CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson defeated Kennesaw State on the road 7-2 on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.2 runs per game and hitting .256 with a .374 on-base percentage and 47 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.41 ERA, .233 opponents' batting average and 2.28 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .974.

PITTSBURGH OVERVIEW

- Pittsburgh is led by 21st-year head coach Joe Jordano.
- The Panthers were swept at home by Louisville last weekend. They are hitting .240 and have a 4.27 ERA and .976 fielding percentage.
- Liam Sabino is hitting .299 with 15 homers, 16 doubles, 43 RBIs and 18 steals, while Frank Maldonado is batting .295 with five homers.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson's eight-game winning streak in ACC regular-season road games is its longest since winning 10 in a row from 1994 (1) to 1995 (9).
- Clemson's 40 regular-season wins are its most since the 2006 team totaled 43 regular-season victories.
- Clemson finished its non-conference schedule with a 21-5 record in 2018. The Tigers were 22-4 in both 2016 and 2017 in non-conference games.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,031 fans per home date (30), the seventh-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of May 15).
- The Clemson record for average home attendance is 4,810 fans per date in 2007.
- Entering 2018, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 24 straight seasons and a top-15 figure 16 years in a row.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation by Collegiate Baseball this week.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top 25 by at least one poll for 40 straight weeks dating to 2016.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson (19-8) is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings, one game ahead of second-place NC State (18-9).

• Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for first place with North Carolina (19-8).

WINNING SEASONS THE NORM

- The Tigers have had a winning record every year since 1965.
- With its 40-13 record in 2018, Clemson is guaranteed of having a winning record for the 54th season in a row.
- Clemson's 54-year streak is the third-longest active streak in the nation, trailing two ACC schools (Florida State 71, Miami (Fla.) 60).
- Clemson has had a non-losing record, which includes seasons with equal number of wins and losses, every season since 1958.
- Bill Wilhelm took over as head coach of the Clemson program in 1958, therefore the Tigers have not had a losing record since he took over.
- Clemson's 61-year streak of non-losing records is tied for the second-longest active streak in the nation, trailing only Florida State (71).

ONE-RUN SUCCESS

- Clemson has a 14-4 record in one-run games, tying the school record of 14 one-run wins in 2016 (14-6 record).
- Clemson has played 22 games decided by one or two runs and is 18-4 in those games.
- The Tigers swept William & Mary in three one-run games to start the season, then swept Virginia on the road in three one-run games in April.
- Clemson's two series sweeps with three one-run wins were the first two times in school history that happened.
- Clemson has five walkoff hits, including walkoff home runs by Jordan Greene (Florida State, May 7) and Grayson Byrd (Austin Peay, May 13).
- The Tigers are 37-14 (.725) in one-run games in Monte Lee's three seasons as head coach at Clemson.

TIGERS AMONG LEADERS IN HOME RUNS

- Clemson has 79 home runs in 53 games, good for 1.5 per game, in 2018.
- The Tigers are second in the nation in home runs (through games of May 15) and only trail Tennessee Tech (113).
- Clemson is 22-3 when it hits at least two home runs in 2018.
- Clemson's 79 home runs are the most in the head coach Monte Lee era (2016-18), besting the 2016 total (75), and the most since 2010 (93).
- Seth Beer (16), Chris Williams (14), Logan Davidson (11), Grayson Byrd (9) and Drew Wharton (6) lead the team in long balls.

BULLPEN STRONG

- Tiger relievers have combined for a 20-5 record, 20 saves, a 2.69 ERA and .212 opponents' batting average in 234.0 innings pitched in 2018.
- The bullpen also has 242 strikeouts against 113 walks.
- The 20 saves are third most in Tiger history and the most since totaling a school-record 26 saves in 2002.

TIGERS FIELDING AT RECORD RATE

- Clemson has committed only 52 errors in 53 games, good for a .974 fielding percentage.
- The Tiger record for fielding percentage in a season is .973, set in 2012.
- Clemson has been errorless in 23 games and has had one error in 15 games, meaning it has committed less than two errors in 38 of the 53 games.
- The Tigers are 31-7 when committing less than two errors and 9-6 when committing two or more errors.
- No Tiger infielder has committed more than seven errors in 2018.
- Clemson infielders have combined to commit only 25 errors, including only two by first basemen.
- Shortstop Logan Davidson has committed only seven errors and has a .970 fielding percentage.

