QUICK PITCHES

- Arkansas State is now 26-26 on the season and 11-16 in the Sun Belt conference after defeating #15 Ole Miss Tuesday evening at Tomlinson Stadium.
- The Red Wolves trailed 5-0 entering the bottom of the eighth but the squad rallied when Justin Felix sent a two-run blast to left. Jacob Jablonski started the ninth with a leadoff walk and scored on an RBI single by Eli Davis. Drew Tipton walked, to put two on with one out and Sky-Lar Culver singled through the right side to bring the Red Wolves within one, 5-4. MacDonald narrowly missed a walk off home run, but came back with an 0-2 single up the middle to score Tipton. An error in center field allowed Culver to score the winning run to give A-State the 6-5 victory.
- Sky-Lar Culver enters the weekend series leading the team in a number of stat categories including a .325 batting average, RBIs (45), hits (64), doubles (14).
- Arkansas State is hitting .258 as a team, 7 Arkansas State players have multiple HRs on the season (43 total), led by Justin Felix's 10 home runs.
- The Red Wolves pitching staff currently owns a 5.16 ERA and has struck out 394 batters in 455.2 innings pitched.
- Kollin Stone has recorded six of the team's eight saves. The junior holds a 3.45 ERA, 28 strikeouts and a 1-2 record over 28.2 IP over 23 games.
- Jack Jumper comes in with a team- best 1.77 ERA, 2-2 record, two saves and 36 strikeouts in 40.2 innings pitched in 25 games.
- Little Rock enters the weekend, 25-26 overall and 15-11 in the Sun Belt Conference. Last weekend, the Trojans took two of three from Texas State. Little Rock took the first game 4-3, the second 9-5 and fell 13-9 in the series finale.

LITTLE ROCK

- A-State leads the all-time series with Little Rock by a count of 78-46 in a series that began in the 1975 season with A-State winning both contests in Jonesboro by scores of 4-3 and 6-1. The Trojans made the trip to Jonesboro again the following season and A-State took both contests by counts of 4-1 and 4-2. The two schools didn't play again until 1980 when Little Rock earned its first two victories in the all-time series by scores of 7-4 and 7-2 in Jonesboro. The two teams played several times throughout the early 80's, but have played in each season from 1987 through the present. The two teams because foes in the Sun Belt Conference in 1992, but the five games during the 1992 campaign didn't count as league games. A-State won the first two games by scores of 7-2 and 2-1 in Little Rock before sweeping a three-game set in Jonesboro later in the year by scores of 12-5, 20-7, and 23-7. Since then all of the games played between the two games have counted on the conference standings or occurred during the SBC Tournament, although the two teams have only met once in the conference tournament (a 13-10 A-State loss in 2000). Head coach Tommy Raffo is 29-12 against Little Rock all time. The team won two-of-three in Little Rock to close out the 2009 season in his first three meetings against them. The Trojans won the series 2-1 in 2010 and won two-of-three in the first series of 2011, but A-State reeled off 13 straight victories against Little Rock, including four series sweeps from the second series of 2011 through the first game of the second series during the 2013 campaign. The Trojans won two in a row to end the regular season for year to take the series. A-State swept Little Rock in the first series of 2014 under Raffo's watch, but lost two-of-three to the Trojans in Little Rock before the Red Wolves won the 2015 season's series in Jonesboro two games to one. In 2016, A-State took two of three from the Trojans in Little Rock. A-State dropped game one 9-4 before bouncing back to win games two and three (12-10 and 15-11) in comeback fashion. In 2018, the teams were only able to play two of the three scheduled games, but both of them were ones to remember. The Red Wolves won the first game of the series 9-8 in 18 innings, the longest SBC game in program history, on a walk-off single from Justin Felix. The game went to extras tied 6-6 but the Trojans scored two runs in the 16th, but A-State scored two in the bottom half to keep the game going. Bradey Welsh won the game with five innings in relief, while Justin Felix and Jake Bakamus tied the school record for walks with four. In game two of the set, A-State scored 19 runs on 18 hits and defeated Little Rock 19-2. The team tied the school record for hit-by-pitches with eight and saw Jeremy Brown, Justin Felix, and Alex Howard each. total three RBI, while Grant Hawkins and Garrett Rucker had four hits. Last season, the Red Wolves took two of three from the Trojans. In the first game the team was tied with Little Rock 6-6 entering the ninth inning, but a one-out double from Jeremy Brown scored Drew Tipton from second to send the Red Wolves to a 7-6 victory in the series opener. in the second game, A-State won 4-1 while Nate Alberius threw a complete game. The Red Wolves fell in the series finale 6-2.

Jonesboro, Ark. (5/14/19)- Trailing 5-0 in the bottom of the eighth, the Arkansas State baseball team rallied for six runs in the final two frames for a 6-5 win over #15 Ole Miss, Tuesday night at Tomlinson Stadium.

Following the win, the Red Wolves improved to 26-26 overall while Ole Miss fell to 32-21.

Zachary Patterson pitched five innings, where he allowed four runs on five hits while walking five and striking out one. Noah Stone (2-1) earned the win out of the bullpen, pitching four innings allowing one run on three hits while punching out five.

The home team entered the bottom of the eighth trailing 5-0, but pulled within 5-2, when Justin Felix sent a two-run blast to left scoring Kyle MacDonald. Jablonski started the ninth with a lead-off walk and scored on an RBI single by Eli Davis. Drew Tipton walked to put two on with one out and Sky-Lar Culver singled through the right side to bring the Red Wolves within one, 5-4.

MacDonald narrowly missed a walk off home run but came back with an 0-2 single up the middle to score Tipton. An error in center field allowed Culver to score the winning run to give A-State the 6-5 victory.

Felix finished the night three-for-four with two RBIs, a home run and a run while MacDonald finished three-for-five with an RBI and a run.

Ole Miss jumped out to a 3-0 advantage in the fourth, when Kevin Graham launched a three-run home run to right. Tyler Keenan extended the Rebels lead 4-0 when homered to right. Ryan Olenek chipped in big for the Rebels, finishing the night three-for-four with a run.

Arkansas State will return to action when it hosts Little Rock in a three-game weekend series. The first pitch is set for 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, 1 p.m. on Saturday and the series will continue Saturday at 1 p.m.

- Arkansas State Senior first baseman Kyle MacDonald was named the 2019 Sun Belt Preseason Player of the year, after leading the Red Wolves in a number of offensive categories including runs (50), hits (66), homers (15) RBI (50), total bases (127).
- He posted a team-high .464 on-base percentage which was best in the league. His .665 slugging percentage was first in the Sun Belt, 22nd in the nation and seventh best in school history.
- The Mississauga, Ontario, native played and started in 51 of the teams 52 games, earning Sun Belt Newcomer of the Year honors and second team all-conference honors. He also picked up All-Central Region First Team honors from the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) to become the 12th player at A-State to earn the award.
- MacDonald was named to 2019 Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Watch List.
- In 2018, he led the team in multiple-hit games with 20 and multiple-RBI games with 12 ... ended the season with an 11-game on-base streak ... posted season-high four hits in two games at Missouri (March 21) and at ULM (March 24) ... hit two home runs in back-to-back games versus Ole Miss (May 15) and at Little Rock (May 17) ... hit two doubles against Coastal Carolina March 17 ... recorded eight total bases three times in games at ULM (March 24), versus Ole Miss (May 15), and at Little Rock (May 17) ... knocked in four runs versus Coastal Carolina March 17 and at Georgia State April 7 ... scored a season-best three runs four times and also walked three times in four different games ... was intentionally walked seven times.
