# Will Wade

**Head Coach**

2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O'Neal's final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here."

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as director of Basketball

Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

### LAST GAME: LSU 76, SAINT MARY'S 72 (Dec. 15, 2018, Las Vegas, Nevada)

LSU won in the Neon Hoops Classic in Las Vegas by making enough good plays in the crucial moments to get the win over Saint Mary's. The Tigers, after scoring the fewest points it had scored all season in the first half of games (29), went on to have its biggest second half scoring of the season (49) to get the win.

LSU led by one at the half, 29-28, and outscored the Gaels, 18-4, over the first 5:20 of the second half to open us a 47-32 advantage. That margin held up until the 9:54 mark with LSU up 55-40. Saint Mary's made a run cutting the game to 55-50 on a 10-0 run to make it 55-50 with 8:11 to go in front of LSU. In the final 30 seconds, Saint Mary's cut the game to two twice but LSU made four-out-of-six free throw attempts and the Gaels had just one field goal for the final margin.

The Tigers, after shooting just 9-of-27 in the first 20 minutes, proceeded to make 16-of-29 attempts in the second half (55.2 percent) to finish the game at 44.6 percent. Saint Mary's shot 48.1 percent. It was fourth time in 21 games (2-2 this season) that LSU was outshot from the field and won.

LSU was outrebounded in the game, 36-27, but did force 19 Saint Mary's turnovers in stopping their four-game winning streak and evening the Tigers record on neutral courts this year at 2-2.

Tremont Waters hit three treys and scored 18 points, while Emmitt Williams had 15, including 7-7 at the free throw line. Naz Reid and Skylar Mays each had 14 points.

## OTHER LSU-SAINT MARY'S NOTES

**NEW LINEUP** – Coach Will Wade went with a new lineup for the game on Saturday and also his rotation for his nine main players. LSU went big at forward with Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams with the three guard lineup of Skylar Mays, Ja'vonte Smart and Marlon Taylor. Tremont Waters came off the bench for the second time in his career and he scored a team-high 18 points on 7-of-12 shootings, including 3-of-5 from the arc with three assists.

**FREE THROWS PART 2** – For the second straight games, both teams shot the same number of free throws and it turned out to be a bunch of them. Both LSU and Saint Mary's shot 25 free throws one game after LSU and Houston shot the same number of free throws in their game (38). The Tigers were 29-of-38 at Houston (76.3 percent) and 22-of-25 versus Saint Mary's ... That's 80.9 percent. In the second half of both games, the Tigers were really good, hitting 16-of-18 versus Houston and 13-of-15 versus Saint Mary's – that's 29-of-33 in the final 20 minutes combined in both games (87.9 percent).

**SHOOTING** – After a five-of-seven game stretch where teams shot in the 30 percent range from the field, from Louisiana Tech (11/16) to UIW (12/9), both opponents shot in the 40s against the Tigers last week. LSU was the team shooting in the 30s against Houston (12/12) after a 26.9 percent second half, hitting just 36.8 percent for the game. Against Saint Mary's the Tigers had to shoot 55.2 percent to finish at 25-of-56 or 44.6 percent, but Saint Mary's shot 48.1 percent. LSU is fourth in the league n shooting at 48.2 percent, while 11th in FG defense at 42.7. LSU has made 34 more field goals than opponents in 19 more attempts ... The win over Saint Mary's marked the fourth time this year, LSU was outshot from the field (2-2 this year) and the fourth time in 21 games in the Will Wade coaching tenure at LSU that the Tigers have posted a win.

**MORE IDENTICAL NUMBERS** – It wasn't just the free throws that were even (both with 25 attempts). Both teams attempted 17 three-pointers, both teams made six. The teams had different field goal attempts, but both made 25 of them in the final stats.

## PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE AGAIN

After just a couple of games between Nov. 25 and Dec. 9, the Tigers had a squeeze of games as part of a six-day road trip at Houston (12/12) and Las Vegas to face Saint Mary's (12/15).

It is an interesting time between now and the opening of league play on Jan. 8. LSU returned to practice on Tuesday, Dec. 18 for this game on Friday and then will take a couple of days off for the Christmas holidays before returns to prepare for a game on Dec. 28 against ULM.

