#### CAROLINA VISITS #12 DUKE

- North Carolina faces Duke for the first of two regular season meetings on Thursday at 7 p.m.
- With the game played on Jan. 12, it marks the earliest meeting in a season since the 2003-04 campaign when the two met in Durham on Jan. 11, a 79-57 Blue Devil victory.
- UNC avoided its first 0-3 ACC start since the 1999-00 season with a 67-58 win over Virginia last time out on Sunday in Chapel Hill.
- UNC's last win at Cameron Indoor Stadium came in 2014 and is 2-7 in the building since 2008-09.
- Stephanie Watts ranks 2nd in the ACC in scoring (19.3) and 5th in rebounding (8.8).
- Stephanie Watts set an ACC record with 10 made three-pointers against Charleston Southern on Nov. 22. She also scored a career-high 39 points.
- Destinee Walker is averaging 18.7 points over the last six games.
- Paris Kea is averaging 6.8 assists in the last six games, having delivered at least five dimes in every one of those games.

- North Carolina spent 12-days in Scotland and Ireland this summer, playing three games against professional players and/or national teams from the two countries. Carolina's leading scorers: Stephanie Watts (18.3), Destinee Walker (15.3) and Paris Kea (14.3).
- In her 31st season at UNC, head coach Sylvia Hatchell is only 13 wins shy of 1,000 career victories. Hatchell has compiled the third most victories all-time behind Pat Summitt and Stanford's Tar VanDerveer.
- Hatchell received a two-year contract extension in September that will keep her in Chapel Hill through the 2019-20 season.
- Redshirt sophomore Paris Kea, a transfer from Vanderbilt, joins the Tar Heel backcourt for the 2016-17 season. She averaged 6.9 points and led the Commodores with 94 assists in the 2014-15 season. Kea was a member of the 2014 USA U18 National Team that won the FIBA Americas gold medal.
- North Carolina has eight new faces on the roster this season - seven freshmen and transfer Paris Kea. The incoming rookie class was ranked No. 13 by ESPN.
- Freshman Naomi Van Nes stands 6 foot, 6 inches tall. She is the tallest UNC player since 6-6 Waltiea Rolle from 2010-13. The Tar Heels have also added 6-4 Emily Sullivan and 6-3 Alyssa Okoene to the Tar Heel front court.
- Hillary Fuller set a career high with 13 rebounds against Bucknell, the fourth most in a game thus far in the ACC this season. She made her first collegiate start against Alabama State, scoring nine points in 17 minutes. It was her first game since March 27, 2015, after missing last season with an Achilles injury.
- Jamie Cherry's 12 assists against Minnesota on Nov. 25 was a career high for the junior point guard, and is tied for the second most in the ACC this season, trailing only Chanette Hick's 13 for Virginia Tech against Auburn.
- North Carolina is 9-0 this season when limiting opponents to 60 points or less.
- Stephanie Watts has made 59 three-pointers thus far this season, leading the ACC with 3.7 made per game. The UNC record is 107 3-pointers set by Ivory Latta in the 2006-07 campaign.
- Jamie Cherry ranks 17th in ACC history with a 81.2 career FT shooting percentage, tied with two former Clemson players.
- Sylvia Hatchell is 33-39 all-time against Duke going back to 1986-87.
- UNC ranks 4th in the ACC in free throw shooting at 72.1 percent. Jaime Cherry (83.0) and Paris Kea (81.6) are the top charity stripe shooter for the Tar Heels.
- Seven Tar Heels - Jamie Cherry, Hillary Fuller, Paris Kea, Taylor Koenen, Emily Sullivan, Destinee Walker and Stephanie Watts - have scored in double figures this season.
- Watts (6x), Kea (4x) and Walker (3x) have reached 20 points in a game a total of 13 times this season.
- Stephanie Watts leads the ACC and ranks 18th nationally with eight double-doubles. She had 15 in her two seasons with the Tar Heels.
- Carolina ranks 3rd in the ACC by averaging 8.3 three-point field goals per game.

#### LAST TIME OUT

Paris Kea finished one point shy of the first triple-double in program history to lead North Carolina to a 67-58 win over Virginia on Sunday at Carmichael Arena. The redshirt sophomore had nine points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists as the Tar Heels garnered their first ACC victory of the season.

