### #7 Minnesota State Heads to the Last Frontier for Four Western Collegiate Hockey Association Games; Mavericks vs. Alaska Anchorage Friday and Saturday

Mavericks Enter Weekend 14-6-0 Overall Record; Suess Extends Point-Scoring Streak to Six Games and Moves into Ninth Place on School's Career Points List

**Off the Hop:** #7 Minnesota State (14-6-0 overall, 12-4-0 WCHA) is on the road for a pair of Western Collegiate Hockey Association games this weekend with the University of Alaska Anchorage (1-13-4, 1-8-3 WCHA) on the docket this weekend in Anchorage. Face-off between the Mavericks and the Seawolves at Sullivan Arena (6,251) is slated for 10:07 p.m. CST both Friday and Saturday.

Minnesota State also plays at the University of Alaska in Fairbanks Jan. 12-13.

**About the Minnesota State-Alaska Anchorage Series:** Minnesota State owns a 47-25-9 all-time record against the Seawolves and have gone 6-1-1 in the last eight games vs. the Seawolves. The series between the two schools dates back to the 1982-83 season.

**Minnesota State Most Recently:** Rated #7 this week by both USCHO and USA Today/USA Hockey (and sixth in the pairwise rankings), Minnesota State stands 14-6-0 overall and stands atop the WCHA standings with an 12-4-0 record in league games after splitting a home league series with Northern Michigan last weekend (4-3 loss and 6-3 win). The Mavericks enter this weekend vs. the Seawolves having won five of its last six games.

**Alaska Anchorage Most Recently:** The Seawolves are 1-13-4 overall and 1-8-3 WCHA on the season. UAA lost a pair of WCHA road contests at Bemidji State in their most-recent outings (5-1 and 4-0 Dec. 15-16 in Bemidji). The Seawolves are led by **Matt Thomas** (RIT '98), who is in his fifth season behind the UAA bench. Thomas owns a 45-92-21 mark as head coach of UAA.

**Minnesota State All-Time:** The Minnesota State men's hockey program, begun in 1969-70, completed its 48th year of competition last year. The Mavericks are in their 22nd year as members of NCAA Division I and in their 19th season as members of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association. The Mavericks sport an all-time record of 872-641-153. (.569).

**C.J. Suess Notes:** Three-year letterwinner is in his second season as team captain. *2016-17 All-WCHA Second Team* selection...Tied for second on team in scoring and fourth in goals with 12-19--31 as a junior...Led Mavericks with seven power play goals and ranked second on team with four game-winners...Suess, who had a four points on two goals and two assists vs. Northern Michigan last weekend, enters the series vs. UAA riding a six-game point scoring streak (6-4--10). Suess leads Minnesota State in scoring with 10-16--26 and stands as Minnesota State's active career scoring leader with 110 points on 45 goals and 65 assists. Suess's 110 points rank ninth on the school's career scoring list for the DI-era. Suess, who has seen action in 137 career games, has played in 108 consecutive games.

**Zeb Knutson Notes:** Three-year letterwinner (2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17) finished fifth on school's point-scoring charts in 2016-17 with 15 goals and 10 assists for 25 points...Posted career highs for goals and points in a season...Led Mavericks in goals (15) and game-winning goals (5)... Named the WCHA Offensive Player of the Week after racking up five points on two goals and three assists in the two wins over Michigan Tech (Oct. 27-28)...Named WCHA Offensive Player of the Week after accumulating 2-3--5 in MSU's road sweep at Lake State (Dec. 8-9)...who has a career-high 15 assists this year, ranks second on the team with 23 points. The Sioux Falls, S.D., native has 31-37--67 in 107 career games

**Minnesota State Head Coach Mike Hastings**

Named the head coach in April of 2012, Mike Hastings has enjoyed immense success behind the bench of the Minnesota State men's hockey program in his five seasons with the Mavericks.

Under his guidance, the Mavericks have won at least 21 games every year, forged a 122-62-18 record, won a pair of MacNaughton Cups as WCHA regular-season champions, two Broadmoor Trophies as WCHA post-season tournament champions and made three NCAA postseason tournament appearances.

In his first year as head coach of the Mavericks in 2012-13, Hastings was named WCHA Coach of the Year after leading MSU to a 24-14-3 mark. The Crookston, Minn., native guided the Mavericks to their second NCAA postseason tournament appearance. MSU claimed wins over #2 Minnesota, #4 North Dakota and #15 Wisconsin during the course of the season and Hastings was named national coach of the year by College Hockey News and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award as the AHCA National Coach of the Year.

In his second season in charge, 2013-14, the Mavericks continued its ascent with the program racking up a 26-14-1 mark. Minnesota State captured its first ever Broadmoor Trophy as the WCHA Final Five champions (league postseason tournament) and made its third NCAA postseason tournament appearance.

The ascendancy continued in 2014-15 with a third consecutive trip to the NCAA postseason, while establishing a school record for wins with a 29-8-3 record. Rated #1 in the country five times during the course of the season, the Mavericks won their second straight Broadmoor, while a 21-4-3 league mark gave the school its first MacNaughton Cup as conference regular-season champs. Hastings was named WCHA Coach of the Year and the recipient of the Spencer Penrose Award as the AHCA National Coach of the Year.

Year Four of the Hastings regime concluded with a share of the MacNaughton Cup as league regular-season champions en route a fourth consecutive 20-win campaign (21-13-7). The Mavericks won a first-round play-off series for the fourth straight year in advancing to the Final Five championship game for the third straight year. The Mavericks won at least 20 games in a season for the fifth straight year in 2016-17 when the Mavericks finished third in the league standings, won a first-round play-off series to advance to the WCHA semi-finals and finished the season with a 22-13-4 overall mark.

The fourth coach in the history of the Maverick men's hockey program, Hastings arrived at Minnesota State following a three-year stint as the associate head coach at Nebraska-Omaha. He also served as an assistant coach with the men's hockey program at the University of Minnesota for one season and before that had a 14-year run as head coach of Omaha of the United States Hockey League. He left the USHL as the league's all-time winningest coach, compiling a 529-210-56 record with the Lancers, never had a losing season and led Omaha to three Clark Cup titles as the USHL's play-off champions. He was named USHL Coach of the Year three times and as the team's general manager, earned league GM of the Year honors five times.

Hastings was an assistant coach for the U.S. national junior team at the 2003 and 2005 International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championships and served twice as head coach for the U.S. junior select team that competed in the Viking Cup, earning gold medal honors in 2000.

A 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State where Hastings played two years for the Huskies (1986-87 and 1987-88).
