## Seawolves post 21 wins, finish GNAC runner-up in 2016-17

### ALASKA ANCHORAGE MEN'S BASKETBALL 2016-17 SEASON REVIEW

**BRIEF SEASON RECAP:** UAA posted its second consecutive 21-win campaign and the program's 12th straight winning record with a 21-8 overall mark and a runner-up finish (15-5) in the GNAC standings in 2016-17 ... the Seawolves posted their first perfect mark at the Alaska Airlines Center by going 16-0 on their home court, and recorded yet another victory over a Div. I club, beating Drake in the GCI Great Alaska Shootout ... the Seawolves were regionally ranked in all three West Region polls at the end of the regular season but fell just shy of earning an NCAA Tournament berth.

**TEAM NOTES:** UAA earned its first back-to-back 20-win seasons since 2010-11 and 2011-12 and the 16th 20-win season in 40 years of program history ... this also marked the program's 12th straight winning season and the 34th in 40 years ... the Seawolves have now earned seven straight winning GNAC records and qualified to the GNAC Tournament every year since its founding in 2011 ... the Seawolves were among the top 50 NCAA Div. II stats leaders in eight categories, including four marks in the top 20 – rebound margin (2nd, +10.5), scoring defense (13th, 66.6), offensive rebounds per game (13th, 13.83) and scoring margin (19th, +12.0) ... in the GNAC stats, UAA paced the 11-team league in scoring defense, scoring margin, FG% defense (.418), and six of the seven rebounding categories ... UAA's defensive efforts of five straight games with under 55 points allowed (Dec. 17-Jan. 5) and three straight games with under 50 points allowed (Dec. 29-Jan. 5) were both program firsts, while the 30-13 halftime lead against Simon Fraser on Feb. 4 marked the Seawolves' fewest points allowed in the first half of a GNAC game ... the final game of the season – a 91-84 triple-overtime loss to Western Oregon in the GNAC Tournament semifinals – equaled

the longest game in program history along with a 92-87 3OT home win over Caldwell on Nov. 18, 2004 – **Rusty Osborne's** first game as head coach ... the Seawolves set 14 other school records in 2016-17, with 13 individual marks and one team record (fewest points allowed in 2nd half, 10 vs Trinity Western, Dec. 17) ... UAA's .684 3FG% (13-19) at Central Washington on Dec. 1 ranked as the 7th-best single-game effort in program history, while the 17 rebounds allowed against BYU-Hawaii tied for 6th-fewest ever by a Seawolf club.

**SUKI SMOOTH:** Picking up his second straight unanimous First Team All-GNAC and D2CCA First Team All-West Region awards, Sr. G **Sekou 'Suki' Wiggs** led the league and ranked 5th nationally with 24.4 ppg, tallying at least 20 points in 21 of 29 games – including his school-record 46 points at Central Washington on Dec. 1 – and a program-record string of four straight games with at least 30 points, Jan. 26-Feb. 4 ... in two seasons, the 2015-16 D2CCA Third Team All-American and GNAC Newcomer of the Year ranks broke UAA's record for career scoring average at 24.2 ppg and finished No. 5 on the career scoring list with 1,477 points; he also crushed the program record by reaching 1,000 points in just 42 games ... in addition to capturing back-to-back GNAC Player of the Week awards in late January/early February, the former transfer from Div. I Idaho jumped from 12th to 5th in the nation in scoring after Jan. 25, when he began a school-record string of four straight 30-plus performances ... in other GNAC stats, he finished 13th in assists (2.8 apg), 17th in rebounding (5.6 rpg), 8th in 3FGs per game (2.3) and 1st in FTs made per game (6.3) ... Wiggs finished No. 3 on UAA's single-season scoring average list, becoming the first Seawolf to average more than 23 points in two different seasons ... with 11 30-point efforts, he was just the third Seawolf with that many in a career (Jason Kaiser [13], Jesse Jackson [16]), while his 25 25-plus performances were second only to Jackson [26] ... on UAA's career lists, Wiggs placed 1st in scoring average (24.2 ppg), 2nd in FTs made (426), 1st in FTs made per game (7.0), 16th in assists per game (3.0), 13th in steals per game (1.4) and 15th in double-doubles (9).

**SPOT-ON SPENCER:** A Second Team All-GNAC performer, Sr. G **Spencer Svejcar** emerged as UAA's 2nd-leading scorer and ranked 13th in the GNAC with 15.1 ppg, tallying double figures in 25 of 29 contests ... the Colorado native was one of the GNAC's most accurate shooters from any distance, ranking 4th in the league in FT% (.863) and 3rd in 3FG% (.458), along with other ranks of 19th in assists (2.4 apg) and 5th in 3FGs per game (2.4) ... in the national stats, he was 47th in FT% ... Svejcar dished a career-high 7 assists in the home victory over Seattle Pacific and had 12 games this year with at least three dimes ...the former Laramie (Wyo.) CC transfer tallied double figures in 45 of 59 games as a Seawolf, drawing 58 starting assignments ... on UAA's career lists, he was 8th in FT% (.853), 14th in 3FG% (.410) and 17th in 3FGs made (125), while on the single-season lists he was 14th in FT%, 11th in 3FG%, 17th in 3FGs per game and 14th in 3FGs made (71).

