

Athletic Insurance Policy Information

The University's Athletic health insurance is a secondary (basic) plan. Your primary insurance plan may be billed first. If you do not have a primary health insurance and/or your primary health insurance plan does not provide out of state coverage, you will be responsible for any expenses not paid for by the DSU secondary insurance plan. An athletic trainer will assist the injured athlete with submitting their claim form. A claim may only be filed for an injury sustained during a sanctioned athletic practice or competition.

It is the responsibility of the athlete to follow up with the insurance company regarding any bills and/or payments. In the need of assistance or inquiries, please contact:
