**SHOWCASE SHOWDOWNS:** The Seawolves will host the 'A' pod of the 2017 D2 West Region Volleyball Showcase, presented by Hilton Garden Inn, this week at the Alaska Airlines Center on the UAA campus ... played on the same court as last year's Div. II West Regional Championships, the event features the top two finishers from each of the region's three conferences, with a predetermined 'cross-over' schedule ... the 'A' pod features five nationally ranked teams (No. 10 Western Washington, No. 11 Cal State San Bernardino, No. 14 UAA, No. 15 Concordia-Irvine and No. 24 Cal Baptist) and five teams that made the NCAA Tournament last season (UAA, WWU, CSUSB, CBU and Chico State) ... along with Anchorage, the Showcase will feature pods in Ellensburg, Wash.; Nampa, Idaho; Lacey, Wash.; Monmouth, Ore.; and San Francisco ... this is the fourth year of the Showcase, which featured only GNAC and Pac West Conference teams in 2014 and 2015, before adding CCAA programs in 2016.

**UAA SHOWCASE HISTORY:** The Seawolves are 11-1 in the Showcase with eight straight victories, suffering their lone loss in a 5-setter to Pac West foe Dixie State in 2014 ... last year in Rohnert Park, Calif., UAA beat Cal State San Bernardino (3-2), Dixie State (3-1), Cal Baptist (3-1) and host Sonoma State (3-1) ... overall, UAA is 9-1 vs the Pac West and 2-0 vs. the CCAA.

**Last:** UAA 3-1 (9/10/16 at Rohnert Park, CA) / **Notes:** UAA won the initial neutral-court meeting vs. then-No. 25 CBU at the D2 West Region Showcase last year at Sonoma State ... the first meeting was a 3-1 UAA victory in 2003 when CBU was an NAIA program ... this will likely be the last meeting in a long while between the programs as CBU is headed to Div. I next season.

**vs CSU San Bernardino:** CSUSB leads 7-3 overall, 1-0 at UAA  
**Last:** UAA 3-2 (9/8/16 at UAA) / **Streak:** CSUSB 1 / **Notes:** The last two meetings have gone five sets, with UAA winning at last year's West Region Showcase in Rohnert Park, Calif., and the Coyotes prevailing in the 2015 NCAA Tournament Second Round clash in Anchorage ... teams have played nine times since 2009 ... first meeting was a 3-0 UAA neutral-court win in 1993.

**SEASIDE SPLIT:** The then-No. 4 Seawolves opened by splitting four matches against West Region competition at the Seaside Invitational in San Diego last week, beating Cal State LA (3-0) and host Point Loma (3-2), and losing in 5-setters to UC San Diego and Azusa Pacific ... Jr. OH Leah Swiss hit .256 with 22 combined kills in the two victories to earn a spot on the *all-tournament team*, and So. Diana Fa'amausili racked up 43 kills and 23 blocks throughout the four matches ... UAA

used its new '6-2' offensive scheme, with So. S Madison Fisher and Fr. S Casey Davenport combining for 9.24 assists per set ... Sr. L Keala Kaio-Perez made her debut as starting libero with 3.22 digs per set and 9 aces, while Jr. MB Tara Melton — one of six Seawolf newcomers — had a team-best 1.36 blocks per set and tallied 15 kills over the final three matches.

**BRIEF SEASON PREVIEW:** The Seawolves return four starters — including all-conference hitters Leah Swiss and Diana Fa'amausili — and five reserves from their 2016 NCAA Runner-Up team as they seek a third straight Great Northwest Athletic Conference title and a fifth straight NCAA Tournament berth ... six newcomers will vie for playing time, too, as UAA tries to offset the loss of all-conference performers at setter, middle blocker and libero.

**2016 SEASON RECAP:** The 2016 UAA volleyball team recorded the best season in program history, reaching the NCAA Div. II National Title Match and earning its second straight Great Northwest Athletic Conference outright title, while posting records of 34-3 overall and 19-1 in league ... among their 40 school records included marks for most victories, longest win streak (20) and most consecutive NCAA Tournament berths (4) as the Seawolves won their first West Region title ... led by *National Coach of the Year* **Chris Green** and *GNAC and West Region player of the year* **Morgan Hooe**, UAA posted seven wins over nationally ranked opponents and went 33-1 from Aug. 27-Dec. 9, with that lone loss coming in a 20-18 fifth set against the league runner-up ... in addition to All-America honors for Hooe and **Leah Swiss**, right-side hitter **Diana Fa'amausili** was tabbed the *GNAC and West Region freshman of the year*.