The Tigers, who do not have a game on the first date of league play on Jan. 5, will have time to work on many things Coach Will Wade wants to work on prior to the start of league play on Jan. 8.

LSU played its first seven games in the first 20 days of the season and will play just six games from Nov. 26 to Jan. 8.

## IT'S NOT RPI BUT NET

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

In very early and still processing NET showings through Monday, LSU is at No. 34, with its 8-3 record. LSU is 0-2 in quadrant 1 play (home 1-30, neutral 1-50, away 1-75) and 2-1 in quadrant 2 wins (home 31-75, neutral 51-100, away 76-135). Three of LSU's wins are in quadrant 3 and three in quadrant 4.

LSU's opponent's schedule NET is 127 and that is ranked 24th best in Division I.

## LSU PUTS 13-GAME WINNING STREAK ON LINE AT MARAVICH CENTER

The win over UIW on Dec. 9 gave LSU 13 consecutive wins in the Maravich Center dating back to the final seven home games of a year ago. The Tigers won six regular season SEC home games to conclude the 2017-18 regular season and the NIT game with UL-Lafayette.

The present 13-game win streak is tied for the eighth longest in Maravich Center history and the longest since LSU won 17 straight at the end of the 2007-08 and start of 2008-09 seasons ... A win Friday will give LSU a tie for the sixth longest win streak in the building:

## ON THE ROAD

The road started out pretty well for LSU last season in Will Wade's first campaign, winning road games at Memphis, Texas A&M and Arkansas to open play away from home. But since then, the Tigers hit the skids losing seven straight in the regular season (Vanderbilt, Auburn, Tennessee, Florida, Alabama, Georgia and South Carolina) and a second-round NIT game at Utah. This year's loss to Houston extends the road losing streak at present to nine games.

All-time, LSU is 419-637 on the road or a win percentage of 39.7 percent.

## NEUTRAL COURTS

The game against Saint Mary's was considered a neutral court contest in Las Vegas, the fourth LSU has played this year after three games last month in the AdvoCare Classic in Orlando. There the Tigers defeated College of Charleston, 67-55, before losing to Florida State, 79-76 in overtime, and 90-77 to Oklahoma State. With the win, LSU is now 2-2 in neutral court games, the first time LSU has won two neutral sight games in a year since the 2013-14 season when LSU was 3-2.

LSU is 148-166 all-time in neutral court games.

## OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY

The first number is offensive rating (how many points per 100 possessions the player produces) and the second number is usage rate (percentage of possessions a players "ends" with a make, miss, turnover).

## THIRD GAME AGAINST A NATIONALLY-RANKED TEAM

The Tigers are 0-2 this year against nationally-ranked teams, having lost to Florida State in overtime in the Advocate Invitational and at Houston. The Tigers are 1-6 in games against nationally-ranked AP poll teams in Will Wade's time at LSU.

LSU is 79-258 all-time or 23.4 percent against teams ranked in the AP poll.

## STEALS ARE GOOD IN BASKETBALL

LSU has some very good steal numbers in the first 11 games with 107 total (9.7 spg), which the total is ranked eighth in the country and first in the league and the per game average is ranked ninth in the NCAA and first in the league.

LSU's Tremont Waters is ranked first in the league and fourth in the nation at 2.91 steals per game while Skylar Mays is ranked third in the league and 110 in the nation at 1.82 steals per game. Ja'vonte Smart at 1.55 spg is ranked ninth in the league.

Waters (32) and Mays (20) are ranked 1-2 in the SEC in total steals.

LSU is +2.1 over last year's steal average of 7.6 a game.

## LSU OVER 50 PERCENT

The Tigers posted a 55.7 percent shooting percentage against UIW (12/9), the fifth time this season that LSU has shot at least 50 percent for a game:

LSU is 4-1 this year when shooting 50 percent or better, 16-1 in the Will Wade era. That one loss came in the Florida State game (11/23), stopping a 16-game winning streak dating back to once at the end of the 2016-17 season when LSU shot 50 percent or better. LSU is 71-7 since the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.

The 34 field goals LSU made against UIW (12/9) was T5 in the Will Wade era at LSU.

