# Will Wade

**Head Coach**

2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O'Neal's final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here."

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as director of Basketball

Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

### LAST GAME: LSU 75, No. 24 FURMAN 57 (Dec. 21, 2018, Baton Rouge)

For the second straight game, the Tigers were able to make a big run at the start of the second half and came away with a strong 75-57 win over No. 24 and previously undefeated Furman last Friday night at the Maravich Center.

The Tigers had just a four-point lead after the first half, but got a good run going at the start of the second half and built the lead to 13 points four minutes into the second half and Furman got only within five the rest of the way. The Tigers shot consistently throughout the game, making 13-of-24 in the first half and 18-of-32 in the second half to shoot 55.4 percent (31-56) for the game.

However, 14 first half turnovers allowed Furman to hang around despite shooting just 35 percent in the first half. In the second half, LSU committed just three turnovers. The key stats was the success LSU had inside with 50 points in the paint to just 22 for Furman, including a 16-7 advantage in second chance points.

Tremont Waters for the second straight game came off the bench and showed his ability with 20 points, seven turnovers (six in the second half), five rebounds and two steals in 35 minutes. Skylar Mays had 16 points on 7-of-10 shooting with three assists and four steals and Kavell Bigby-Williams had his second double double of 10 points and 10 rebounds. Naz Reid had 10 rebounds to go with nine points.

### OTHER FURMAN NOTES

**DECIDING RUNS** -- It was an 18-4 run over the first 5:20 of the second half that pushed LSU out to a big



margin in its win over Saint Mary's after leading by just one at the half Dec. 15 in Las Vegas and it was a run in the first four minutes of the second half against No. 24 Furman that allowed LSU to stake its claim to a lead they would not relinquish. LSU outscored the Paladins, 12-3 in the first 4:04 to expand a four-point halftime advantage to 13, 43-30. Furman would get no closer than 5.

**AGAINST RANKED TEAMS** – LSU wins for the second time in the Will Wade era against a ranked team (at Texas A&M last year the other). It is LSU's 80th win all-time against a ranked team in the AP poll and the first against a ranked team in the Maravich Center since Feb. 13, 2016 against No. 15 Texas A&M, 76-71. The 18-point margin of victory equals the biggest margin in a win against a ranked team since the Tigers defeated No. 9 Kentucky, 85-67, in that same season on Jan. 5, 2016.

**DOUBLE UP IN REBOUNDS** – The Tigers' Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams combined for 20 rebounds with each grabbing 10 in the win over Furman. The last time LSU had two players with double figure rebounds was a unique combo of guard and forward as Tremont Waters and Duop Reath combined for 22 rebounds, each getting 11, against Kentucky on Jan. 3, 2018.

#### LET'S PLAY THEN PRACTICE

After opening with seven games in the first 20 days of the season, with the ULM game Friday, LSU will have played just six games between Nov. 26 and the first league game on Tuesday, Jan. 8.

Now there is an open date involved as 10 of the league teams will open SEC play on Jan. 5 because LSU will play late in February when those 10 teams are in the SEC/Big 12 event.

But it does allow Coach Will Wade and his staff the time to look at the program and take the information and process it prior to SEC play without having to worry about scouting reports or things like that. The Tigers in the last two games against Saint Mary's and Furman have shown what some of that practice time has led to with the return of the more structured inside-out offense.

#### IT'S NOT RPI BUT NET

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

After play on Saturday, figuring LSU's win over Furman, LSU is at No. 25 in the NET with its 9-3 record. LSU's strength of schedule is listed at No. 12.

LSU is 0-2 in quadrant 1 play (home 1-30, neutral 1-50, away 1-75) and 4-1 in quadrant 2 wins (Furman, Saint Mary's, Charleston, UNCG)(home 31-75, neutral 51-100, away 76-135). Two of LSU's wins are in quadrant 3 and three in quadrant 4.

