KNOW THE FOE: GNAC Tournament champion **Montana State Billings** is making its second NCAA West Region title-game appearance in the last five seasons, having dropped the 2014 final to host Cal Poly Pomona in its deepest ever NCAA Tournament run ... the Yellowjackets feature the dynamic senior duo of GNAC player-of-the-year and tourney MVP Alisha Breen (21.4 ppg, 9.1 rpg, 2.4 apg, .424 FG, .358 3FG, .869 FT) and point guard Rylee Kane (14.1 ppg, 3.5 rpg, 4.9 apg, 1.8 spg, .472 FG, .556 FT).

Notes: UAA has won 11 of the last 12 and 21 of 23 since MSUB joined the GNAC in 2007-08 ... teams' only neutral-court or post-season meeting was a 77-57 UAA victory in the 2016 GNAC Tournament title game in Lacey, Wash. ... UAA has won the last nine by double figures ... MSUB's last win came 75-72 in Billings, Mar. 1, 2014 ... MSUB is UAA's 3rd-most common opponent (behind Alaska Fairbanks and Seattle Pacific), despite the teams splitting into different leagues from 2002-07 ... teams played twice yearly from 1984-85 to 2000-01 as members of the Pacific West and Continental Divide conferences.

SEAWOLF NCAA HISTORY: The Seawolves are making their 17th overall NCAA Tournament trip ('86, '88, '89, '92, '94, '00, '07, '08, '09, '10, '11, '12, '14, '15, '16, '17, '18) and now stand 24-16 all-time in NCAA games after their wins over Northwest Nazarene and Humboldt State ... UAA is 18-6 in West Region play since 2007, suffering four of those losses to No. 1 seeds (and eventual regional champions) on their home courts (Cal Poly Pomona, '11 & '14; Seattle Pacific, '10; UCSD, '07) ... the Seawolves have won four regional titles (2008, 2009, 2012, 2016) ... UAA made its first appearance in the NCAA Div. II national title game in 2016 after bowing out in the national semifinals in 2008 and 2009 ... UAA improved to 11-6 in NCAA openers and earned its third straight first-round win Friday ... the Seawolves improved 6-8 all-time in the Round of 32 with the win over Humboldt State ... UAA is 4-1 in the Sweet 16 (regional finals).



HOW WE GOT HERE: The Seawolves went down to the final 30 seconds in its first two NCAA West Regional Championships games to 'survive and advance,' earning a 65-63 win over 4th-seeded Northwest Nazarene and an 81-73 win over 8th-seeded Humboldt State at the Felix Event Center ... on Friday, Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** had 21 points (7-10 FG, 7-7 FT) and 9 rebounds, and So. PG **Yazmeen Goo** scored 13 points (4-7 FG), including the game-winning layup with 1.7 seconds left ... the nationally 13th-ranked Seawolves also got 12 points and 5 assists from Jr. G **Kian McNair**, who also aided a defensive effort that held NNU first-team all-league guard Lexi Tubbs to

6 points on 1-of-11 shooting ... on Saturday, Wandersee led four Seawolves in double figures with 15 points and UAA shot season bests of .583 FG (28-48) and .857 FT (18-21) to outlast the CCAA Tournament-champion Lumberjacks ... Goo had 13 points (3-3 FG, 7-7 FT), while Jr. G **Sydni Stallworth** and Fr. F **Sala Langi** tallied 10 points apiece on combined 7-8 FG shooting ... the game featured eight ties, 12 lead changes and no double-digit leads ... Sr. G **Kaitlyn Hurley** delivered 8 points (3-5 FG) and four different Seawolves grabbed exactly four rebounds to aid a 33-23 advantage on the boards.

THIS YEAR VS. MSUB: The Seawolves pulled away in the second half of both meetings to earn their fourth straight regular-season sweep of the Yellowjackets, earning an 81-60 win Jan. 6 in Billings and a 73-63 victory Feb. 1 in Anchorage ... in the first game, UAA used its depth to outscore host MSUB 40-18 over the last 14 minutes, powered by 19 points (6-10 FG, 3-5 3FG, 4-4 FT) from Sr. F **Shelby Cloninger** and 18 points on school-record-tying 6-of-6 3FG shooting from Jr. G **Tara Thompson** ... Sr. G **Rodericka Ware** delivered 13 points (5-7 FG, 2-4 3FG) and 6 assists off the bench as UAA shot .551 percent from the field and a season-best .524 (11-21) from long range ... in Anchorage, Cloninger had 21 points – including the clinching jumper with 1:06 remaining – and 10 rebounds, while Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** had 14 points and 8 rebounds ... Fr. G **Sala Langi** tallied 9 points (4-6 FG) and 4 rebounds, and Jr. G **Kian McNair** delivered 6 points, a career-high 7 rebounds, 5 assists, no turnovers and 4 steals as UAA out-rebounded the visitors 46-31.