## SHOOTING THE THREE

The three ball hasn't been much of a factor in LSU's week away from Baton Rouge as LSU and Houston combined to hit only nine treys – LSU 5, Houston 4 – and then both teams hit exactly the same number in Vegas against Saint Mary's (6-of-17).

Against Grambling (12/1), the Tigers were 9-of-21 or 42.9 percent, the second best single-game percentage of the season, topped only by the 9-of-18 (50%) shooting in the second game of the season against UNCG. Versus UIW (12/9), the Tigers hit double figures in threes for the second time this season:

<b>Vs. UIW – 10-of-26 – 38.5%</b>

LSU is 12th in the SEC in three-point percentage (81-of-247, 32.8%). Opponents have made six more three-pointers than the Tigers so far this season (87-of-238, 36.6%). LSU is 12th in the SEC in three-point field goal defense and accordingly only 287 nationally.

Three opponents – UNCG (19), Memphis (10) and Louisiana Tech (11) – recorded double digit three-point make games.  
Last season, LSU made a school record 268 treys in 33 games (268-744) and shot 34.6 percent from the arc.

### INSIDE THE ARC

LSU is No. 18 in the country in shooting percentage inside the arc at 57.5 percent. The Tigers are second only behind Ole Miss (57.8%) in the league.

The Tigers shot 56.2 percent inside the arc a year ago.  
LSU in its home games is at 60.2% inside the arc this year.

### FREE THROWS

It was a week of free throws as LSU made 29-of-38 against Houston, including 16-of-18 in the second half and then 22-of-25 against Saint Mary's including 13-of-15 in the second half ... For the week, LSU was 51-of-63 (80.9 percent) and 29-of-33 in the second half combined (87.9 percent).

The top three free throw shooting games of Will Wade's tenure at LSU have all come in the first part of the 2018-19 season; 29 makes at Houston (12/12), 28 vs. UNCG (11/9) and 24 against Southeastern (11/6).

In the UNCG game, the Tigers hit 22 in a row at the free throw line to start the game before missing.

LSU is second in the league in free throw shooting at 75.4 percent (184-of-244), which is 34th in the country. Opponents are 157-of-228 (68.9%). The Tigers are +27 in free throw makes on 16 more attempts.

In the last week, LSU moved up two places in the league in percentage and 23 spots nationally.

Skylar Mays is second in the league in free throw percentage at 87.5 percent (28-of-32) and 47th in the country.

### WILL WADE

The native of Nashville graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach during last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called power 5 major conferences this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12) ... ### THREE-GUARD SYSTEM

Soon after Coach Wade arrived at LSU, he stated his belief in having two point guards on the floor at most times to run his offense.

Last season that meant Tremont Waters and Skylar Mays who combined to average 27.2 points (15.9 for Waters, 11.3 for Mays) and a combined 8.9 assists.

Now Coach Wade has started three point guards in every game and until the Saint Mary's game that meant sophomore Waters, junior Mays and freshman Ja'vonte Smart. In the Saint Mary's game, Coach Wade went with Mays, Smart and junior college transfer Marlon Taylor, who was getting his first college start.

Waters would come off the bench to play 30 minutes and probably have one of his better overall games of the season with 18 points. Taylor played 23 solid minutes with seven points.

So it is now four point guards in three spots with Darius Day getting some playing time as a third forward at the three position.

Waters needs 13 three-pointers to become the 21st LSU player to make 100 career treys.

### SKYLAR MAYS

Junior guard Skylar Mays joined teammate Tremont Waters with his own ESPN SportsCenter moment against Memphis (11/13) when he delivered an emphatic driving dunk that registered as the third best player of the day. Mays would score 19 points on 6-of-11 shooting, including three treys. He has 39 career double figure scoring games at LSU.

Mays had an outstanding AdvoCare Invitational in which he led the team, averaging 17.0 points per game, 3.3 rebounds and 3.3 assists per game. He followed that up with two more double figure scoring games to run his current streak to seven consecutive double figure scoring games before it was stopped at Houston (12/12) on a cold shooting night when he only scored seven points.