UNC also received a double-double from Stephanie Watts with 15 points and 10 boards and Destinee Walker had a game-high 17 points. Taylor Koenen had 11.

Aliyah Huland El paced Virginia with 13 points, while J'Kyra Brown had 12 and Breyana Mason added 10.

Carolina seized control of the game by scoring the final 10 points of the game after Virginia took a 56-55 lead with 3:42 remaining.

#### LAST TIME VS. DUKE

Carolina closed out the 2015-16 regular season with a 93-57 loss to Duke inside Carmichael Arena. Freshman Stephanie Watts led UNC in scoring for the 11th time this season with 18 points, eight rebounds, five assists, three blocks and two steals. Hillary Summers recorded her eighth double-double of the year with 10 points and 15 rebounds. Destinee Walker registered double figures for the 27th time with 14 points.

Rebecca Greenwell paced Duke with a career-high 27 points. Oderah Chidom and Kyra Lambert added 20 and 14 points, respectively for the Blue Devils.

#### KEA NEARLY RECORDS FIRST UNC TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Paris Kea finished one point shy of the first triple-double in program history in a 67-58 win over Virginia on Sunday, Jan. 8. The redshirt sophomore had nine points and set career highs with 10 rebounds and 10 assists to notch her first career double-double.

#### KEA, WATTS AMONG TOP SCORING BACKCOURTS

#### WALKER ON FIRE LAST SIX GAMES

Sophomore guard Destinee Walker is averaging a team-leading 18.7 points per game in the last six games, scoring at least 20 points three times.

She has now scored in double figures in 10 of the last 13 games after not doing so in the first three games this season.

#### WATTS SETS ACC 3FG RECORD

Stephanie Watts set an ACC record with 10 three-pointers against Charleston Southern on Tuesday, Nov. 22, breaking the record of nine set three times by two different NC State players - Jennifer Howard (2x) and Myisha Goodwin-Coleman.

#### WATTS SCORES 39 ON CAREER DAY

Not only did Stephanie Watts set an ACC record with 10 three-pointers against Charleston Southern, she also scored a career-high 39 points, tying for the fifth most points ever scored by a Tar Heel player.

Watts also set a school record with 19 points scored in the first quarter alone.

#### WATTS AMONG NATIONS TOP SCORERS, SHOOTERS

Stephanie Watts prolific shooting this season has her listed among the top players in the nation. She ranks 25th in scoring at 19.3 points per game, and from beyond the arc she is third in three-pointers made (3.7) per game, first in three-point attempts (162) and fifth in three-pointers made (59).

#### ALL-AROUND ATHLETE

Sophomore Stephanie Watts is among the ACC leaders in a handful of stat categories: Second in scoring (19.3), 5th in rebounding (8.8), 4th in blocked shots (1.4), 11th in steals (2.2), 1st in three-pointers made per game (3.7), 3rd in defensive rebounds (5.9) and 7th in offensive rebounds (2.9).

#### KEA PROTECTS THE ROCK

Paris Kea's 2.4 assists-turnover ratio leads UNC and is 3rd in the ACC. She has 75 assists against 31 turnovers. Additionally, she ranks 14th in the conference at 14.4 ppg, 6th in assists (4.7) and 9th in steals (2.3).

#### SHOULDERING THE LOAD

Paris Kea and Stephanie Watts have each scored in double figures at least 13 times this season. Both have registered 20 or more points four or more times, and each have scored more than 30 in a game.

#### HATCHELL RECEIVES CONTRACT EXTENSION

Naismith Hall of Fame head coach Sylvia Hatchell received a two-year contract extension in September that will keep her in Chapel Hill through the 2019-20 season.

#### HATCHELL SECOND AMONG ACTIVE CAREER WINS LEADER

With 987 career wins, UNC Hall of Fame coach Sylvia Hatchell owns the second most wins among active women's basketball coaches, trailing only Stanford's Tara VanDerveer.

Tennessee legend Pat Summitt is the all-time leader with 1,098 wins.

#### LARA (PRINGLE) SANDERS EXCELLED AT 2016 RIO OLYMPICS

Lara Sanders, better known as LaToya Pringle to North Carolina women's basketball fans, turned in a fantastic performance playing for Turkey at the 2016 Rio Olympics.