SENIOR LEADERS

- Clemson has relied in large part on four seniors in the heart of the lineup to achieve its 40-13 record this season.
- Patrick Cromwell, Robert Jolly, Drew Wharton and Chris Williams have been in the middle of the lineup for most of the season.
- They have combined to total 31 doubles, a triple, 26 homers and 125 RBIs.

TIGERS RECOGNIZED FOR APR SCORE

- Baseball was one of seven Tiger programs in the top-10 percent of their sport in the eligibility, graduation and retention metric.
- It was the second year in a row the Clemson baseball program was lauded by the NCAA for its APR.
- Clemson was one of only three ACC institutions (Notre Dame, Virginia Tech) to earn recognition for baseball.

GRADUATES

- Five Tiger players and two student assistants received their degrees during commencement ceremonies in Littlejohn Coliseum on May 10, 11.
- Outfielders Robert Jolly and Drew Wharton and infielder Adam Renwick graduated with a degree in parks, recreation & tourism management.
- Infielder Patrick Cromwell graduated with a degree in communication.
- Lefthander Alex Schnell graduated with a degree in construction science & management.
- Student assistant coaches Mark Davidson (history) and Ben Paulsen (business management) graduated as well.

PRO INFLUENCE

- Clemson has several current and former players on its roster who have MLB ties.
- Both Tiger student assistant coaches, Mark Davidson and Ben Paulsen, were former Tigers who went on to play in the majors.
- Davidson, father of Tiger shortstop Logan Davidson, played at Clemson in 1982 and played six MLB years (1986-91) with the Twins and Astros.
- Paulsen, Clemson's first-base coach, played at Clemson from 2007-09 and played three years (2014-16) with the Rockies.
- Grayson Byrd is the son of righthander Paul Byrd, who played 14 years with the Mets, Braves, Phillies, Royals, Angels, Indians and Red Sox.
- Carson Spiers is the nephew of former Tiger infielder Bill Spiers, who played 13 MLB seasons and is currently a Tiger football staff member.
- Bo Majkowski is the son of Don Majkowski, who played 10 years as a quarterback in the NFL with the Packers, Colts and Lions.

NOTES

BEER HAS 50 CAREER HOME RUNS

- Junior Seth Beer had 18 homers in 2016, 16 home runs in 2017 and has 16 homers in 2018, meaning he has 50 career homers.
- His 50 career homers are eighth in Clemson history and one behind the seventh-place Tiger (Eric Macrina).
- He was one of 40 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .286 with 16 homers, seven doubles, 41 RBIs, 49 runs, a .439 on-base percentage and a steal in 53 games in 2018.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 49 of the 53 games in 2018.
- He reached base via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 23 straight games from March to April.
- He hit one homer in each game of the Georgia Tech series on March 9,10 and did the same in the Boston College series from March 29-31.
- In late March, he hit a home run in four straight games, the first Tiger to do that since Kris Harvey in 2005, then did it again in May.
- He was named national player-of-the-week by Perfect Game and ACC Player-of-the-Week on April 2, as he had four homers and 12 RBIs.
- He was named national player-of-the-month (March) by NCBWA after hitting .294 with eight homers, a double, 20 RBIs and 19 runs in 20 games.
- In his career, he is hitting .318 with 37 doubles, a triple, 50 homers, 164 RBIs, 157 runs and a .486 on-base percentage in 178 games.
- He has 169 career walks, tied for most in Clemson history, and his one walk every 3.61 at-bats is first in Tiger history.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 170 of his last 176 games with a plate appearance.
- He has reached via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 107 of his 110 career games with a plate appearance against ACC (89) and SEC (18) teams.

BYRD TIES TIGER HOME RUN RECORD

- Junior infielder Grayson Byrd had one career home run, which came in 2017, entering the game against Charleston Southern on March 13.
- He hit three homers in his first three plate appearances and totaled a career-high five RBIs in Clemson's 5-0 win over the Buccaneers.
- He tied the school record for homers in a game and became the 14th Tiger with three and first since 2010 (John Hinson vs. USC Upstate).
- He hit a solo homer to left in the second inning, a three-run homer to right field in the fourth and a solo homer to center in the seventh.
- The son of former MLB pitcher Paul Byrd is hitting .248 with nine homers, 26 RBIs and three steals in 41 games (37 starts) in 2018.
- He led off the 11th inning with a walkoff homer in Clemson's 3-2 win over Austin Peay on May 13.
- In his two seasons as a Tiger, he is hitting .269 with 10 homers, 46 RBIs, 45 runs and six steals in 98 games (91 starts).