LSU's opponent's schedule NET is 120 and that is ranked 17th best in Division I.

#### LSU PUTS 14-GAME WINNING STREAK ON LINE AT MARAVICH CENTER

The win over Furman (12/21) stopped the Paladins eight-game road winning streak and extended LSU's winning streak at the Maravich Center to 14 games dating back to the final seven home games of a year ago. The Tigers won six regular season SEC home games to conclude the 2017-18 regular season and the NIT game with UL-Lafayette.

The present 14-game win streak is tied for the sixth longest in Maravich Center history and the longest since LSU won 17 straight at the end of the 2007-08 and start of 2008-09 seasons ... A win Friday will give LSU solo sixth place on the longest win streaks in the building:

## ON THE ROAD

The road started out pretty well for LSU last season in Will Wade's first campaign, winning road games at Memphis, Texas A&M and Arkansas to open play away from home. But since then, the Tigers hit the skids losing seven straight in the regular season (Vanderbilt, Auburn, Tennessee, Florida, Alabama, Georgia and South Carolina) and a second-round NIT game at Utah. This year's loss to Houston extends the road losing streak at present to nine games.

All-time, LSU is 419-637 on the road or a win percentage of 39.7 percent.

## OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY

Our Cody Worsham pulled this out from Kenpom.com on Twitter prior to the Furman game and here is the way it stands after play prior to Christmas. LSU has four-of-the-top-14 players in the SEC in offensive efficiency, including the top two players:

The first number is offensive rating (how many points per 100 possessions the player produces) and the second number is usage rate (percentage of possessions a player "ends" with a make, miss, turnover).

## STEALS ARE GOOD IN BASKETBALL

LSU has some very good steal numbers in the first 11 games with 118 total (9.8 spg), which the total and average are ranked first in the SEC and seventh in the country.

LSU's Tremont Waters is ranked first in the league in both steals average (2.8) and total steals (34). He is eighth in steals per game and seventh in total nationally.

Skylar Mays is ranked second in the league in both steals average (2.0) and total steals (24). That is ranked 59th in the nation in average and 55th in total steals in the NCAA stats.

LSU is +2.2 over last year's steal average of 7.6 a game.

## LSU OVER 50 PERCENT

The Tigers posted a 55.4 percent shooting percentage against Furman (12/21), the sixth time this season that LSU has shot at least 50 percent for a game:

LSU is 5-1 this year when shooting 50 percent or better, 17-1 in the Will Wade era. That one loss came in the Florida State game (11/23), stopping a 16-game winning streak dating back to once at the end of the 2016-17 season when LSU shot 50 percent or better. LSU is 72-7 since the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.

## SHOOTING THE THREE

The three ball hasn't been much of a factor in LSU's last three games as LSU and Houston (12/12) combined to hit only nine treys – LSU 5, Houston 4 – and then both teams hit exactly the same number in Vegas (12/15) against Saint Mary's (6-of-17). LSU hit a grand total of 4 against Furman, but more importantly the LSU defense kept Furman to 9 in 31 attempts (29.0%).

Against Grambling (12/1), the Tigers were 9-of-21 or 42.9 percent, the second best single-game percentage of the season, topped only by the 9-of-18 (50%) shooting in the second game of the season against UNCG. Versus UIW (12/9), the Tigers hit double figures in threes for the second time this season:

LSU is 12th in the SEC in three-point percentage (85-of-260, 32.7%). Opponents have made 11 more three-pointers than the Tigers so far this season (96-of-269, 35.7%). LSU is 11th in the SEC in three-point field goal defense and accordingly only 268 nationally.

Three opponents – UNCG (19), Memphis (10) and Louisiana Tech (11) – recorded double digit three-point make games.

Last season, LSU made a school record 268 treys in 33 games (268-744) and shot 34.6 percent from the arc.

## INSIDE THE ARC

LSU continues to have its best games from two-point range at the Maravich Center where it is shooting over 60 percent at home. Against Furman, the Tigers were 27-of-43 inside the arc (with 50 points in the paint) or 62.8 percent.