The former Tar Heel standout all six games, averaging a team-leading 22.0 points per game. Sanders scored a personal best 36 points against Japan.

## CAROLINA INKS THREE ON NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

Janelle Bailey of Matthews, North Carolina, Leah Church of Purlear, North Carolina and Jaelynn Murray of Columbia, South Carolina signed National Letters of Intent to play women's basketball for the University of North Carolina.

**BAILY:** Five-star rated by ESPN • Ranked 4th best forward in 2017 class by ESPN • Selected to the USA FIBA U17 World Championship team • Averaged 9.3 points and 9.1 rebounds, helping the team to a bronze medal finish • Three-time all-state selection • Led Providence Day School to its eighth straight N.C. Independent Schools championship as a junior, averaging 16.8 points and 8.8 rebounds • Has career totals of 1,415 points and 711 rebounds at Providence Day School.

**MURRAY:** Three-star rated by ESPN • Named one of the top-5 elite players in South Carolina • Led Dreher High School to a pair of state championships • Selected all-state and 4-AAA All-Region • Team captain for both basketball and volleyball teams • Has scored 1,118 career points • Averaged 18.5 points, 7.8 rebounds and 1.9 blocks per game as a junior • Cousin of Seventh Woods, a freshman on the UNC men's basketball team.

**CHURCH:** A record holder in both free throw and three-point shooting • Inscribed in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame for winning the National Hoop Shoot free throw contest • Made 32 three-pointers in one minute to break the previous world record (27) • Also recognized by ESPN for making 120 three-pointers in five minutes • A home schooled student that plays basketball at Forest Trail Academy (Kernersville, N.C.) • Led club to the NISAA Championship runner-up finish in 2015-16 • Has made 337 three-pointers and is approaching 2,000 career points heading into senior season.

## THE #CHERRYBOMB LEGEND

Junior Jamie Cherry has made it a habit of making big shots in big moments. Her most famous shot was the game-winning three-pointer with 0.6 seconds left against Ohio State in the NCAA Tournament second round that was the No. 1 play that night on SportsCenter on March 23, 2015.

The first long-distance shot came at halftime of the game with ETSU on Jan. 2, 2015. Cherry later hit a 40-foot buzzer beater against Louisville in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals to send the game into overtime on March 6, 2015.

As a sophomore, she made a half-court shot at the end of the first quarter against Oklahoma State on Dec. 14, and in the first round of the 2016 ACC Championship, Cherry's three-pointer at the end of regulation sent the game against Pitt into OT.

North Carolina head coach Sylvia Hatchell solidified her place among the legends of basketball when she was chosen for induction into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame as a member of the class of 2013.

Hatchell's career record of 975-358 puts her second among active women's coach and third in the history of the sport to the legendary Pat Summitt and Stanford's Tara Vanderveer in career victories. With a 703-278 mark at Carolina, Hatchell stands as one of only two coaches - along with former Virginia coach Debbie Ryan - to reach the 700-win mark at an Atlantic Coast Conference school.

Beyond the sheer magnitude of wins, Hatchell's credentials are sterling. She was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 2004, has been named national coach of the year three times and has led teams to at least 20 wins 31 times, fourth-most nationally.

While Hatchell keeps impressive company in many categories, she is also part of an exclusive club that features just one member. When UNC defeated Louisiana Tech to win the 1994 NCAA Championship, Hatchell became the first and only coach to lead teams to national championships at the AIAW, NAIA and NCAA levels. Those titles - the first two coming at Francis Marion - are the crown jewels in one of the most decorated coaching careers in women's basketball history.

Though Hatchell's highly-regarded coaching career has made her a pillar in the sport of basketball, more recently she is best known for her battle with leukemia that forced her to the sidelines for the entire 2013-14 season. Only weeks removed from induction into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, Hatchell was diagnosed with leukemia in October 2013.

Hatchell went through a series of chemotherapy treatments that lasted into March 2014, the same time her Tar Heel team clawed its way to the Elite 8 and was minutes away from a spot in the NCAA Final Four, before falling to Stanford on its home court in the Regional Final. There was hope that Hatchell would rejoin the team if Carolina had reached the Finals Four in Nashville, Tennessee.

