



ARKANSAS STATE POSTGAME NOTES vs. SOUTH ALABAMA (Nov. 11, 2017)

TEAM

- A-State's team captains were senior **Dee Liner**, juniors **Justice Hansen** and **Justin McInnis** and sophomores **BJ Edmonds** and **Darveon Brown**.

OFFENSE

- A-State went over 300 yards total offense for the 87th time over its last 98 games, including every game this season.
- Junior QB **Justice Hansen** threw multiple TD passes for the 10th consecutive game. He now has 27 for the season and 46 for his career . . . Hansen became the sixth player in A-State history to record 5,000 passing yards in a career . . . He recorded over 200 passing yards for the ninth consecutive game and 15th time of his career.
- Senior WR **Christian Booker** hauled in his 3rd TD reception of the year.
- Senior WR **Chris Murray** caught his seventh TD pass, which ties the fourth most in school history for a single season. His 11 career TD receptions tie the seventh most ever by an A-State player.

DEFENSE

- A-State recorded at least 5 TFL for the 25th consecutive game. A-State finished with double-figure TFL for the third consecutive game, while their 10 total ties their second most this year.
- The Red Wolves recorded at least 1 turnover gained for the 39th time in 47 games under defensive coordinator Joe Cauthen.
- Junior DE **Ronheen Bingham** recorded a career-high 2 sacks.
- Senior DE **Ja'Von Rolland-Jones** recorded at least 1 sack for the fifth consecutive game, running his total to 9.0 on the year to tie the 10th most in school history for a single season. He now owns three of the top 10 single-season marks in school history.
- Senior CB **Kyle Martin** posted a career-high 9 tackles, topping his previous high by four stops.
- Senior CB **Blaise Taylor** recorded his second career forced fumble, while also picking up his first career fumble recovery.
- Sophomore safety **BJ Edmonds** recorded 13 tackles, which tied his career high. He finished with double-figure stops for a team-high third time this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Sophomore K **Sawyer Williams** made 2-of-3 field goals, marking the fourth time this season he has converted multiple attempts in a game. He has now made at least 1 FG in five consecutive games and is 11-of-15 on the year.
- Sophomore punter **Cody Grace** recorded multiple punts inside the opponent's 20-yard line for the seventh time this season. He has at least one punt inside the 20 every game.
- True freshman **Jonathan Adams Jr.** posted a season-high 55 yard kickoff return on just his third career attempt. The 55-yard return was the longest since Daryl Rollins-Davis had a 78-yard return last year against ULM in A-State's 7th game.