WINNING WAYS: UAA joined Seattle Pacific this year as the only programs to win at least a share of four straight GNAC regular-season titles ... the Seawolves have won five of the eight GNAC Tournament titles since the event started in 2011 ... the Seawolves have won at least 25 games for the program-record fourth straight season and at least 20 games for the 14th time overall ... UAA is a combined 79-6 – including 36-3 on the road – in GNAC regular-season and tournament games over the last four seasons ... at 124-11 (.919), the Seawolves have the second-most victories and second-best winning percentage in NCAA Div. II since 2014-15, trailing only defending champion Ashland (126-11, .920) ... the Seawolves have clinched the program's 12th consecutive winning season and earned their 11th NCAA Tournament berth in 12 years ... the loss at SPU on Jan. 20 snapped GNAC regular-season win streaks of 33 overall (including GNAC Tourney), 29 overall (not including GNAC Tourney) and 23 straight on the road ... UAA has won 20 consecutive GNAC regular-season home contests, posting perfect 10-0 marks the last two seasons ... UAA has gone a combined 168-15 (.918) in the last 11 seasons on its home courts ... the loss to Sonoma State snapped a 41-game winning streak against Div. II non-conference opponents in the regular season, marking the first such setback since Ryan McCarthy's Seawolf coaching debut, Nov. 9, 2012, against Colorado Mines.

MORE NIFTY NUMBERS: Heading into the NCAA Tournament, the Seawolves held nine top-50 national stats ranks, including six top-25 marks – 5th in assists per game (19.2), 5th in steals per game (14.2), 10th in turnover margin (+6.9), 11th in turnovers forced per game (22.7), 18th in assist/turnover ratio (1.21) and 23rd in scoring offense (76.9) ... this year will end a streak of four years that UAA led NCAA Div. II in steals per game ... in the GNAC stats, UAA leads in five categories and ranks No. 2 in five others.

WANDERSEE WONDERFUL: A reserve in 66 of 71 career games before this year, Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** entered the starting 5 and delivered in a big way, earning unanimous **First Team All-GNAC** honors ... Wandersee leads the GNAC and ranks 44th nationally with 1.5 blocks per game, plus other league ranks of 4th in scoring (14.7 ppg), 2nd in FG% (.529), 8th in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and 12th in FT% (.782) ... she collected GNAC co-Player of the Week for her efforts against Hawaii Pacific and Cal State LA, earned the Seawolf Hoops Classic Most Outstanding Player award the following week, and made the GCI Great Alaska Shootout All-Tourna-

ment Team – in November alone ... the Kodiak product had her first career double-double against a Div. II opponent with 24 points and 11 rebounds against Hawaii Pacific, grabbed her second (16 pts/career-high 13 rebs) in the win at Saint Martin's, and just missed a third with 9 rebounds and a career-high 32 points in the 86-78 win at Western Oregon ... including a 21-point effort in Friday's win over Northwest Nazarene, she now has seven career 20-plus games ...

with more than a year to play, Wandersee already owns UAA career top-10 marks in FT% (5th, .806), (FG%, 6th, .524), blocks (6th, 86), blocks per game (7th, 0.85) and victories (9th, 94).

SURE-SHOT SHELBY: Sr. F **Shelby Cloninger** captured **Second Team All-GNAC** honors last week as UAA's second-leading scorer (12.3 ppg) and rebounder (6.2 rpg) ... with 19 double-figure scoring efforts in her 28 appearances – including successive career highs of 19 points against Div. I Maryland Eastern Shore, 22 at UAF and 26 at Simon Fraser – she holds GNAC ranks of 14th in scoring, 11th in rebounding, 3rd in FT% (.873), 13th in FG% (.467), 4th in 3FG% (.391) and 15th in 3FGs per game (1.5) ... the Kamiah, Idaho, native also has 13 games with at least 7 rebounds this year, including 10 against MSU Billings and Western State, nine at Simon Fraser and at Seattle Pacific, and a career-high 12 at Western Washington ... in late November, Cloninger claimed **GCI Great Alaska Shootout Most Outstanding Player** and GNAC Player of the Week honors after leading the Seawolves to the final tournament title, and she picked up the GNAC weekly award for Jan. 29-Feb. 4 for her effort in home wins over UAF and MSUB ... a transfer from North Idaho College after playing at Div. I Utah State, Cloninger holds UAA career ranks of 3rd in FT% (.821), 11th in 3FGs per game (1.3), 12th in 3FG% (.358) and 17th in 3FGs made (78).

FEELIN' GOO: In her first year as a starter after playing understudy to GNAC all-time steals and assists leader Kiki Robertson, So. TRANSFER TRAIN'S A-CHUGGIN': UAA's three active transfers – Sr. G **Rodericka Ware** (Academy of Art), Jr. G **Kian McNair** (Portland State) and Jr. G **Sydni Stallworth** (2-time 1st Team NJCAA All-American at Pima CC) – have all made significant impacts ... Ware began her career at Central Arizona College before earning First Team All-Pacific West Conference honors last year with Art U, posting 17.4 ppg, 4.0 apg and a league-leading 2.8 3FGs made per game ... the Lakewood, Wash., native has scored double figures in 11 of 27 games as a Seawolf and dished at least four assists in 12 contests, including 19 points, 5 assists and 5 steals against Holy Names, and 13 points and 6 assists at MSU Billings ... UAA's 4th-leading scorer (8.4 ppg), Ware currently holds GNAC ranks of 5th in steals (1.9 spg), 12th in assists (2.7 apg), 13th in 3FGs per game (1.6) and 17th in 3FG% (.346) ...