LSU is No. 11 in the country in shooting percentage inside the arc at 58.0 percent for the season. The Tigers are first in the league in shooting inside the arc. Ole Miss is 14th in the country at 57.9%.

The Tigers shot 56.2 percent inside the arc a year ago.

## FREE THROWS

Despite making just 9-of-15 against Furman at the charity stripe, LSU remains third in the league in free throw percentage at 74.5% (193-of-259).

LSU is 46th in the nation in free throw percentage. Opponents are 163-of-237 (68.8%). The Tigers are +30 in free throw makes on 22 more attempts.

## WILL WADE

The native of Nashville graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach during last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called power 5 major conferences this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12) ... ### SKYLAR MAYS

The junior guard from Baton Rouge certainly had a good last two games in the LSU wins against Saint Mary's and Furman. His numbers off 14 points against Saint Mary's (12/15) and 16 points versus Furman (12/21):

**Totals -- 10-of-16 FG, 3-7 3FG, 7-8 FT -- 30 points, 4 rebounds, 5 assists, 7 steals**

For the season Mays is averaging a team high 13.3 points per game, 3.4 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game. Mays has had half of his 24 steals in the last four games combined.

The second team Academic A-A chosen by CoSIDA members has a 4.01 GPA and is majoring in pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for the highest GPA by undergraduate student-athletes.

Mays, who leads the team in three-point field goals (24) is shooting 51.9 percent from the floor (55-of-106) and 24-of-57 from the arc (42.1 percent). He is also exceptional at the line, making 28-of-32 free throws for 87.5%.

Mays is presently 13th among active career scorers in the SEC with 792 points and he is seventh in the league in career active assists leaders with 240. He is third behind only Q Weatherspoon of Mississippi State and KeVaughn Allen of Florida in active career steals in the SEC with 116.

### JA'VONTE SMART

The freshman from Baton Rouge had been stuck on 16 as his best scoring game in the early going into the game at Houston. He had posted that number against Louisiana Tech (11/16), Florida State (11/23) and against Incarnate Word (12/9).

Against Tech he had seven field goals with two treys with six field goals and two treys against Florida State. Last Sunday against UIW he also hit six field goals and two treys in the win.

Against Houston (12/12), Smart in 36 minutes hit for six field goals, one trey and was 5-of-5 at the free throw line to score his season high of 18 points.

He has struggled from the field in the last two games against Saint Mary's (12/15) and Furman (12/21) with just a combined two points on 1-of-12 shooting from the floor (0-2 from the arc).

Smart enters the Furman game averaging 10.3 points a game, 3.1 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game.

Since going 0-2 at the free throw line against Oklahoma State (11/25), Smart is 9-9 at the line in the last five games. For the season, Smart is 23-of-27 at the line.

### MARLON TAYLOR

The junior college transfer started his first game versus Saint Mary's and scored seven points on 3-of-6 shooting with a trey and a couple of athletic dunks, including an alley oop from Tremont Waters off a timeout play.

He followed that up with 30 minutes against Furman (12/21) with eight points and three rebounds including two spectacular dunks.

For the two games he is averaging 7.5 points and 2.5 rebounds, shooting 7-of-12 overall with a trey.

Taylor has two double figure games, his debut against Southeastern (11/6) with 15 and 11 against Houston (12/12). In that game, Taylor was a very important 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a free throw shooting contest in a season when he is just 17-of-27 at the line (63 percent).

Taylor is averaging for the year, 6.0 points a game, making 24-of-52 field goals (46.2 percent) with seven treys.

LSU's Emmitt Williams, who has two double doubles this year, leads the team in rebounding by a good margin, averaging 6.5 boards a game. Of his 71 rebounds, 32 are offensive (Against Houston, he had six rebounds and five were offensive). Williams is T15 in the SEC in rebounding average.

