QUICK PITCHES

• Arkansas State is now 25-26 on the season and 11-16 in the Sun Belt conference after dropping three contest to Georgia Southern over the weekend.

• A-State dropped the last meeting 15-3 to Ole Miss which took place on Feb. 20. The Red Wolves struck first with back-to-back RBI hits by Justin Felix and Kyle MacDonald in the top of the first inning, but Ole Miss answered back on a three-run homer to by Tyler Keenen in the bottom half of the frame and tacked on two more runs with an RBI single and sacrifice fly to go up 5-2 after the first inning.

• Sky-Lar Culver enters the midweek matchup leading the team in a number of stat categories including a .328 batting average, RBIs (44), hits (63), doubles (14).

• Arkansas State is hitting .257 as a team, 7 Arkansas State players have multiple HRs on the season (43 total), led by Justin Felix's 9 home runs.

• The Red Wolves pitching staff currently owns a 5.18 ERA and has struck out 388 batters in 446.2 innings pitched.

• Kollin Stone has recorded six of the team's eight saves. The junior holds a 3.45 ERA, 28 strikeouts and a 1-2 record over 28.2 IP over 23 games.

• Jack Jumper comes in with a team- best 1.77 ERA, 2-2 record, two saves and 36 strikeouts in 40.2 innings pitched in 25 games.

• #11 Ole Miss enters the Mid-Week matchup 32-20 overall and 15-12 in the SEC. The Rebels are entering the contest after dropping the three conference matchups to #5 Mississippi State. Ole Miss dropped the first contest 2-0, the second 8-5 and fell in the series finale 11-5.

OLE MISS

- A-State trails the all-time series with Ole Miss by a count of 25-88 after losing 15-3 earlier this season in Oxford, Miss.,
• The Red Wolves struck first with back-to-back RBI hits by Justin Felix and Kyle MacDonald in the top of the first inning, but Ole Miss answered back on a three-run homer to by Tyler Keenen in the bottom half of the frame and tacked on two more runs with an RBI single and sacrifice fly to go up 5-2 after the first inning.
• Drew Tipton, Sky-Lar Culver and Alex Howard each finished the night 2-for-4 for the Red Wolves, with Howard adding an RBI single in the third inning. Felix and MacDonald each finished with an RBI as well.
• In 2017, A-State shut out Ole Miss 5-0 on May 16 in front of a Tomlinson Stadium record crowd of 1,188. Bryan Ayers tied his career high with seven innings of shutout baseball to earn the win. Alex Howard had three hits and two RBI to lead the offense. The shutout for A-State was the first over the Rebels in school history. The team lost the meeting in Oxford by a score of 16-4 Feb. 21.
• Arkansas State won the first meeting between the two schools by a score of 7-3 in 1951 with Ole Miss taking the second game by a count of 11-4. The Rebels went on to win 12 straight until A-State claimed a 9-8 victory in the second of four games during the 1961 season. The Red Wolves swept two meetings during the 1968 season by scores of 2-1 and 7-6 and didn't sweep the Rebels again until 1978 when A-State won two games by the scores of 6-1 and 7-5 with both games being hosted in Blytheville, Ark. Arkansas State swept Ole Miss during the 1988 season by scores of 6-5 and 13-11 and won the only meeting in 1994 9-4 in 10 innings. A-State won both meetings in 2003 (3-2 and 8-5) and won twoof-three games in 2004 with an 11-7 win over the 10th-ranked Rebel in Oxford before a 9-8 loss at No. 7 Ole Miss. A-State took the rubber game 7-6 over No. 6 Ole Miss later in the year. A-State defeated No. 2 Ole Miss in Oxford early in the 2008 season by a score of 7-5. Along with a win over No. 2 Louisiana- Lafayette in 2014, that is the highest-ranked opponent A-State has ever defeated.

Jonesboro, Ark. (5/12/19)- The Arkansas State baseball team scored five unanswered runs, but it wasn't enough as the Red Wolves fell 11-6 to Georgia Southern Sunday evening at Jack Stallings Field.

Following the loss, the squad fell to 25-26 overall and 11-16 in the Sun Belt conference while Georgia southern improved to 20-21 overall and 16-11 in the league.

Payton Lannon pitched three innings, out of the bullpen, where he allowed three runs on two hits with two walks and a strikeout. Lannon retired nine consecutive batters in his outing Sunday.

Georgia Southern built an 8-1 advantage over the first two innings, but the Red Wolves rallied over the next two, scoring six unanswered runs. Kyle MacDonald ignited the A-State offense when he filed out to left field to score Alex Howard. The Red Wolves pulled within 8-3, when Justin Felix slashed a two-run double to center field bringing across Sky-Lar Culver and Drew Tipton.

Back-to-back passed balls by Georgia Southern allowed Howard and Karsen Reid to come home for the Red Wolves to pull within 8-6 of the Eagles. However, the home team got two runs back in the home half of the fifth to extend its lead 10-6.

Felix finished the day two-for-five with two RBIs and two doubles while Drew Tipton finished two-for-three with an RBI, a double and a run. Culver also assisted with the offense going two-for-five with an RBI, a double and a run.

Arkansas State will return to action Tuesday, May 14 when it hosts Ole Miss. The first pitch is set for 6:30 p.m. at Tomlinson Stadium.

- Arkansas State Senior first baseman Kyle MacDonald was named the 2019 Sun Belt Preseason Player of the year, after leading the Red Wolves in a number of offensive categories including runs (50), hits (66), homers (15) RBI (50), total bases (127).
- He posted a team-high .464 on-base percentage which was best in the league. His .665 slugging percentage was first in the Sun Belt, 22nd in the nation and seventh best in school history.
- The Mississauga, Ontario, native played and started in 51 of the teams 52 games, earning Sun Belt Newcomer of the Year honors and second team all-conference honors. He also picked up All-Central Region First Team honors from the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) to become the 12th player at A-State to earn the award.
- MacDonald was named to 2019 Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Watch List.
- In 2018, he led the team in multiple-hit games with 20 and multiple-RBI games with 12 ... ended the season with an 11-game on-base streak ... posted season-high four hits in two games at Missouri (March 21) and at ULM (March 24) ... hit two home runs in back-to-back games versus Ole Miss (May 15) and at Little Rock (May 17) ... hit two doubles against Coastal Carolina March 17 ... recorded eight total bases three times in games at ULM (March 24), versus Ole Miss (May 15), and at Little Rock (May 17) ... knocked in four runs versus Coastal Carolina March 17 and at Georgia State April 7 ... scored a season-best three runs four times and also walked three times in four different games ... was intentionally walked seven times.