In May 2014, Hatchell's doctor announced that she had completed all treatments and would be back on the bench for the 2014-15 campaign. And in typical program fashion, the Tar Heels had another outstanding season, posting a 26-9 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Hatchell continues to be an adamant supporter of the fight against cancer with help from her teammates at UNC Lineberger Cancer Center. Hatchell fills her calendar with numerous speaking engagements to raise money and awareness of the deadly disease.

In June 2016, her book *Fight! Fight! Discover Your Inner Strength When Blinded by Life* was released to rave reviews, and within days became the No. 1 Amazon new release in the "cancer books" category.

"I wrote this book because I wanted to help other people as they go through difficult times," Hatchell said. "People are going through some extremely trying things in life, and I'm always inspired by the courage and boldness that they display. All I want to be is a guide for others as they face some unfathomable challenges in life."

Since coming to Chapel Hill in 1986, Hatchell has forged a tradition of excellence at Carolina. Under her direction, the Tar Heels have won a national championship and eight ACC titles, compiled six 30-win seasons and claimed five ACC Player of the Year and seven ACC Rookie of the Year honors. "With the reputation of the school, the image, the location and the athletic programs - including the men's basketball program - I knew we could build a tremendous women's basketball program here," Hatchell says.

While that 1994 championship season, which capped back-to-back 30-win seasons, marked Carolina as a player on the national scene, Hatchell and the Tar Heels have surged to the forefront of that scene in recent years. Since the beginning of the 2004-05 season, UNC has compiled a record of 279-69, won four Atlantic Coast Conference titles and made two Final Four appearances.

With Hatchell away from the team in her normal capacity in 2013-14, associate head coach Andrew Calder guided the club to a 27-10 record and a No. 4 seed in the Stanford Region. The Tar Heels appeared in the Elite 8 for the seventh time in program history, defeated No. 1 seed South Carolina in the regional semifinals and swept Duke in the regular season for the first time in six years.

The 2012-13 season saw Carolina reclaim its position as one of the top teams in America. The Tar Heels finished with a record of 29-7 that featured a Preseason WNIT championship and a run to the ACC Tournament title game. UNC received the No. 3 seed in the NCAA Bridgeport Region, its highest NCAA seed since earning four consecutive No. 1 seeds from 2005-08.

The 2007-08 campaign featured a Carolina first under Hatchell - the Tar Heels completed an undefeated ACC regular season. In addition to winning all 14 regular season contests, the Tar Heels brought home a fourth-straight tournament crown by defeating Duke, 86-73. UNC earned a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight postseason and advanced to the Elite Eight.

Hatchell's Tar Heels were among the nation's best throughout the 2006-07 season, which saw Carolina establish a school record

for wins with 34. UNC opened the campaign with a 24-game winning streak, the best start to a season in school history. Along the way the Tar Heels defeated national powers Tennessee and Connecticut as well as defending national champion Maryland. March saw Carolina win its third ACC championship in as many years and advance to the Final Four for the third time in program history.

The 2005-06 season was one of the most successful in program history and Hatchell was honored accordingly. The Tar Heels earned the program's first in-season No. 1 ranking, won a second-consecutive ACC title and reached the Final Four. Hatchell was honored as national coach of the year by the Associated Press, the WBCA and Basketball Times. She also received the Naismith Award and was named ACC Coach of the Year.

Among the players Hatchell has coached during her career are Charlotte Smith, a national player of the year whose last-second shot won the 1994 national championship and who now coaches Elon University; Marion Jones, the point guard on the 1994 team; forward Tracy Reid, a two-time ACC Player of the Year and the 1998 WNBA Rookie of the Year; and Ivory Latta, the 2006 national player of the year and a two-time WNBA All-Star with Washington. Other former Tar Heels with WNBA experience are Nikki Teasley, who hit the winning shot as the Los Angeles Sparks won the 2002 league championship and was named MVP of the 2003 WNBA All-Star Game; Coretta Brown, who played for the Chicago Sky; La'Tangela Atkinson, a first-round draft pick in 2006; Camille Little, another first-round pick who won a WNBA title with Seattle; Erlana Larkins, a consensus All-America in 2008 who won a WNBA title with Indiana; LaToya Pringle, UNC's career leader in blocks; Jessica Breland, who bravely returned from a battle with Hodgkin's lymphoma to lead the 2010-11 Tar Heels to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen; and Tierra Ruffin-Pratt, who went from undrafted free agent to key contributor for the WNBA's Washington Mystic in 2013.