**ELITE EIGHT RECAP:** The Seawolves reached their first NCAA Div. II Elite Eight in program history in 2016, earning the No. 6 seed for the national quarterfinal, semifinal and final rounds, Dec. 8-10 at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, South Dakota ... the nationally 9th-ranked Seawolves posted 4-set wins over 12th-ranked Angelo State and 10th-ranked Palm Beach Atlantic to earn a berth in their first NCAA Title Match, where they fell in straight sets to top-ranked and 8-time national champion Concordia St. Paul ... Sr. S Morgan Hooe and **Chrisalyn Johnson** were both named to the *All-NCAA Tournament Team*.

**2016 WEST REGION CHAMPS:** The regionally top-seeded Seawolves earned their program's first regional title with a wins over Chico State, Northwest Nazarene and No. 16 Western Washington in the West Regional Championships at the Alaska Airlines Center, Dec. 1-3 ... after an impressive sweep of Chico State (25-21, 25-18, 25-15) in the first round, UAA needed a dramatic comeback to fend off 5th-seeded and GNAC rival NNU (25-17, 22-25, 25-21, 23-25, 15-10) in the regional semis ... trailing 9-5 in the 5th set against NNU, **Leah Swiss** ripped six kills and Sr. MB Erin Braun accounted for three points in the final 11 rallies to earn UAA's first-ever NCAA 2nd Round victory ... in the regional final, Swiss had 16 kills and 12 digs, and Sr. S Morgan Hooe made a dramatic return from injury to power a 19-25, 27-25, 25-21, 25-23 win over 16th-ranked and 3rd-seeded Western Washington ... Braun had 15 kills on .424 hitting, **Chrisalyn Johnson** had 10 kills and a career-high 24 digs, and So. L Kyla Militante-Amper tied the the second-most digs in the UAA single-match history with 39 ... Hooe, Swiss, Braun and **Diana Fa'amausili** gave UAA four of the 12 honorees on the all-tournament team.

**A HOWL LOTTA LOVE:** UAA led NCAA Div. II Volleyball in attendance for the second straight season in 2016, with its 1,387 per game far outdistancing Angelo State ... the Seawolves drew five of the year's top seven single-match attendance totals, with their 2,710 for the West Regional final standing as the program record and the second-highest attendance for any D-II match since 2013.

**TEAM NOTES:** Boosted by its NCAA Tournament run, UAA went 7-2 last season against AVCA Top 25 teams and is 15-5 against ranked teams since 2014 ... UAA is 25-32 against ranked opponents under Green, after having lost 32 straight prior to his arrival in 2008 ... UAA has gone 20-3 against regular-season, non-conference op-



ponents since 2015, including 8-0 at home ... the season-opening loss to UCSD snapped a 26-match win streak in the month of September, dating back to Sept. 25, 2014 ... the Seawolves are 40-6 at the Alaska Airlines Center since its opening in Sept. 2014, and 86-17 at home since 2009 ... among their 40 program team and individual records in 2016, the Seawolves broke the marks for victories and winning percentage set in 2015 by the 27-3 squad ... the 2016 Seawolves also put up team records for most road wins (13), most consecutive wins (20), most consecutive sweeps (6), most consecutive sets won (22) and highest AVCA national ranking (No. 3) ... the five longest win streaks in program history have all occurred since head coach **Chris Green's** second season in 2009.

(.242) ... in the NCAA West Regional Championships, she accounted for 4.25 kps, 3.00 dps and 0.67 bps, posting double-doubles in all three matches and making the all-tournament team ... **GREEN MACHINE:** Having led UAA to an unprecedented nine straight winning seasons, UAA head coach **Chris Green** (195-74, .725) has established himself as the most successful coach in program history and one of the top mentors in the NCAA Div. II ranks, earning the **2016 AVCA D-II National Coach of the Year** award ... now a **4-time GNAC Coach of the Year** (2009, 2013, 2015, 2016) and **2-time AVCA D-II West Region Coach of the Year** (2009, 2015), Green has led UAA to NCAA Tournament berths in seven of the last eight seasons, capturing the program's highest-ever seeds the last three years ... in the 28 years before Green's arrival, the Seawolves made two NAAs ... UAA has won at an .813 clip (105-24) since the start of the 2013 campaign, including .882 (67-9) in league play ... after helping the Seawolves to a 10-win turnaround in his first season, Green earned both GNAC and NCAA Div. II West Region coach-of-the-year honors in 2009 when he piloted UAA to its first GNAC title and the program's first-ever NCAA victory ...
