Team Notes/Up Next

- Raigyne Louis scored 17 points at Texas Tech on Nov. 30 for the 74th double-figure scoring game of her career. Her current double-digit scoring streak is up to 23 consecutive games going into the Tulane game.
- Faustine Aifuwa, a redshirt freshman, grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds and blocked a career-high 3 shots at Texas Tech on Nov. 30.
- Chloe Jackson and Raigyne Louis scored 23 points each, against Saint Louis on Nov. 25. The pair scored 20 or more points for the second game in a row, following the Nov. 24 performances of 23 and 20 points against nationally-ranked Texas.
- Raigyne Louis needs three assists to become the only Lady Tiger with 1,300 points, 600 rebounds, 200 steals and 275 assists in a career. The preseason All-SEC Coaches selection has 1,340 points, 601 rebounds, 243 steals and 272 assists.
- Three true freshmen have made at least one start so far this season. Khayla Pointer and Raven Farley have started three

games, Nicholls, Texas and Saint Louis, while Jailin Cherry made her first start in a Lady Tiger uniform on Nov. 10 at No. 23/22 USF. Redshirt freshman Faustine Aifuwa has made two starts, against Southeastern and at Northern Colorado.

Raigyne Louis is the former Raigyne Moncrief, the defending SEC Defensive Player of the Year. She married former LSU football player Lamar Louis over the summer and will go by her married name for her senior year.

This will be the 39th meeting between LSU and Tulane. LSU holds an 30-8 series lead with the last meeting occurring on Dec. 11, 2016, a 69-51 win. The Green Wave are 5-4 on the season following Tuesday's 79-56 win over New Orleans.

UP NEXT: The Lady Tigers will host UL Lafayette on Sunday, Dec. 17. Tip time is set for 2 p.m. on SEC Network Plus and the LSU Sports Radio Network. Patrick Wright and Jeff Palermo will call the action for the radio audience, while Lyn Rollins and Victor Howell will call the game on SECN+.

Fargas Ranks 2nd In Program History For Total Wins

With the win over her alma mater Tennessee on Feb. 21, 2016, head coach Nikki Fargas became the second-winningest coach in school history in terms of total wins. She is behind legendary coach Sue Gunter who tallied 442 victories in 22 seasons. Fargas recorded her 100th victory on the LSU sideline with the commanding, 69-51, win over in-state rival Tulane on Dec. 11, 2016. Here's a look at LSU's coaching history:

In her seventh season, Fargas is 21-23 in non-SEC games on the road (includes neutral sites & NCAA post-season play) and 41-8 in non-conference games at the PMAC. *These records do not include the SEC Tournament, which are not considered SEC games but are versus SEC foes.*

Twenty-Something, Times Three

Chloe Jackson and Raigyne Louis got on a roll against Saint Louis on Nov. 25 and produced matching 23-point performances. It was the second game in a row that the pair put up the 20-plus scoring games. Louis now had 18 career games of 20 or more points, while Jackson has nine games reaching the mark.

The last time two LSU players scored 23 or more points in a game was Feb. 7, 2010 against Ole Miss. Allison Hightower scored 31 and LaSondra Barrett scored 23 in the triple overtime, 102-101 loss.

Jackson and Louis earned their second 20-plus scoring games of the season on Nov. 24 in a 75-66 loss to nationally-ranked Texas. Jackson scored a team-high 23 points, 15 in the second half, while Louis scored 20, including the Lady Tigers first nine points of the game.

Louis produced the second 20+ point game of the season against Southeastern on Nov. 12 with 21 points in the home opener. It was the second game in a row that a Lady Tiger had scored 20 or more points in a game.

Jackson led LSU with 21 points against No. 23/22 USF in the season opener. She scored 15 of the Lady Tigers' 25 points in the first half.

Award Watch Lists

Junior Chloe Jackson was named to the inaugural Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List in early November. The award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, will recognize the top shooting guard in NCAA women's basketball.

Add other potential honor to senior Raigyne Louis' resume. Louis was named to the inaugural Cheryl Miller Award Watch List during the preseason. Also presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, the award will recognize the top small forward in NCAA women's basketball. Louis is also LSU's nominee for the Senior CLASS Award.

