### CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Miami (Fla.) defeated Clemson twice in three games at Doug Kingsmore Stadium last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.9 runs per game and hitting .245 with a .367 on-base percentage and 24 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.34 ERA, .242 opponents' batting average and 2.25 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .975.

### GEORGIA OVERVIEW

- Georgia is led by fifth-year head coach Scott Stricklin.
- The Bulldogs won one of three games against Kentucky last weekend. They are hitting .282 and have a 3.57 ERA and .978 fielding percentage.
- Keegan McGovern is hitting .344 with 12 homers, while Michael Curry is batting .317 with seven homers.

### QUICK HITS

- No. 10 Georgia rallied from a 3-0 deficit to defeat No. 3 Clemson 6-3 at SRP Park in North Augusta, S.C., on April 10.
- Clemson is 16-for-50 (.320) with three grand slams, three doubles and 46 RBIs with the bases loaded.
- The Tiger bullpen has a 2.90 ERA and .241 opponents' batting average.

### ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,161 fans per home date (21), the fifth-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of April 15).
- The Clemson record for average home attendance is 4,810 fans per date in 2007.
- Entering 2018, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 24 straight seasons and a top-15 figure 16 years in a row.

### POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 12 by Perfect Game in the polls this week.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top 25 by at least one poll for 36 straight weeks dating to 2016.

### ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson (11-7) is in second place behind NC State (13-5) in the ACC Atlantic Division standings.
- Overall in the ACC, Clemson is fourth behind NC State (13-5), Duke (12-5) and North Carolina (12-6).

### SENIOR LEADERS

- Clemson has relied on four seniors in the heart of the lineup to achieve its 26-10 record this season.
- Patrick Cromwell, Robert Jolly, Drew Wharton and Chris Williams have been in the middle of the lineup for most of the season.
- They have combined to hit .250 with 24 doubles, a triple, 19 homers and 102 RBIs.

• Cromwell is batting .264, Williams is hitting .257, Jolly is batting .250 and Wharton is hitting .227.

### PRO INFLUENCE

- Clemson has several current and former players on its roster who have MLB ties.
- Both Tiger student assistant coaches, Mark Davidson and Ben Paulsen, were former Tigers who went on to play in the majors.
- Davidson, father of Tiger shortstop Logan Davidson, played at Clemson in 1982 and played six MLB years (1986-91) with the Twins and Astros.
- Paulsen, Clemson's first-base coach, played at Clemson from 2007-09 and played three years (2014-16) with the Rockies.
- Grayson Byrd is the son of righthander Paul Byrd, who played 14 years with the Mets, Braves, Phillies, Royals, Angels, Indians and Red Sox.
- Carson Spiers is the nephew of former Tiger infielder Bill Spiers, who played 13 MLB seasons and is currently a Tiger football staff member.
- Bo Majkowski is the son of Don Majkowski, who played 10 years as a quarterback in the NFL with the Packers, Colts and Lions.

### BEER HAS 44 CAREER HOME RUNS

- Junior Seth Beer had 18 homers in 2016, 16 home runs in 2017 and has a team-high 10 homers in 2018, meaning he has 44 career homers.
- His 44 career home runs are ninth most in Clemson history.
- He was one of 40 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .288 with 10 homers, six doubles, 25 RBIs, 32 runs, a .442 on-base percentage and a steal in 36 games in 2018.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 34 of the 36 games in 2018.
- He hit one homer in each game of the Georgia Tech series on March 9, 10 and did the same in the Boston College series from March 29-31.
- In late March, he hit a home run in four straight games, the first Tiger to do that since Kris Harvey in 2005.
- He was named national player-of-the-week by Perfect Game and ACC Player-of-the-Week on April 2, as he had four homers and 12 RBIs.
- He was named national player-of-the-month (March) by NCBWA after hitting .294 with eight homers, a double, 20 RBIs and 19 runs in 20 games.
- In his career, he is hitting .322 with 36 doubles, a triple, 44 homers, 148 RBIs, 140 runs and a .492 on-base percentage in 161 games.
- He has 156 career walks, fifth most in Tiger history, and his one walk every 3.50 at-bats is first in Tiger history.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 154 of his last 159 games with a plate appearance.
- He has reached via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 98 of his 100 career games with a plate appearance against ACC (81) and SEC (17) teams.

### BYRD TIES TIGER HOME RUN RECORD

- Junior infielder Grayson Byrd had one career home run, which came in 2017, entering the game against Charleston Southern on March 13.
- He hit three homers in his first three plate appearances and totaled a career-high five RBIs in Clemson's 5-0 win over the Buccaneers.
- He tied the school record for homers in a game and became the 14th Tiger with three and first since 2010 (John Hinson vs. USC Upstate).
- He hit a solo homer to left in the second inning, a three-run homer to right field in the fourth and a solo homer to center in the seventh.