**DIANTE'S EN FUEGO:** Sr. G **Diante Mitchell** was one of the most effective floor generals in the GNAC this season, ranking 7th in the league with 3.0 assists per game and 29th in scoring at 12.4 ppg ... the former Western Nebraska transfer led the GNAC in overall FT% at .883 – including clinching charities against Cal State LA, Saint Martin's and Western Washington, and the game-winning 3-point play with 4.8 seconds left in overtime at Seattle Pacific – while his .910 rate (61 of 67) in league games led the GNAC by .038 ... the Seawolves' 3rd-leading scorer recorded 17 games with 12 or more points, including 25 points in the home victories over WWU and SPU, plus 21 points in the road win over UAF ... Mitchell was the Seawolves' representative on the

GCI Great Alaska Shootout after helping UAA to a discretionary exhibition victory over Div. I Drake ... on UAA's career list the Utah native finished No. 4 in FT% at .872 and No. 15 in 3FG% at .408.

**HAMMELL TIME:** After leading the GNAC by nearly three boards per game in his debut season, Sr. F **Corey Hammell** finished runner-up in 2016-17, trailing Northwest Nazarene's Maurice Jones 10.4 to 9.8 rpg ... the 2015-16 2nd Team All-GNAC selection and '16-17 preseason all-GNAC pick ranked 5th in NCAA Div. II with 4.24 offensive rebounds per game and stood 29th in overall rebounding ... in 61 games as a Seawolf, Hammell had

35 double-digit rebounding efforts and broke Todd Fisher's 27-year-old UAA career record of 9.7 rpg, finishing at 10.0 rpg ... Hammell had seven double-doubles this season, and his 10 career games with 15-plus boards are 2nd-most in program history ... the Santa Rosa (Calif.) JC transfer was also one of the most productive players in program history at the free throw line, ranking 7th in FTs made (304), 17th in FT% (.819) and 3rd in FTs made per game (5.0) ... on the other career lists, he placed 4th in both total rebounds (609) and double-doubles (21).

**DEVINE PRESENCE:** Sr. C Connor Devine was UAA's first true post presence in recent seasons and its best shot-blocker in the GNAC era after transferring from Div. I mid-major power South Dakota State in the off-season ... the former 4A state player of the year at Wasilla High emerged as UAA's 4th-leading scorer (8.3 ppg) and 3rd-leading rebounder (4.4 rpg), while leading the way with program records of 76 total blocks and 2.62 blocks per game ... with 60 blocks in 20 GNAC games, Devine vaulted to 2nd in the league and now 11th nationally ... Devine sported additional GNAC ranks of 8th in FG% (.534) and 20th in steals (0.9 spg) ... In November, Devine had 14.5 ppg and 7.0 rpg in the Seawolf Jamboree to earn all-tourney honors and help UAA to critical West Region victories over Cal State LA and BYU-Hawaii, and he had his best all-around game in the season finale against Western Oregon with 20 points (8-10 FG, 4-4 FT), 5 rebounds and 6 blocks in the 3OT GNAC Semifinals loss.

**THE OSBORNE FILE:** Completing his 13th year at the helm, head coach Rusty Osborne (250-138) has now led the Seawolves to 12 straight winning seasons, along with five NCAA Tournaments and a trip to the 2008 NCAA D-II Semifinals ... the longest tenured coach in program history and currently with the second-longest tenure in the GNAC, he became the first UAA basketball coach to reach 200 career victories when the Seawolves beat Alaska Fairbanks on Jan. 10, 2015 ... Osborne captured his first career GNAC and NABC West District coach-of-the-year awards in 2008 after becoming the second coach to lead UAA to three consecutive NCAA berths (2006-08), and in 2011-12 his Seawolves posted a 24-10 record to equal the 2nd-most victories in program history; Osborne's 2007-08 club holds that record with a 29-6 mark ... before taking over the head job in 2004-05, the Texas native previously served 13 seasons (1991-04) as a UAA assistant, including 11 years as the top assistant ... the Seawolves have won over 60 percent of their games with Osborne on the staff, claiming four conference titles and eight trips to the NCAA Division II Tournament ... Osborne was assisted in 2016-17 by Cameron Turner (6th season), Scott Friel (1st season) and former Seawolf guard Jesse Brown (1st season).