He was back in double figures with 14 against Saint Mary's and for the season is averaging a team leading 13.3 points per game, 3.5 rebounds a game 2.4 assists and 1.8 steals a contest.

The second team Academic A-A chosen by CoSIDA members has a 4.01 GPA and is majoring in pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for the highest GPA by undergraduate student-athletes.

Mays, who leads the team in three-point field goals (22) is shooting 50 percent from the floor (48-of-96) and 22-of-52 from the arc (42.3 percent).

Mays is presently 13th among active career scorers in the SEC with 776 points and he is seventh in the league in career active assists leaders with 237. He is third behind only Q Weatherspoon of Mississippi State and KeVaughn Allen of Florida in active career steals in the SEC with 112:

### JA'VONTE SMART

The freshman from Baton Rouge had been stuck on 16 as his best scoring game in the early going into the game at Houston. He had posted that number against Louisiana Tech (11/16), Florida State (11/23) and against Incarnate Word (12/9).

Against Tech he had seven field goals with two treys with six field goals and two treys against Florida State. Last Sunday against UIW he also hit six field goals and two treys in the win.

Against Houston (12/12), Smart in 36 minutes hit for six field goals, one trey and was 5-of-5 at the free throw line to score his season high of 18 points. He struggled from the field against Saint Mary's going 1-of-8 with two points, although he did have three assists in 30 minutes.

Smart enters the Furman game averaging 11.2 points a game, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.



Since going 0-2 at the free throw line against Oklahoma State (11/25), Smart is 9-9 at the line in the last four games. For the season, Smart is 23-of-27 at the line.

#### MARLON TAYLOR

The junior college transfer started his first game versus Saint Mary's and scored seven points on 3-of-6 shooting with a trey and a couple of athletic dunks, including an alley oop from Tremont Waters off a timeout play.

Taylor has two double figure games, his debut against Southeastern (11/6) with 15 and 11 against Houston (12/12). In that game, Taylor was a very important 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a free throw shooting contest in a season when he is just 17-of-27 at the line (63 percent).

Taylor is averaging 5.8 points a game, making 20-of-46 field goals (43.5 percent) with seven treys.

LSU's Emmitt Williams, who has two double doubles this year, leads the team in rebounding by a good margin, averaging 6.9 boards a game. Of his 69 rebounds, 30 are offensive (Against Houston, he had six rebounds and five were offensive). Williams is tenth in the SEC in rebounding average.

Darius Days is second at (4.9) and Naz Reid is third in average at 4.8 a game.

LSU is 11 in the league in rebound average at 36.5 a game and sixth in rebound defense at 33.1 a contest.

#### KBW AND THE BLOCKS

As of Wednesday, Kavell Bigby-Williams nine blocks against Grambling on Dec. 1 is tied for second most in a single game this season in the NCAA with the top two being in-state players:

Bigby-Williams averages 2.36 blocks per game and is ranked 29th in the country. He is third in the SEC in block average.

As a team, LSU is 32th in the NCAA in blocks per game at 5.0 and 23rd in the nation in total blocks at 55. However, LSU's team average is only ranked eighth in the SEC.

KBW just missed becoming the third person in the last 30 years to have double figure blocks in a game. Shaquille O'Neal had games with 12 blocks (once), 11 (3 times) and 10 blocks (twice). Stromile Swift had 11 in a game once.

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, KBW joined the following LSU players who have had six or more blocks in a game are: Kavell Bigby-Williams (1), Tyrus Thomas (3), Chris Johnson (4), Jordan Mickey (4), Brandon Bass (2), Glen Davis (1), Anthony Randolph (1) and Malcolm White (1).

Bigby-Williams has also had some good games offensively this season:

#### DARIUS DAYS

The freshman has started three games for the Tigers and is averaging 6.6 points and 4-9 rebounds. He is 25-of-50 from the field and an impressive 17-of-20 at the free throw line.

In the three games as a starter, Days had 13 points and nine rebounds against Grambling (12/1), nine points and eight rebounds against Incarnate Word (12/9) and seven points and three boards at Houston (12/12). In the three games, Days is 11-of-21 from the floor with three treys. His scoring average in the three games has gone up from 6.3 points to 7.3 points a game.