- The son of former major league pitcher Paul Byrd is hitting .273 with five homers, 14 RBIs and two steals in 24 games (21 starts) in 2018.
- In his two seasons as a Tiger, he is hitting .281 with six homers, 34 RBIs, 36 runs and five steals in 81 games (75 starts).

### CRAWFORD FINDING HOME ON WEEKEND

- Junior righty Brooks Crawford was a long reliever most of his first two seasons at Clemson, but he has become the Saturday starter in 2018.
- He is 3-2 with a 3.48 ERA, .258 opponents' batting average and 24 strikeouts against 12 walks in 41.1 innings pitched over nine starts.
- Clemson has a 7-2 record in his nine starts in 2018.
- He is holding opponents to a .172 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- In his career, he is 10-2 with one save, a 3.11 ERA and 72 strikeouts in 110.0 innings pitched over 52 appearances (11 starts).

### CROMWELL GETTING ON BASE

- Senior Patrick Cromwell has emerged as one of Clemson's top offensive threats in 2018.
- He is hitting .264 with four homers, five doubles, 17 RBIs, 26 runs, a .388 on-base percentage and a steal in 36 games (33 starts).
- He has a .956 fielding percentage, committing only five errors in 113 chances, and has made many highlight-reel plays at third base.
- He hit the game-tying, solo homer in the ninth inning against Winthrop on Feb. 27, a game the Tigers went on to win.
- He went 3-for-5 with two two-run homers against Miami (Fla.) on April 13.
- In his career, he is hitting .242 with five doubles, six homers, 22 RBIs and a .362 on-base percentage in 69 games (54 starts).

### GILLIAM CLOSING THE DEAL

- Junior righthander Ryley Gilliam has been the team's closer each of the last two seasons and has a team-high five saves in 2018.
- He is 2-1 with a 1.15 ERA, .167 opponents' batting average and 24 strikeouts against 11 walks in 15.2 innings pitched over 13 outings.
- In his five ACC regular-season outings, he has three saves and has allowed two hits and no runs with 11 strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 8-4 with nine saves, a 3.64 ERA and 90 strikeouts in 81.2 innings pitched over 55 appearances (six starts).

### GREENE PROVIDING SPARK

- Junior infielder Jordan Greene has come on to become the starter at second base and has provided a spark in the lineup.
- He is hitting .278 with a double, four homers, 11 RBIs, 16 runs, a .412 on-base percentage and three steals in 23 games in 2018.
- In ACC games, he is hitting .306 with a .469 on-base percentage and three steals in 13 games (11 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .258 with 14 doubles, five homers, 36 RBIs, 59 runs and 11 steals in 120 games (94 starts).

### HENNESSY LEADING ROTATION

- Sophomore lefthander Jacob Hennessy was a reliever as a freshman in 2017, but has become the Friday starter in 2018.
- He is 3-2 with a 2.70 ERA, .222 opponents' batting average and 42 strikeouts against 13 walks in 53.1 innings pitched over nine starts.

# NOTES

- He is holding opponents to a .150 batting average with two outs.
- In the first four innings in 2018, he has allowed 29 hits, nine earned runs and nine walks with 30 strikeouts in 36.0 innings pitched.
- He earned the win against Boston College by allowing just one hit and no earned runs in 6.0 innings pitched on March 29.
- In his career, he is 5-3 with a 3.11 ERA and 79 strikeouts against 24 walks in 84.0 innings pitched over 35 appearances (nine starts).

## HIGGINBOTHAM BACK ON THE MOUND

- Sophomore lefthander Jake Higginbotham was a mid-week starter as a freshman in 2016, but suffered an arm injury and missed all of 2017.
- He is 5-1 with a 3.80 ERA, .230 opponents' batting average and 37 strikeouts against 14 walks in 47.1 innings pitched over nine starts.
- He returned to action against William & Mary on Feb. 18 and earned the win in 5.1 innings pitched, allowing just one run on two hits.
- He earned the win against No. 10 Dallas Baptist by allowing just five hits and no earned runs with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 8-1 with a 4.13 ERA and 65 strikeouts against 35 walks in 80.2 innings pitched over 17 appearances (16 starts).