CRAWFORD FINDING HOME ON WEEKEND

- Junior righty Brooks Crawford was a long reliever most of his first two seasons at Clemson, but he has become the Saturday starter in 2018.
- He is 7-2 with a 3.60 ERA, .242 opponents' batting average and 47 strikeouts against 12 walks in 65.0 innings pitched over 13 starts.
- Clemson has an 11-2 record in his 13 starts in 2018.
- He is holding opponents to a .178 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- In ACC regular-season games, he is 5-2 and is tied for the ACC lead in wins in conference games.

- In his last seven starts, he is 6-1 with a .223 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts against three walks in 38.2 innings pitched.
- He allowed only four hits, one run and no walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.2 innings pitched to earn the win over Austin Peay on May 12.
- In his career, he is 14-2 with one save, a 3.23 ERA and 95 strikeouts in 133.2 innings pitched over 56 appearances (15 starts).

CROMWELL GETTING ON BASE

- Senior Patrick Cromwell has emerged as one of Clemson's top offensive threats in 2018.
- He is hitting .243 with five homers, five doubles, 21 RBIs, 33 runs, a .371 on-base percentage and a steal in 48 games (45 starts).
- He has a .951 fielding percentage, committing only seven errors in 144 chances, and has made many highlight-reel plays at third base.
- He hit the game-tying, solo homer in the ninth against Winthrop on Feb. 27, a game the Tigers went on to win.
- He went 3-for-5 with two two-run homers against Miami (Fla.) on April 13.
- In his career, he is hitting .231 with five doubles, seven homers, 26 RBIs, 39 runs and a .354 on-base percentage in 81 games (66 starts).

DAVIDSON A COMPLETE PLAYER

- Sophomore shortstop Logan Davidson has been steady both at the plate and in the field in 2018.
- He was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .304 with 16 doubles, 11 homers, 35 RBIs, 50 runs, 38 walks, a .427 on-base percentage and 10 steals in 53 games.
- He is 27-for-63 (.429) with five homers, nine doubles, 18 RBIs and a .486 on-base percentage during his current 14-game hitting streak.
- He has hit five of his 11 home runs in the first inning.
- He has committed only seven errors in 230 chances at shortstop, good for a .970 fielding percentage.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as MVP of the South Carolina series. He was 3-for-6 with a homer and .786 on-base percentage in three games.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on April 30, as he was 11-for-22 with four doubles, two homers, seven RBIs and nine runs in five games.
- He was named national player-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball May 14, as he had three homers, three doubles and eight RBIs.
- In his career, he is hitting .294 with 25 doubles, 23 homers, 76 RBIs, 106 runs, a .406 on-base percentage and 20 steals in 116 games.

GILLIAM CLOSING THE DEAL

- Junior righthander Ryley Gilliam has been the team's closer each of the last two seasons and has a team-high 10 saves in 2018.
- His 10 saves are tied for fourth in Tiger history and are the most since Matt Vaughn had 11 saves in 2008.
- He was one of 41 players named to the NCBWA Stopper-of-the-Year Watch List in April.
- He was named an NSCA Strength & Conditioning All-American in 2018.
- He is 2-2 with an 0.86 ERA, a .143 opponents' batting average and 47 strikeouts against 18 walks in 31.1 innings pitched over 21 outings.
- In his last 15 outings, he has eight saves and has allowed eight hits and one run (0.38 ERA) with 35 strikeouts in 24.0 innings pitched.
- In his 11 ACC regular-season outings, he has eight saves and has allowed seven hits and one run with 28 strikeouts in 19.0 innings pitched.

HEAD COACH MONTE LEE

Born: Feb. 9, 1977 in Spartanburg, S.C.
Education: Bachelor's degree in elementary education at College of Charleston (2000).

- He had a save in five straight appearances in April, only the second Tiger in history to do that (Paul Harrelson in 2002 is the other).
- He became the first Tiger in history to record a save in all three games of a three-game series when he did so at Virginia from April 27-29.
- In his career, he is 8-5 with 14 saves, a 3.14 ERA and 113 strikeouts in 97.1 innings pitched over 63 appearances (six starts).
- His 14 career saves are tied for eighth most in Tiger history.

