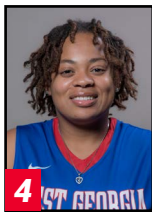

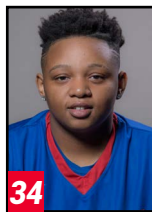

BY THE NUMBERS

4 West Georgia has won four straight Gulf South Conference games and will put that record up against a Union team that is 3-0 in GSC play.

39 The Wolves have outscored their opponents by 34 points in the fourth quarter. UWG has scored 198 fourth quarter points and allowed 164.

96 Head Coach Scott Groninger has 96 career wins at West Georgia and is closing in on 200 career wins overall with 181 in this his 15th season.

TEAM NOTES

- The Wolves finished the 2017 portion of the schedule with an 8-3 record after their final non-conference game last Saturday afternoon.
- UWG fell 67-62 to Point at home in their last time out, snapping a six-game win streak.
- Kayla Carter continues to lead West Georgia with 14.3 points per game. The senior led the Wolves' offense on Saturday with 16 points against the Skyhawks.
- Aysha Harris also scored in double-figures on the night, going for 13 against Point. The junior has 584 points in her UWG career.
- D'Asia Cain is the second leading rebounder on the team, with 6.1 per game, but since being put into the starting lineup, the senior has had at least seven rebounds in six of her last seven games.
- Senior forward De'Ashia Jones leads the Wolves on the glass with 6.9 rebounds per game.

A CLOSER LOOK: UNION

- It'll be the biggest game thus far for the Wolves when UWG heads to Jackson, Tenn. to take on a Union team who is also unbeaten in GSC play.
- The Bulldogs are 10-1 overall on the year and 3-0 in Gulf South Conference play and are loaded with talent.
- On paper, the Bulldogs have the clear advantage, scoring 86.5 points per game, and shooting the ball at a 51 percent clip from the field as a team, including 40.5 percent from the three-point line.
- Chelsey Shumpert leads the Bulldogs and the entire Gulf South Conference in scoring, putting up 24.5 points per contest.
- In total, four players average double figures for the Bulldogs, with a fifth player just shy of that marks scoring 9.4 points per game.

A CLOSER LOOK: CHRISTIAN BROTHERS

- On Thursday, the Wolves head to Memphis to take on Christian Brothers on the road.
- The Bucs are 2-7 on the year and 1-2 in Gulf South Conference play and host Auburn-Montgomery on Tuesday night at Canale Arena.
- CBU averages just 55.2 points per game

offensively and have been outscored 567-497 on the season

- Rafaella Angelidou is CBU's leading scorer, with a 12.0 points per game average.

INSIDE THE UNION SERIES

- It's the 13th meeting all-time between West Georgia and Union, with the Bulldogs leading 10-2 all-time.
- Both Scott Groninger and Mark Campbell have been the head coaches for their respective school for every previous meeting between the two teams.
- Union won the last meeting between the teams 63-45 on February 4, 2017.

INSIDE THE CHRISTIAN BROTHERS SERIES

- CBU leads the all-time series between the Wolves and Bucs by a slim 8-7 margin.
- Coach Groninger is 7-6 against his former team in his previous seven seasons at West Georgia.
- The last matchup was a 60-57 road win for West Georgia on February 2, 2017.

DEFENSIVE STANDOUTS

- The top two in steals in the Gulf South Conference will go head-to-head on Tuesday night as Aysha Harris leads the league with 3.0 steals per game and Chelsey Chumpert from Union is the second leading steal getter in the league with 10.6
- In steals per game, Harris ranks 16th in the nation with Shumpert in at 29th.

Head Coach Scott Groninger begins his eighth season at the helm of the UWG program this fall, looking for bigger and better success.

Groninger has put together an 88-108 record in seven seasons as the Wolves' head coach, with his best season coming in 2014-15, a 19-11 overall finish and a 13-9 mark in Gulf South Conference play. In 2016-17, Groninger matched his career best GSC record going 13-9 in league play. Groninger's Wolves reached the Gulf South Conference Tournament Semifinals two years straight in the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons, and returned to the semifinals a season ago.

In his previous seven seasons, Groninger has coached six All-Gulf South Conference selections, and landed two on the All-South Region Teams and two Honorable Mention All-America Selections. De'Ashia Jones is the most recent All-GSC honoree on Groninger's résumé, earning Second Team honors a season ago.

In 2015-16, Katrina Littlepage was named both All-Region and All-America while Taylor Beverly earned that honor in her one season in Carrollton in 2014-15.

Groninger is a graduate of William Jewell College, and earned a Master's Degree from Georgia Southern. His head coaching experience dates back to 2003 when he became the head coach at Chowan in North Carolina. Groninger was also an assistant coach at the University of Kentucky and at Chicago State.