## JOLLY HAPPY AS A SENIOR

- Robert Jolly is enjoying one of his best seasons as a senior in 2018. After being a catcher from 2015-17, he has moved to the outfield.
- He is hitting .250 with six doubles, a homer, 16 RBIs, 16 runs, 20 walks and a .366 on-base percentage in 34 games (33 starts).
- He is hitting .325 with runners on base and .350 with runners in scoring position.
- In his career, he is hitting .266 with 21 doubles, two homers, 51 RBIs, a .369 on-base percentage and three steals in 150 games (91 starts).

## MARR HAVING STRONG FRESHMAN YEAR

- Redshirt freshman righthander Travis Marr has been one of the team's top long relievers in his second season in the program in 2018.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.81 ERA, .267 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts in 32.0 innings pitched over 13 appearances (one start).
- In his last 10 appearances, he is 3-0 and has allowed just 19 hits and four runs (1.52 ERA) with 18 strikeouts in 23.2 innings pitched.
- He is holding opponents to 0-for-9 with four strikeouts against no walks with the bases loaded.
- He has allowed just 12 hits and two runs (0.98 ERA) in 18.1 innings pitched after the fifth inning.
- In his career, he is 3-0 with a 2.73 ERA and 27 strikeouts against 11 walks in 33.0 innings pitched over 14 appearances (one start).

## MEREDITH ADDING SPEED TO LINEUP

- Freshman outfielder Kier Meredith made his Clemson debut at Notre Dame on April 7 after missing the first half of the season due to injury.
- He made an instant impact in the Notre Dame series, going 4-for-10 with a homer, triple, .571 on-base percentage and three steals.
- He is hitting .263 with a triple, homer, two RBIs, two runs, a .440 on-base percentage and four steals in five games in 2018.

## MILLER FILLING KEY RELIEF ROLE

- Senior righthander Ryan Miller has been one of Clemson's top relievers in 2018 and has filled an important role.
- He is 2-1 with three saves, a 3.24 ERA, .246 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts in 33.1 innings pitched over 13 relief outings.
- He is holding opponents to a .175 batting average with two outs.
- He has 42 groundball outs compared to 24 flyball outs.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief to record the save in Clemson's win over No. 23 South Carolina at Greenville, S.C., on March 3.
- In his career, he is 3-1 with four saves, a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeouts against nine walks in 45.0 innings pitched over 24 relief outings.

## SPIERS MAKING THE JUMP

- Sophomore righthander Carson Spiers saw limited action as a freshman, but he has made a big jump as one of the team's top relievers in 2018.
- He has made a team-high 15 appearances, all out of the bullpen, and has three saves.
- He is 1-2 with a 3.04 ERA, .189 opponents' batting average and 22 strikeouts against eight walks in 20.2 innings pitched.
- He is holding opponents to a .114 batting average with runners on base.
- He has allowed only two of his 18 inherited baserunners to score in 2018.
- In his career, he is 1-2 with a 3.04 ERA and 25 strikeouts against eight walks in 23.2 innings pitched over 18 relief appearances.
- His cousin, Will Spiers, is the starting punter on the Tiger football team.
- His father, Michael Spiers, hit .301 with 16 homers, 110 RBIs and 32 steals in 184 games as a Tiger from 1988-91.
- His uncle, Bill Spiers, hit .325 with 17 homers, 119 RBIs and 60 steals in 173 games as a Tiger from 1985-87, then played 13 MLB seasons.
- His grandfather, Bud Spiers, hit .254 with seven homers and 44 RBIs as a Tiger from 1956-58.

## WHARTON EMERGING IN FINAL SEASON

- Senior Drew Wharton entered the season with a career .220 batting average, no homers and 20 RBIs in 74 games (22 starts) over three years.
- With the departure of two outfielders from last year's team, he has made the most of his chance to contribute in 2018.
- He is hitting .227 with seven doubles, a triple, five homers, 29 RBIs and a .305 on-base percentage in 36 games (35 starts) in 2018.
- He hit three long balls, the first three of his career, in the series against No. 10 Dallas Baptist in February.
- He hit a walkoff triple in Clemson's 8-7 win over No. 23 South Carolina on March 4.
- In his career, he is hitting .224 with 10 doubles, a triple, five homers, 49 RBIs, 23 runs and five steals in 110 games (57 starts).

## WILLIAMS POWERING TIGERS

- Chris Williams was drafted in the 31st round in 2017, but chose to return for his senior season.
- He is one of the team's best power hitters and has seen most of his action at first base in 2018, but has also played at catcher.
- He was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List in March.
- He is hitting .257 with six doubles, nine homers, 40 RBIs, 30 runs, a .354 on-base percentage and a steal in 36 games in 2018.