In preparation for a career in coaching, Hatchell earned a B.S. degree in physical education and health from Carson-Newman in 1974. While at Carson-Newman, in addition to playing basketball and volleyball, Hatchell coached the Talbott School girls' basketball team to a winning season and a trip to the playoffs. She then spent a year coaching the junior varsity women's team and earning a master's degree at the University of Tennessee.

Prior to taking over the Tar Heel program, Hatchell guided Francis Marion to a 272-80 mark over 11 seasons. She coached the 1986 Lady Patriots to a remarkable 36-2 record and a National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics national championship. Her 1982 team was her first national championship squad, as Francis Marion captured the AIAW small college division crown.

In 1984, the Lady Patriots posted a 28-5 record, advancing to the quarterfinals of the NAIA national tournament, and received the Fellowship of Christian Athletes National Team Sportsmanship Award. Under Hatchell's direction, Francis Marion routinely led the nation in scoring and the Lady Patriots were never ranked lower than 18th during her 11 seasons. In 1993, Hatchell was inducted into the Francis Marion University Athletic Hall of Fame.

Hatchell's collegiate success is only a part of her impressive head coaching resume. In August 1995, she led the U.S. to a silver medal at the World University Games in Fukuoka, Japan. Former Tar Heels Sylvia Crawley and Charlotte Smith were key members of the team, and Marion Jones was named to the team but broke a bone in her foot and could not compete.

During the summer of 1994, Hatchell directed the United States team to the gold medal in the R. William Jones Cup. The team's 8-0 record included a 76-67 win over Canada and a 90-89 overtime victory against Korea in the championship game. Hatchell also has extensive international experience as an assistant coach of U.S. women's teams. She was an assistant coach for the U.S. team that claimed the gold medal at the 1988 Olympic Games and served in the same capacity for the 1986 U.S. national women's squad that won gold medals at both the Goodwill Games and World Championships. In fact, she was at training camp with that national team at Eastern Michigan University when she received the call from Swofford informing her that she would be Carolina's next coach.

Hatchell's stints in international competition also include serving as an assistant coach for the U.S. World University Games team that won the gold medal in 1983 and the team that won a silver medal in 1985. She was a court coach at the U.S. Olympic basketball tryouts in both 1984 and 1992 and also worked on the

Olympic Games basketball events staff in Los Angeles in 1984. In her initial task for the Amateur Basketball Association of the United States of America, she coached the South team to the gold medal at the 1982 National Sports Festival. In 1979, Hatchell joined legendary Maryland coach Chris Weller to coach the East All-Stars at the Hanes All-American Classic. The West team was led by Jody Conradt of Texas and Sonja Hogg of Louisiana Tech.

In addition to her national coach of the year honors, Hatchell's long list of coaching awards includes the 1986 Converse NAIA Regional Coach of the Year and the 1986 AMF Voit Championship Coach Award. In 1995, she was named College Basketball Coach of the Year by Athletes International Ministries.

Actively involved in shaping the sport of women's basketball, Hatchell served as president of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association during the 1996-97 season.

Hatchell graduated cum laude from Carson-Newman College, where she played basketball and volleyball. In March 1994, she was honored as the Carson-Newman Distinguished Alumnus of the Year and in 1999 she was inducted into the school's Athletic Hall of Fame. In the summer of 2009, Hatchell had the honor of being inducted into both the North Carolina and South Carolina Sports Halls of Fame.

Hatchell's husband, Sammy, was also a basketball coach. Formerly the all-time winningest coach at Meredith College in Raleigh, Sammy was the associate head coach of the Shaw University women's team that won the 2012 Division II national title. Fittingly, the couple met at a summer league basketball game and attended a basketball clinic on their first date. They married two years later, in 1979. Sammy helps run the North Carolina basketball camps each summer.