Career Numbers For Louis

Raigyne Louis became the 32nd Lady Tiger to log 1,000 career points at #25 Texas A&M on Jan. 22, 2017. She joined the 1,000-Point club in her 85th career game in purple and gold. Two weeks later, she joined the LSU

500-Rebound club against Alabama on Feb. 5 in her 88th career game. Louis is the 29th Lady Tiger all-time to amass 500 rebounds, and the 19th player to have at least 1,000 points and 500 rebounds.

Louis currently totals 1,340 career points at LSU, which ranks 19th all-time. Her 601 rebounds rank her 15th in the record book, passing legend Joyce Walker in the Texas Tech game. She jumped to fifth place on the all-time steals list with 243.

Louis is only the sixth Lady Tiger in school history to register 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals.

She needs four assists to crack the top-15 on the LSU career assists list. Louis has dished out 272 assists. Seimone Augustus (2002-06) and Miriam Farr (1990-94) are tied for 15th with 276 assists.

Statistically Speaking ...

- LSU has forced its opponents to turn the ball over 20 or more times in four games this season, including a season high 30 by Southeastern Louisiana. The last three opponents have recorded 20 or more turnovers – Texas, Saint Louis and Texas Tech.

- The Lady Tigers have held the advantage on the boards in four games this season. The largest margin was +21 against Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 12.

- LSU has shot 45.0 percent or better from the field in three games with a season-high of 51.5 against Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 12. The Lady Tigers have shot at least 35.0 percent in every game this season.

- From the free throw line, LSU's best performance of the season was 70.8 percent against Saint Louis on Nov. 25 in Las Vegas. It is also the only game so far this season where both teams attempted at least 20 free throws in the game.

- The Lady Tigers' best performance of the season from long distance was on Nov. 10 against nationally-ranked USF - 37.5 percent.

- LSU has stolen the ball more times than their opponent in six of seven games this season.

Lady Tigers in Regular Season Tournaments

LSU is 46-14 in regular season tournaments since 1996, including Preseason WNIT games. LSU went 1-1 in the 2017 South Point Thanksgiving Shootout on Nov. 24-25 in Las Vegas. The Lady Tigers lost to nationally-ranked Texas, 75-66, then beat Saint Louis, 71-59.

Scoring Double Figures

For the first time in the 2017-18 season, four players scored double-figures in a single game. Against Nicholls on Nov. 21, Raigyne Louis led all scorers with 17 points, followed by Ayana Mitchell with 12 and Chloe Jackson and Faustine Aifuwa with 10 points each.

LSU is 13-6 in Season Openers on the Road

The season opener was the 19th time that the Lady Tigers opened their season on the road in the 43-year history of the program. LSU is 13-6 in road season-opening games. This was the third season in a row the Lady Tigers started the season on the road.

Preseason Polls

LSU was picked seventh in the SEC by league coaches, and by members of the media in the preseason. The Lady Tigers closed the 2016-17 campaign ranked seventh in the SEC with an 8-8 record.

Richard-Harris On SEC Leadership Council

Sophomore Jaelyn Richard-Harris is recognized not only as a leader for the Lady Tigers, but also for the SEC. She is a member of the SEC Women's Basketball Leadership Council, which provides student-athletes

Jailin Cherry, Raven Farley, Dekeriya Patterson and Khayla Pointer make up the No. 19 recruiting class signed by LSU last November.

Farley, a 6-4 forward from Elizabeth, N.J., is the highest-rated player in this signing class. She is tabbed as a five-star prospect by HoopGurlz, which also ranks her No. 19 overall in this class, and fifth nationally at her position. Farley will be the first New Jersey-native on a Lady Tiger Basketball roster. She played her junior season at Queen of Peace High School after transferring from The Patrick School. She averaged 15 points and 10 rebounds in 2015-16 after opening the season on the Naismith Trophy Girls Basketball Player of the Year Watch List. Farley was selected to the 2017 McDonald's All-American Game on Jan. 15.