GREENE PROVIDING SPARK

- Junior infielder Jordan Greene has provided a spark in the lineup during the second half of the season.
- He is hitting .245 with four doubles, five homers, 16 RBIs, a .391 on-base percentage and seven steals in 38 games (30 starts) in 2018.
- He hit a walkoff solo homer in Clemson's 5-4 win over No. 13 Florida State on May 7, the Tigers' first walkoff homer since 2016 (Seth Beer).
- In his career, he is hitting .252 with 17 doubles, six homers, 41 RBIs, 72 runs and 15 steals in 135 games (108 starts).

HENNESSY LEADING ROTATION

- Sophomore lefthander Jacob Hennessy was a reliever as a freshman in 2017, but has become the Friday starter in 2018.
- He was one of 78 pitchers named to the College Baseball Foundation National Pitcher-of-the-Year Watch List in April.
- He is 4-3 with a 3.65 ERA, .255 opponents' batting average and 51 strikeouts against 14 walks in 69.0 innings pitched over 13 starts.
- He is holding opponents to a .175 batting average with two outs.
- He earned the win against Boston College by allowing just one hit and no earned runs in 6.0 innings pitched on March 29.
- In his career, he is 6-4 with a 3.70 ERA and 88 strikeouts against 25 walks in 99.2 innings pitched over 39 appearances (13 starts).

HIGGINBOTHAM BACK ON THE MOUND

- Sophomore lefthander Jake Higginbotham was a mid-week starter as a freshman in 2016, but suffered an arm injury and missed all of 2017.
- He is 6-1 with a 3.39 ERA, .233 opponents' batting average and 52 strikeouts against 25 walks in 66.1 innings pitched over 13 starts.
- Clemson has an 11-2 record in his 13 starts in 2018.
- He returned to action against William & Mary on Feb. 18 and earned the win in 5.1 innings pitched, allowing just one run on two hits.
- He earned the win against No. 10 Dallas Baptist by allowing just five hits and no earned runs with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA and 80 strikeouts against 46 walks in 99.2 innings pitched over 21 appearances (20 starts).

JOLLY HAPPY AS A SENIOR

- Robert Jolly is enjoying one of his best seasons as a senior in 2018. After being a catcher from 2015-17, he has moved to the outfield.
- He is hitting .239 with six doubles, a homer, 17 RBIs, 18 runs, 24 walks and a .356 on-base percentage in 44 games (39 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .262 with 21 doubles, two homers, 52 RBIs, a .365 on-base percentage and six steals in 160 games (97 starts).

MARR HAVING SOLID FRESHMAN YEAR

- Redshirt freshman righthander Travis Marr has been one of the team's top long relievers in his second season in the program in 2018.
- He is 6-1 with a 4.71 ERA, .292 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts in 42.0 innings pitched over 19 appearances (two starts).
- He is holding opponents to 1-for-12 (.083) with four strikeouts against no walks with the bases loaded.
- In his career, he is 6-1 with a 4.60 ERA and 31 strikeouts against 17 walks in 43.0 innings pitched over 20 appearances (two starts).

MEREDITH ADDING SPEED TO LINEUP

- Freshman outfielder Kier Meredith made his Clemson debut at Notre Dame on April 7 after missing the first half of the season due to injury.
- He made an instant impact in the Notre Dame series, going 4-for-10 with a homer, triple, .571 on-base percentage and three steals.
- He is hitting .242 with a homer, triple, double, four RBIs, six runs, a .457 on-base percentage and four steals in 10 games in 2018.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in all 10 games.

MILLER FILLING KEY RELIEF ROLE

- Senior righthander Ryan Miller has been one of Clemson's top relievers in 2018 and has filled an important role.
- He is 4-1 with four saves, a 2.75 ERA, .211 opponents' batting average and 52 strikeouts in 55.2 innings pitched over 21 relief outings.
- He is holding opponents to a .138 batting average with two outs.
- He has 69 groundball outs compared to 38 flyball outs.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief to record the save in Clemson's win over No. 23 South Carolina at Greenville, S.C., on March 3.
- In his career, he is 5-1 with five saves, a 2.81 ERA and 63 strikeouts against 16 walks in 67.1 innings pitched over 32 relief appearances.

