**

Penn has been superb in season openers in its 132-year history. The Quakers are 101-30-1 (.769) all-time in season openers and are even better in home openers at 104-27-1 (.792). Under the longest tenured head coach in team history—Al Bagnoli—Penn is 11-6 in the first game of the year and has an identical record in home openers during that span.

## **Penn Scoring Trend**

Penn has scored in 110 consecutive games, the third longest streak in Ivy history. Brown holds the record at 128, which remains active. Yale also has a 108-game active streak. The Quakers have not been shut out since their trip to Harvard in 1997. Penn has never been shut out at home in the Al Bagnoli era. In fact, the last time the Quakers were held without a point at Franklin Field was Nov. 18, 1989, a span of 97 games.

## **Offseason Changes**

There have been some changes to the Quakers since you've last seen them. Former receiver Mark Fabish returned to West Philadelphia this winter to serve as tight ends coach, while offensive line coach Jon McLaughlin has assumed the duties as offensive coordinator.

**Count Up to 1,300 - NCAA Record!**

**1,294:** No program at any level of college football has played more games than the Penn Quakers. On Oct. 31, at Brown in Providence, R.I., the Quakers are set to play the 1,300th game in program history—the first team in NCAA history to reach that number. Today's matchup with Villanova marks the 1,294th football game played by the school and the 804th at Franklin Field.

**Wynn Named to Buck Buchanan Watch List**

The preseason All-American was also named to this prestigious list in August. The Buck Buchanan Award is given to the best defensive player in the FCS (I-AA). Only 20 players in the entire country made the list. Make sure to watch #6 today as he totaled two interceptions against Villanova last season. He needs five picks to break Chuck Bednarik's 61-year-old school record for career interceptions (14).

**Penn Receiving Votes in National Poll**

With the release of Top 25 FCS media poll by The Sports Network (TSN), Penn has earned some preseason recognition, receiving votes in the first three editions of the national poll. Penn received 56 points in the preseason poll, ranking 42nd among the 78 teams in the rankings. In the latest release of the poll on Monday, the Red and Blue received 52 points which is 38th-most in the country. The Quakers, who return the majority of their starters in all three phases of the game after a 5-2 Ivy campaign in 2008, was not in the top 25 of the national media preseason poll last season, but was receiving votes throughout most of the year. Penn was last ranked on Oct. 24, 2005 when they were #25 in the Sports Network and ESPN/USA Today rankings.

**Penn Picked Second**

In the Ivy League preseason media poll released on Aug. 12, Penn was picked to finish as the runner-up to defending co-champion Harvard. The Quakers received four first-place votes and have now been selected in the top four of the preseason poll for 17 consecutive seasons. The last time the Quakers were not predicted to finish in the top half of the Ivy League was 1992, one month prior to the program's first game under the direction of head coach Al Bagnoli. Penn's 117 poll points was 12 behind Harvard and 11 in front of third-place Brown. Yale (82 points) was fourth, followed by Princeton (67), Columbia (44), Cornell (44) and Dartmouth (23).

**Count Up to 800 - Third All-Time!**

**791:** Entering tonight's game against Villanova, the Quakers have accumulated 791 wins in program history. That mark is third all-time in the FCS behind only Yale and Harvard. Only Yale (803) has reached the 800-win mark as Harvard entered the 2009 season with 798 wins. Penn's win total is 11th all-time in Division I as Michigan, Texas, Notre Dame, Nebraska, Ohio State, Penn State and Alabama have all reached 800 wins. Oklahoma currently stands one game in front of the Quakers with 792 wins.

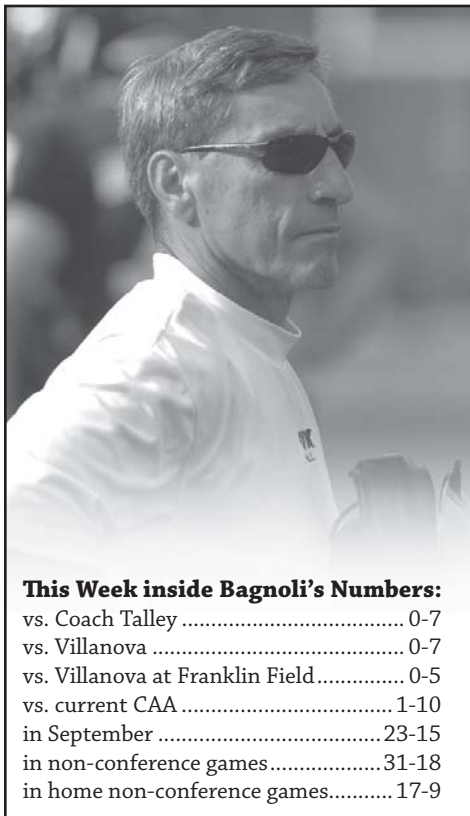

## Al Bagnoli - George A. Munger Head Coach of Football

Winning is infectious, and under George A. Munger Head Coach of Football Al Bagnoli — the second-winningest active coach in the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) — the Penn football team has made it a way of life for the past 17 seasons. Bagnoli is the longest tenured coach in Penn's 132-year history upon entering his 18th campaign with the Red and Blue. No coach has a higher Ivy winning percentage than Bagnoli and no coach has won more outright Ivy titles than the six championship rings that Bagnoli adorns. Under his watch, 131 players have earned All-Ivy honors, 12 have signed NFL free agent contracts and three more have been selected in the NFL Draft. Prior to his success at Penn, Bagnoli spent 10 seasons at Union (N.Y) where his achievements planted him in the Union Athletic Hall of Fame. After he played three seasons at Central Connecticut State, where he graduated in 1975, Bagnoli spent three seasons on the coaching staff at the University of Albany.