Naz Reid is at 5.3 rebounds a game with Darius Days at 4.9 and Kavell Bigby-Williams at 4.8.

LSU is No. 10 in the league in rebound average at 36.8 a game and fifth in rebound defense at 32.2 a contest.



## KBW AND THE BLOCKS

As of the Christmas break, Kavell Bigby-Williams' nine blocks against Grambling on Dec. 1 is tied for second most in a single game this season in the NCAA with the top two being in-state players:

Bigby-Williams averages 2.2 blocks per game. He is seventh in the SEC in block average.

KBW just missed becoming the third person in the last 30 years to have double figure blocks in a game. Shaquille O'Neal had games with 12 blocks (once), 11 (3 times) and 10 blocks (twice). Stromile Swift had 11 in a game once.

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, KBW joined the following LSU players who have had six or more blocks in a game are: Kavell Bigby-Williams (1), Tyrus Thomas (3), Chris Johnson (4), Jordan Mickey (4), Brandon Bass (2), Glen Davis (1), Anthony Randolph (1) and Malcolm White (1).

## DARIUS DAYS

The freshman has started three games for the Tigers and is averaging 6.4 points and 4.9 rebounds. He is 27-of-52 from the field and an impressive 17-of-20 at the free throw line.

In the three games as a starter, Days had 13 points and nine rebounds against Grambling (12/1), nine points and eight rebounds against Incarnate Word (12/9) and seven points and three boards at Houston (12/12). In the three games, Days was 11-of-21 from the floor with three treys.

## NAZ REID

Naz Reid has in Coach Wade's words been doing a lot of good things but some of the stats weren't reflecting that, but he has certainly improved his numbers rapidly just missing a double double against Furman with nine points and 10 rebounds (12/21).

Reid opened his LSU career with 17 points against Southeastern Louisiana, 29 versus UNCG and 11 against Memphis. In those three games, Reid was 22-of-36 from the field, including 11-of-14 in the UNCG game (11/9).

He is averaging 12.1 points and 5.3 rebounds along with 1.2 assists per game. He has started 10 games and is shooting 55-of-114 (48.2%) from the field with 10 treys.

## EMMITT WILLIAMS

The freshman missed the Incarnate Word with a lip injury suffered in practice prior to the game, but played 23 minutes off the bench and had six rebounds and a block in the game at Houston.

Against Saint Mary's, Williams played 21 minutes off the bench and scored a season high 15 points on 4-of-6 shooting and a perfect 7-of-7 at the free throw line. Williams had six boards with two assists and a steal. Against Furman (12/21), he hit all three field goal attempts and had eight points.

He has two double doubles – 12 points and 10 rebounds against Southeastern (11/6) and 11 points and 10 rebounds against Memphis (11/13).

Williams is averaging 8.6 points per game, 6.5 rebounds and is shooting 64.2 percent from the field (34-of-53) to go with 27-of-37 at the free throw line.

## FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at nine games of 1.09, ranked 326 of the 353 teams as of the Christmas break. Only Arkansas and Kentucky are listed as younger by the web site.

The freshmen on the team in 12 games have scored 45.4 of LSU's points this season.

## FORMER BASEBALL PLAYER SCORES IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES

Former LSU baseball pitcher Will Reese scored his first two collegiate points in the Grambling game (12/1) and had another two against UIW (12/9). He joins a group of former players to have handled the two sport aspect at LSU. He was a scholarship pitcher for the baseball team for two seasons before deciding to walk-on to the men's basketball team at LSU, playing basketball for the first time since leading Anacoco High to two state titles.

He is the first two-sport player to score for LSU basketball since Robert Royal on Jan. 17, 2000 (FB, BKB) and he is the first LSU baseball player to record points since Lyle Mouton on March 17, 1989. Of course the SEC Network and ESPN's Ben McDonald also participated in both basketball and baseball in his time at LSU in the mid-1980s.