SPIERS MAKING THE JUMP

- Sophomore righthander Carson Spiers saw limited action as a freshman, but he has made a big jump as one of the team's top relievers in 2018.
- He has made a team-high 24 appearances, all out of the bullpen, and has four saves.
- He is 2-2 with a 2.31 ERA, .158 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts against 17 walks in 35.0 innings pitched.
- He is holding opponents to an .094 batting average with runners on base and an .080 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- He has allowed only three of his 27 inherited baserunners to score in 2018.
- In his career, he is 2-2 with a 2.37 ERA and 35 strikeouts against 17 walks in 38.0 innings pitched over 27 relief appearances.
- His cousin, Will Spiers, is the starting punter on the Tiger football team.
- His father, Michael Spiers, hit .301 with 16 homers, 110 RBIs and 32 steals in 184 games as a Tiger from 1988-91.
- His uncle, Bill Spiers, hit .325 with 17 homers, 119 RBIs and 60 steals in 173 games as a Tiger from 1985-87, then played 13 MLB seasons.
- His grandfather, Bud Spiers, hit .254 with seven homers and 44 RBIs as a Tiger from 1956-58.

NOTES

STRIDER PITCHING AS TOP FRESHMAN

- Righthander Spencer Strider has been Clemson's most impactful freshman in 2018 as a reliever and spot starter.
- He is 4-1 with a save, a 3.67 ERA, .195 opponents' batting average and 60 strikeouts in 41.2 innings pitched over 19 outings (three starts).
- He leads the team in strikeouts and has allowed four extra-base hits, including only one home run.
- In ACC regular-season games, he is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA and 20 strikeouts in 16.0 innings pitched over eight relief appearances.

WHARTON EMERGING IN FINAL SEASON

- Senior Drew Wharton entered the season with no homers and 20 RBIs in 74 games (22 starts) over three years.
- With the departure of two outfielders from last year's team, he has made the most of his chance to contribute in 2018.
- He is hitting .234 with 12 doubles, a triple, six homers, 35 RBIs and a .315 on-base percentage in 53 games (52 starts) in 2018.
- He hit three long balls, the first three of his career, in the series against No. 10 Dallas Baptist in February.
- He hit a walkoff triple in Clemson's 8-7 win over No. 23 South Carolina on March 4.
- In his career, he is hitting .229 with 15 doubles, a triple, six homers, 55 RBIs, 29 runs and eight steals in 127 games (74 starts).

WILKIE ON A SECOND-HALF SURGE

- Sophomore catcher is on a second-half surge, just like he was at the end of his freshman season in 2017.
- He is hitting .308 with four homers, eight doubles, 32 RBIs and a .416 on-base percentage in 52 games (50 starts).
- He is 32-for-73 (.438) with three homers, four doubles, 17 RBIs and a .523 on-base percentage during his current 19-game hitting streak.
- Before his hitting streak, he was hitting .212, therefore he has raised his batting average 96 points since.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in each of the last 29 games.
- He is hitting .355 with runners on base, .392 with runners in scoring position and .362 with two outs.
- In ACC regular-season games, he is hitting .322 with two homers, six doubles, 19 RBIs and a .430 on-base percentage in 26 games.
- As Clemson's catcher, he has allowed only 21 stolen bases in 36 attempts.
- In his career, he is hitting .291 with nine doubles, a triple, four homers, 37 RBIs, 29 runs and a .406 on-base percentage in 76 games.

WILLIAMS POWERING TIGERS

- Chris Williams was drafted in the 31st round in 2017, but chose to return for his senior season.
- He is one of the team's best power hitters and has seen most of his action at first base in 2018, but has also played at catcher.
- He was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List in March.
- He is hitting .249 with eight doubles, 14 homers, 52 RBIs, 42 runs, a .362 on-base percentage and three steals in 53 games in 2018.
- He has committed only two errors in 475 chances, good for a .996 fielding percentage.
- He is 7-for-11 with two grand slams, 18 RBIs and a 1.182 slugging percentage with the bases loaded in 2018.
- He hit two grand slams, the first two of his career, in the Miami (Fla.) series on April 13,14.

- In his three-year career, he is hitting .251 with 27 doubles, 36 homers, 141 RBIs, 105 runs and seven steals in 159 games (147 starts).

FOUR TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2018

- Former Tigers Daniel Gossett, Dominic Leone, Brad Miller and Tony Sipp have all played at least one MLB game in 2018.
- Gossett is in his second season, Leone is in his fifth season, Miller is in his sixth season and Sipp is in his 10th season.
- Gossett, who had a 23-9 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Oakland Athletics in 2017.
- Leone, who had a 16-8 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Seattle Mariners in 2014.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- Sipp batted .280 and had a 2-2 pitching record for the Tigers in 2004.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2014 has had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