A four-star prospect according to HoopGurlz, Pointer is a 5-7 guard from Marietta, Ga., and Fargas' niece. She signed with LSU out of Holy Innocents' Episcopal School. As a junior, she averaged 15.2 points, 6.0 rebounds, 6.1 assists and 7.1 steals.

Cherry, a 5-9 guard from Pascagoula, Miss., averaged 14 points and 19 rebounds a game last season as a junior at Pascagoula High School. She also averaged six assists and five steals per game in 2015-16.

Patterson, a 5-9 guard from Ft. Myers, Fla., prepped at Dunbar High School where she averaged 17.1 points, 2.6 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 2.3 steals per games as a junior for the Tigers. She has amassed 1,064 points, 177 steals and 207 assists heading into her senior season.

Nikki Fargas knows success and what it takes to be successful. In her seventh season at the helm of the Lady Tiger Basketball program in 2017-18, Fargas vows to place the Lady Tigers back into national prominence.

"We're going to do everything in our power to make sure that LSU Women's Basketball is back at that elite level, that we are competing for SEC championships, and that we are positioning ourselves to cut down nets," said Fargas.

Fargas has produced four 20-win seasons and an overall record of 113-83 in six seasons at LSU. Her 113 victories ranks her as the second-winningest Lady Tiger basketball coach in school history in terms of total wins, just behind legendary coach Sue Gunter. Over the six seasons, LSU has secured five NCAA Tournament appearances highlighted by back-to-back trips to the NCAA Sweet 16, and 19 victories over ranked opponents.

Fargas, who won national championships as both a player and an assistant coach at Tennessee and turned UCLA into a national power in just three years, has that combination of outstanding in-game coaching ability and tremendous recruiting competence. In addition, Fargas has been a leader off the court in the Baton Rouge community, helping the Lady Tigers connect with the city of Baton Rouge while donating their time and efforts to making a difference. She and her Lady

Tigers were heavily involved in assisting residents and local church communities following the devastating flood in August 2016 that impacted thousands of people in the area.

In the classroom, LSU has been a shining example of the definition of student-athlete. The Lady Tigers have recorded a perfect score of 100 in graduation success rate released by the NCAA during three seasons under Fargas. For players who have exhausted their eligibility at LSU, Fargas boasts a 100-percent graduation rate. Over the last five years, the Lady Tigers have earned 21 SEC Academic Honor Roll accolades.

Well respected in coaching circles, Fargas has twice been selected by the USA Women's Basketball Committee to serve as an assistant coach for USA National Teams. In the summer of 2012, she became the first coach in LSU history to serve on a USA U18 team staff since the squad's inception in 1988. That team claimed the gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship. In the summer of 2013, most of that group reunited to lead the USA U19 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA World Championships in Lithuania. Fargas is the only coach in LSU history to claim multiple USA gold medals during her tenure as Lady Tiger head coach.

Fargas has a championship and winning pedigree at every level of her career and owns an impressive

590-184 record as a player, graduate assistant, assistant coach and head coach dating back to her freshman season at Tennessee. She played, coached and studied under one of the game's greatest figures, the legendary Pat Summitt at Tennessee and she assisted Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Debbie Ryan at Virginia.

Widely recognized as one of the nation's top assistant coaches during stints at Tennessee and Virginia, Fargas took over at UCLA in 2008. In three years with the Bruins, she turned around a UCLA program that had won only one NCAA Tournament game in the nine years prior to her arrival. Fargas led the Bruins to a 72-26 (.735) overall mark, reached the NCAA Tournament twice and finished second in the Pac-10 Conference in both 2010 and 2011.

Off the court, Fargas is a passionate crusader for breast cancer awareness. She and Tennessee head coach Holly Warlick founded the non-profit organization, Champions for a Cause. Since 2007, they have raised over \$300,000 through Cruisin' for a Cause, a long-haul motorcycle adventure to raise dollars and awareness for a cure for breast cancer.

Fargas, was raised in Oak Ridge, Tenn., by her mother, Jean Caldwell. She and her husband Justin Fargas are the proud parents of a five-year-old daughter, Justice Simone Fargas.