#### NAZ REID

Naz Reid has in Coach Wade's words been doing a lot of good things but some of the stats were showing that but now in the last three games, he has equaled his longest stretch of double figure scoring games since the opening three games of the season.

Reid hit 7-of-8 field goals in a 16-point game against Incarnate Word (12/9) with seven rebounds, three assists and three steals. Against Houston, Reid had 13 points, hitting 4-of-8 from the field with an assist and a steal. In Vegas versus Saint Mary's he was just 5-of-13 from the field but hit all four free throw attempts to scored 14 points.

Reid was 16-of-29 from the field the last three games.

Reid opened his LSU career with 17 points against Southeastern Louisiana, 29 versus UNCG and 11 against Memphis. In those three games, Reid was 22-of-36 from the field, including 11-of-14 in the UNCG game (11/9).

He is averaging 12.4 points and 4.8 rebounds along with 1.2 assists per game. He has started nine games and is shooting 51-of-107 (47.7%) from the field with 10 treys. He is 24-of-34 from the free throw line (70.6%).

### EMMITT WILLIAMS

The freshman missed the Incarnate Word with a lip injury suffered in practice prior to the game, but played 23 minutes off the bench and had six rebounds and a block in the game at Houston. Against Saint Mary's, Williams played 21 minutes off the bench and scored a season high 15 points on 4-of-6 shooting and a perfect 7-of-7 at the free throw line. Williams had six boards with two assists and a steal.

He has two double doubles – 12 points and 10 rebounds against Southeastern (11/6) and 11 points and 10 rebounds against Memphis (11/13).

Williams is averaging 8.7 points per game, 6.9 rebounds and is shooting 62 percent from the field (31-of-50) to go with 25-of-34 at the free throw line, including the last 12 straight.

### FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at nine games of 1.08, ranked 330 of the 353 teams as of Wednesday. Only Arkansas and Kentucky are listed as younger by the web site.

The freshmen on the team in 11 games have scored 46.9 of LSU's 893 points this season (Reid 136, Smart 123, Williams 87, Days 73).

### FORMER BASEBALL PLAYER SCORES IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES

Former LSU baseball pitcher Will Reese scored his first two collegiate points in the Grambling game (12/7) and had another two against UIW (12/9). He joins a group of former players to have handled the two sport aspect at LSU. He was a scholarship pitcher for the baseball team for two seasons before deciding to walk-on to the men's basketball team at LSU, playing basketball for the first time since leading Anacoco High to two state titles.

He is the first two-sport player to score for LSU basketball since Robert Royal on Jan. 17, 20001 (FB, BKB) and he is the first LSU baseball player to record points since Lyle Mouton on March 17, 1989. Of course the SEC Network and ESPN's Ben McDonald also participated in both basketball and baseball in his time at LSU in the mid-1980s.

### WITH ONE MORE GAME AGAINST LOUISIANA COMPETITION

### SERIES VERSUS FURMAN

Furman comes into the game at 12-0, ranked No. 24 in the AP poll and 25 in the USA Today coaches' poll. The Paladins are No. 3 in the Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25. They are the first team in the country to reach 12 wins and comes to Baton Rouge having won eight consecutive true road contests.

The teams last home game was Saturday, a 93-50 win over UNCW. The Paladins shot 47.4 percent in that game but took 46 three-pointers of the 76 shots they posted, making 17. Clay Mounce led Furman with 26 points, 10 rebounds and five assists, making six treys, while Jordan Lyons had 16 points and four assists, Alex Hunter had 14 points and Matt Rafferty had 13 points, 11 rebounds, seven assists and four steals. UNCW had 17 second chance points and 34 fast break points.

The Paladins have wins over two Final Four teams from 2018 – Loyola Chicago and Villanova.

This will be the first the teams have played since their only meeting on Dec. 29, 1960 in the Poinsettia Classic in Greenville, South Carolina when Furman won in triple overtime, 56-55.

The game will match two of the youngest coaches in the country as Furman is coached by 35-year-old Bob Richey, who is in his second full season as the head coach at Furman. Last year the team won a school record 22 regular season games in finishing 23-10.
